HARNESS RACING STEWARDS REPORT

Trainers with multiple runners engaged in any race were questioned as to their intended driving tactics.

Due to a significant delay caused by the false start in Race 1 the starting times for all races were rescheduled back one race with the starting time for Race 7 rescheduled to 8.55 pm.

RACE 1 – VINCENT FUNERAL SERVICES MAIDEN – 2180 METRES MS

A false start was declared at the first attempt when the mobile barrier lost power as the start was effected. THE MIGHTY DOC fell as a result. The mobile barrier was subsequently retested on a number of occasions with the problem rectified. All horses underwent veterinary inspections subsequent to the false start resulting in THE MIGHTY DOC being declared a late scratching on veterinary advice at 5:40PM, the gelding having sustained gravel grazes over the left carpus with associated swelling. All other runners were passed fit to start. C Hayes, the driver of THE MIGHTY DOC, was examined by medical staff with no injuries reported.

ALKATRAZ – Led and withstood an early challenge for the lead.

NORTHERN STRIDE – Mounted an unsuccessful early challenge for the lead prior to being restrained to a peg line trailing position.

BOLD CENTURIAN – Broke gear and then broke stride with three laps to travel. Again broke near the 1200 metres and was retired from the race by its driver due to the broken gear. On review of the official race videos and the evidence of the observing Steward who confirmed the gear had broken prior to the horse breaking stride no action was taken against BOLD CENTURIAN.

INCOGNITO – Raced in a one out trailing position until being left leading the one wide line near the 1900 metres.

THE MIGHTY DOC – Late scratching at 5.40 pm due to an injury sustained as a result of the false start. Stewards ordered that all bets placed on THE MIGHTY DOC be refunded and all win bets paid less 21 cents in the dollar and all place bets be paid less 22 cents in the dollar. A veterinary examination of THE MIGHTY DOC revealed the gelding to have sustained Acting on veterinary advice THE MIGHTY DOC has been stood down pending a veterinary certificate.

RACE 2 – HARVEY NORMAN ELECTRICAL BURNIE PACE – 1892 METRES SS

A false start was declared at the first attempt when the barrier strand wrapped around a front leg of GOOD FEELINGS.

OZZIE MAJOR - Galloped away - no action taken due to the significant delay due to a false start.

IDEAL INVESTMENT – Galloped out – no action taken due to the significant delay subsequent to a false start. Raced four wide from the 700 metres.

ARTIFLASH – Galloped out losing significant ground - No action taken due to the significant delay subsequent to a false start. Tired over the concluding stages – no action taken A post race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities.

MAJOR DAVVIN - Commenced a three wide run from the 700 metres.

General

Stewards questioned Steven Davis, driver of MAJOR DAVVIN, and Troy McDonald driver of IDEAL INVESTMENT, regarding the reason for IDEAL INVESTMENT racing 4 wide from approximately the 700 metres. After taking evidence from the drivers, viewing official race videos and giving regard to their own observations Stewards ascertained that just entering the home straight Mr Davis shifted from a one wide to a three wide position and momentarily prior to Mr McDonald commencing a run from the rear of MAJOR DAVVIN with IDEAL INVESTMENT then obliged to race four wide thereafter. Stewards also considered that the line of horses preceding MAJOR DAVVIN appeared to be racing wider up the track than is usual. As the head on video was unavailable the Stewards could not be comfortably satisfied that MAJOR DAVVIN had been the cause of IDEAL INVESTMENT racing four wide and therefore Stewards gave Mr Davis the benefit of the doubt on this occasion and no further action was taken.

RACE 3 – RELAY FOR LIFE PACE – 2500 METRES SS

ON MY OATH – Led and withstood an early challenge for the lead.

CHRISTIAN MAJOR – Raced in a mid field trailing position until shifting out to lead the one wide line near the 2200 metres. Obtained a one out one back trail near the 2000 metres.

CHRIS BE QUICK – Galloped out – placed out of the draw in standing start races. Raced three wide one back from the 1000 metres.

PERFECT MACH – Led the one wide line and issued an unsuccessful early challenge for the lead prior to restraining to the position behind the leader after 400 metres. Tired over the concluding stages. A post race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities. Stood down from racing until the completion of a satisfactory requalifying trial.

GO IN STYLE – Left leading the one wide line after 400 metres.

MICTON MOUSE – Galloped out. This being the gelding's first start after qualifying for a standing start, Stewards placed the gelding out of the draw in standing start races.

OUR SIR OLIVER – Galloped out – placed out of the draw in standing start races. Commenced a three wide run from towards the rear of the field near the 1000 metres.

LETS SAVE THE DAY NZ – Reared at the start then galloped away. Placed on its last chance in the draw in standing start races.

