Trainers with multiple runners engaged in any race were questioned as to their intended driving tactics.

During the meeting Stewards received information that three drivers were subject to Public Health restrictions due to travel from Victoria since July 8 but before July 16. Stewards, acting under the provisions of AHRR15(1), removed the drivers from their remaining drives and directed them to leave the course immediately.

The Stewards actions resulted in a number of driving changes as follows:

Race 4

Race 5

#5 HEZ THE ONE – Mr P Hill replaced Mr M Ford #8 DEADLY ASSASSIN – Mr L Hooper replaced Ms J Chibnall #11 DOMEDAN – Mr M Yole replaced Mr T McDonald

Race 8

#2 COOLHAND EASTON NZ – Mr K Williams replaced Mr M Ford #3 CAPTAIN COSMONAUT – Mr L Hooper replaced Ms J Chibnall #8 NORTHVIEW DAVE NZ – Mr M Yole replaced Mr T McDonald

RACE 1 – TASMANIAN EQUINE VETERINARY SERVICES PACE – 1609 METRES

FORGOT THE WALLET – Led then surrendered the lead approaching the 1400 metre point. Hung in, contacting a number of marker pegs near the 850 metre point. A warning was issued. Utilised the sprint lane in the run to the finish.

NOVA BAXTER – Worked forward from outside the leader to take over the lead approaching the 1400 metre point.

RACE 2 - PRYDES EASIFEED PACE - 2090 METRES

Street Address: 171 Westbury road Prospect Tasmania 7250 Postal Address: P O Box 1329, Launceston, Tasmania 7250 REGAL KENZIE – Gave ground over the concluding stages to be beaten in excess of 59 metres. Having considered the 31.9 metre margin between 1st and 3rd, Stewards took no action against REGAL KENZIE.

MY ULTIMATE BEAUTY – Raced in a one out one back trailing position for the first 400 metres prior to being left leading the one wide line. Once again obtained a one out one back trail near the 1600 metres. Hung out slightly entering the home straight on the final occasion.

WHO SAID YOU SAID – Led but was unable to hold the lead, taking up the position trailing the leader. Shifted out to lead the one wide line near the 1600 metre point. Hung in badly at various stages throughout the race. Tired over the concluding stages to be beaten in excess of 146 metres. A post-race veterinary examination of the gelding failed to reveal any abnormalities. WHO SAID YOU SAID is stood own from racing until the completion of a satisfactory trial.

NOBEER NOMORE – Worked forward to take over the lead after 400 metres. Held back for post-race blood samples to be taken.

HUGHIE PLAYBOY – Entering the home straight on the final occasion checked by an inside runner shifting out slightly and raced roughly for a short distance.

RACE 3 – NUTRIEN SPRINTLANE PACE – 2090 METRES

IDEN BLACK PRINCE – Led and then surrendered the lead after 450 metres. Utilised the sprint lane in the run to the finish.

JUST FOR DAVE – Worked forward to the lead after 450 metres.

GAUCI – Gave ground over the concluding stages.

VONNS ANGEL – Worked forward three wide to take over the position leading the one wide line approaching the 1500 metre point.

IFITSTOBEITSUPTOME - Commenced a three wide run from mid-field near the 1200 metre point.

TAUMALOLO – Gave ground over the concluding stages.

GORDIEVSKY LEIS - Three wide, one back from the 1200 metre point.

LORD BAZALUP - Three wide, two back from the 1200 metre point.

RACE 4 – TASMANIAN HORSE TRANSPORT PACE– 1609 METRES

STEPPING STONES - Commenced a three wide run from mid-field approaching the 1000 metre point.

ALBAYZIN - Raced three wide for the first 400 whilst being restrained to the rear of the field.

SOMEHOWSOMEWAY – Raced three wide with a trail for the first 450 metres, then worked forward three wide to take over the position leading the one wide line approaching the 1000 metre point.

MY CELEBRITY – Led the one wide line for the first 400 metres, prior to restraining to the position behind the leader.

THE FLOYD – Worked forward three wide to take over the position leading the one wide line after 400 metres. Obtained a one out one back trail approaching the 1000 metre point.

THE DEAL – Held up until the later stages of the home straight, prior to utilising the sprint lane and finishing strongly.

MONDOOLEY MACH – Three wide, one back from the 1000 metre point.

HEZ RAZOR SHARP - Three wide, two back from the 1000 metre point.

RACE 5 – LADBROKES PACE – 2090 METRES

LORIMERMAJOR – When racing behind the leader approaching the final turn, commenced to take an inside run when the leader shifted up the track and then eased back to a trailing position shortly thereafter.

MONTANA STORM NZ – Led then surrendered the lead approaching the 1500 metre point. The gelding was immediately shifted out to lead the one wide line.

ENDEAVOUR STRIDE – Led the one wide line until working forward to take over the lead near the 1500 metre point. Hung out briefly approaching the final turn when leading then corrected by its driver. When questioned regarding ENDEAVOUR STRIDE challenging for the lead and taking over in a fast lead time of 33.9 seconds, driver Mr P Hill told Stewards that he gave ENDEAVOUR STRIDE a couple of light taps with the whip coming out of the gate, with the intention of taking up the position leading the one wide line. He went on to say once reaching that position, when he attempted to restrain ENDEAVOUR STRIDE, the gelding commenced to contact its own sulky wheels and as a result it commenced to severely overrace. He further added that at that stage the horse pulled its way towards the lead, eventually crossing over near the 1500 metre point. He added that the gelding continued to contact its own sulky wheels throughout the majority of the race prior to giving ground to finish in 7th position, beaten 14.3 metres. Stewards advised Mr Hill that they would be noting his explanation. Trainer Mr B Yole was advised to take whatever action is necessary to avoid a repeat of ENDEAVOUR STRIDE contacting its own sulky wheels.

KOSIMO - Commenced a three wide run from towards the rear of the field near the 1200 metre point.

KIVIK – Raced three wide for the first 450 metre prior to dropping into a one out one back position.

JOBELLS IMAGE – Three wide, one back from the 1200 metre point.

RACE 6 – HAPPY 70TH BIRTHDAY WAYNE YOLE PACE – 2090 METRES

EYE SEE DOUBLE – Gave ground over the concluding stages.

BE MAJOR THREAT – Led the one wide line prior to being restrained to a trailing position after 350 metres. The gelding was then taken away from the peg line to take up the position leading the one wide line approaching the 1500 metre point.

RACE 7 – LINDISFARNE JUNIOR FOOTBALL CLUB PACE– 2090 METRES

LOCKAWAY KACIE – Led for the first 400 metres prior to surrendering the lead.

HEZ THE ONE – Worked forward from the position outside the leader to take over the lead after 400 metres.

KARDESLER NZ - Caught racing three wide for the first 400 metres whilst being restrained to the rear of the field.

SOMEDAN – Commenced a three wide run near the 1100 metres.

REIGN OF PAIN - Three wide one back from the 1100 metres.

AHA REACTION NZ – Three wide two back from the 1100 metres. Placed back in the draw in mobile barrier races.

RACE 8 – CLUBS TASMANIA PACE – 2090 METRES

COOLHAND EASTON NZ - Showed gate speed to lead the event.

GIPSY TREASURE - Three wide one back from the 1100 metres.

SCOTLYNN BEACH NZ – Commenced a three wide run near the 1100 metres.

THE DUDE NZ – Broke in the score up and was out of position when the start was effected. After considering submissions made by driver Ms T Ford and subsequently by trainer Mr B Yole Stewards placed THE DUDE NZ out of the draw in mobile barrier races.
