RACE 1 – LADBROKES MATES MODE BM70 HCP (2100 METRES)

CREATIVE HERO – Brushed with ONE LOTTO at the start. Rider T Johnstone pleaded guilty to a charge under the provisions of AR132(7)(a)(ii) in that she used her whip on eleven occasions prior to the 100 metres, six more than permitted. When assessing penalty stewards took into account her good record in relation to the rule and her guilty plea. Rider T Johnstone was fined the sum of \$250 and was advised of her right of appeal.

ONE LOTTO – Brushed with CREATIVE HERO at the start. Raced three wide throughout. Stewards queried rider D Pires in relation to his riding instructions. Rider D Pires stated it was intentions to race handy but was unable to when HELLOT pushed forward, leaving him travelling three wide. A post race veterinary examination revealed boils on the wither.

BOND STREET BEAU – Over raced early stages, momentarily held up at about the 400 metres.

RACE 2 - KEVIN SHARKIE MAIDEN 3YO & UP (1100 METRES)

STEEL MIST – Slow to begin, laid in rounding the home turn and had to be steadied off the heels of SCARDIMALIA.

LITTLE LIONEL – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was cleared to race, slow to begin, brushed the rail near the 750 metres and then shifted inwards

going through the running rail. When questioned rider C Baker stated that when attempting to settle the gelding it shifted in abruptly, going through the rail dislodging her. Trainer S Brunton was advised that the gelding must complete a satisfactory trial prior to racing again. A post race veterinary examination failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities. Rider C Baker was stood down for the remainder of the meeting by the on-course doctor and was reassessed at the end of the day and was given all clear to fulfill her riding engagements scheduled at Launceston the following day.

REMUDA – Declared a late scratching at 11.12am when barrier staff were unable to load the gelding. Stewards will advise trainer G White that the gelding must complete two consecutive satisfactory trials prior to racing again. Stewards ordered that the following deductions apply to all winning bets prior to 11.12am

1ST - 10 SCARDIMALIA 44 cents Win – 21 cents Place 2ND - 3 STEEL MIST - 30 cents Place 3RD - 8 GONE GLOBAL - 27 cents Place

A LITTLE SHADY - Brushed with MISS CHICA MALA after the start.

GONE GLOBAL – Raced three wide throughout without cover.

LITTLE RIVER MISS – Over raced early stages. Under-went a post-race veterinary examination which failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities.

SCARDIMALIA – Raced wide throughout.

MISS CHICA MAIA - Brushed with A LITTLE SHADY after the start.

RACE 3 – MCTAS PROPERTIES BM68 HCP – (1100 METRES)

JAJA CHABOOGIE – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

GEE GEE TRUE STORY – Raced wide throughout.

ZIAVERA – Rider M Ulucinar became unbalanced shortly after jumping when the mare dropped its head, resulting in the mare being slow to muster early speed.

BARIA – Over-raced middle stages.

NEUTRALIZE – Slow to begin, shifted out under pressure at about the 150 metres.

RACE 4 – LADBROKES IT! MAIDEN/CLASS 1 – (1600 METRES)

EXPENSIVE MISTAKE – Declared a late scratching at 9.47am on veterinary advice, after being found to be lame in the near side fore and abrasions to the offside hind. Trainer S Brunton was advised a veterinary clearance would be required prior to racing again. Stewards ordered that the following deductions apply to all winning bets prior to 9.47am

1st - 4 - EAGLE STREET - Win 20cents - Place 17cents

EAGLE STREET – Restrained off the heels of SPEED ROCK which had shifted out rounding the home straight, was the disappointed for a run between SMASHING HIT which laid in and SPEED ROCK which had rolled out marginally.

SMASHING HIT – Laid in in the home straight, warning has been placed on the mare as it was difficult to load.

RACE 5 – GRAHAM FAMILY FUNERALS CLASS 1 HCP – (1200 METRES)

HAPPY CLAN – Slow to begin, raced wide rounding the home turn.

GEE GEE SNOWFLAKE – Over raced middle stages.

PUNK PRINCESS - Over raced early stages.

RACE 6 – TERRY MCALLISTER MEMORIAL BM60 HCP - (1000 METRES)

OUTBOUND – Jumped outwards at the start and was slow to muster early speed. Rider B McCoull pleaded guilty to a charge under the provisions of AR132(7)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on eleven occasions prior to the 100 metres, six more than permitted. When assessing penalty stewards took into account his record in relation to the rule and his guilty plea. And that he had not used his whip over the final 100 metres. Rider B McCoull was fined the sum of \$400 and was advised of his right of appeal. Rider B McCoull was reprimanded under the provisions of AR132(7)(a)(i) in that he used his whip on consecutive strides prior to the 100 metres on one occasion.

KOHIMA – A post race veterinary examination failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities. Trainer C Thompson advised it was his intentions to have blood tests taken from the gelding and he would advise stewards of the results.

COPPER CHARM – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

TAPPA PASS – Raced wide throughout. Rider G Catania was queried on the poor performance of the mare. Rider G Catania stated that when placing the mare under pressure that it failed to respond to her riding. A post race veterinary examination failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities. Trainer S Cotton advised stewards that the mare would now be returned to its owners. A satisfactory trial must be completed prior to racing again for poor performance.

RACE 7 - MCDONALDS NORTH HOBART BM60 HCP - (1390 METRES)

POPEYE THE SAILOR – Stewards questioned rider T Johnstone in relation to the below market performance of the gelding. Rider T Johnstone stated that the saddle had slipped shortly after the start placing her at a disadvantage throughout the race. Rider T Johnstone also advised stewards that she had dropped her whip near the 200 metres. Rider T Johnstone was advised that she must ensure that on returning to scale that she advises stewards of anything that may affect the performance of her mounts in races in future.

LUCKY LIL – Declared a late scratching at 12.11pm due to no available apprentice

being available. Stewards ordered that the following deductions apply to all winning bets prior to 12.11pm.

1ST - 8 STELLADONI 14 cents Win – 13 cents Place 2ND - 5 NICCO THE GREEK 11 cents Place 3RD - 4 RAVAGE 16 cents Place

NICCO THE GREEK – Shifted in under pressure in the home straight.

WORDS OF PRIDE – Raced wide throughout. A post race veterinary examination failed to reveal any obvious abnormality. Trainer S Cotton advised stewards it is her intentions to now retire the mare. The mare must complete a satisfactory trial prior to racing again for poor performance.

MOSHAMA – Slow to begin.

THE BEEKEEPER – Over raced in the early stages, shifted out under pressure near the 200 metres. Rider I Toker pleaded guilty to a charge under the provisions of AR132(7)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on nine occasions prior to the 100 metres, four more than permitted. When assessing penalty stewards took into account his record in relation to the rule and his guilty plea. Rider I Toker was fined the sum of \$400 and was advised of his right of appeal. Rider I Toker also pleaded guilty to a charge under the provisions of AR132(7)(a)(i) in that he used his whip on consecutive strides on two occasions prior to the 100 metres. When assessing penalty stewards took into account his guilty plea and his record under this rule. Rider I Toker was fined the sum of \$200. Rider I Toker was reminded of his right of appeal.

ZOUSTORM - Slow to begin, raced wide throughout.