VIGOROSO NZ - Galloped out and will continue out of the draw in standing start races.

HEZ THE ONE - Galloped out then inconvenienced after the start. Will continue to be placed out of the draw in standing start races.

RACE 4 – BILLING CRANES MOBILE – 2180 METRES

BENJAMIN NIADH – Lead then surrendered the lead after 250 metres.

STAR ROCKER - Worked forward from outside the leader to take over the lead after 250 metres.

AUNTY BESSY – Momentarily tightened on the first turn by the runner to its outside hanging in slightly.

DOLLARSIGN – Commenced a 3 wide run from the rear of the field near the 700 metres. Gave ground over the concluding stages.

REDFOX RAIDER – Raced in a trailing position until shifting out to lead the one wide line near the 1800 metres. Pulled hard throughout the middle stages. Commenced to tire from the 500 metres ultimately being beaten in

excess of 180 metres. Stewards ordered a post race veterinary examination of the gelding failed to reveal any abnormalities. This horse is stood down from racing until the completion of a satisfactory trial.

RACE 5 - LADBROKES PACE - 2180 METRES SS

ROCKS ROY – Galloped away. Placed on its last chance in the draw in standing start races. Failed to obtain a clear run to the finish - untested.

LIVINONTHEEDGE – Galloped out. As this was the gelding's first start after a qualifier it has been placed out of the draw in standing start races. Commenced a three wide run in the middle stages of the race to work forward to the position leading the one wide line near 650 metres. Raced roughly in the back straight on the final occasion.

VONNS ANGEL – Led then broke free of interference entering the home straight with three laps to travel then broke again free of interference entering the home straight with 700 metres to travel. Stewards ordered that VONS ANGEL be stood down from racing until the completion of a satisfactory trial.

JUST FOR DAVE – Raced in a one out one back trailing position until gaining an inside run to work forward to the lead entering the front straight with 3 laps to travel.

IM QUITE AMERICAN – Had a tendency to over race when leading the one wide line. Commenced to tire from the 600 metres ultimately being beaten in excess of 107 metres. Stewards ordered a post race veterinary examination of the gelding which revealed.

DEVIL OF TYNE - Checked as the stat was effected. Raced three wide two back from the 650 metres.

AITUTAKI – Galloped out and will continue to be placed out of the draw in standing start races. Gave ground over the concluding stages. Placed on its last chance to race competitively.

SMILE LYLE – Led the three wide line from the 650 metres. Placed back in the draw in standing start races.

LIVE FOR PEACE – Galloped out and will continue right out of the draw in standing start races. Raced three wide one back from the 650 metres.

General

Stewards will question T Rattray, driver of KABIBI, and M Yole, driver of LIVINONTHEEDGE regarding the reason for the latter horse racing roughly in the back straight on the final occasion.

RACE 6 - CHOICES FLOORING MOBILE - 2180 METRES

The all clear for this race was delayed to afford Mark Yole driver of second placed GOT THE GOODS to view the official race videos to determine whether the inside sulky wheel of the winner MACH CHARM had contacted or gone inside marker pegs entering the home straight on the final occasion. After viewing the official videos Mr Yole was satisfied that MACH CHARM had not contacted on gone inside marker pegs and the all clear was given on the Judges numbers.

HYDE PARK – Led then hung out under pressure on the final turn - a warning was issued. Contacted the sulky wheel of another runner when racing in tight quarters in the home straight on the final occasion and raced roughly.

BOOKER BAY – Had a tendency to over race when leading the one wide line throughout. Gave ground over the concluding sages.

MACH CHARM – Obtained an inside run entering the home straight on the final occasion.

GOT THE GOODS - Commenced a three wide run from towards the rear of the field near the 800 metres.

RAFFAS ACE – Out of position when the start was effected – placed on its last chance in the draw in mobile barrier races. Raced three wide one back from the 800 metres.

LITTLEBITOFMAGIC – Well out of position when the start was effected - will continue to be placed out of the draw in mobile barrier races. Three wide two back from the 800 metres.

RACE 7 – BECOME A MEMBER PACE – 2180 METRES SS

HEIDI GO SEEK – Galloped out – placed out of the draw in standing start races. Three wide two back from the 500 metres.

JAKES A JOY – Stood flat-footed then galloped away – continue out of the draw in standing start races.

BRIGHTON PRINCE – Galloped out – continue out of the draw in standing start races.

MY ULTIMATE MAJOR – Placed back in the standing start draw.

KEEP PLAYING – Three wide from the 800 metres.

MONDOOLEY MACH - Failed to obtain a clear run to the finish - untested.

JOEY GIRL – Failed to obtain a clear run to the finish – untested.

HEZA RUMMAGE NZ – Three wide one back from the 800 metres.
