Comments / Explanations:

Rider C Atkinson was indisposed for today's meeting due to illness. Rider C Atkinson will be required to provide a medical clearance prior to riding again.

Trainer J Blacker was fined the sum of \$100 under the provisions of LR13.3. for late rider declarations for PAGE and COSTERO in race 1.

Jockey D Ganderton was transported to hospital after Race 6. Jockey D Ganderton will be advised that he will be required to provide a medical clearance prior to riding again.

RACE 1 – LADBROKES BLENDED BETS – BM68 HCP - (2100 METRES)

MAINCOURT – Jumped out at the start.

PAGE – Inconvenienced on jumping. Bumped near the 1200 metres.

JOHN'S LAD – Failed to stretch out in the early stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

COSTERO – Inconvenienced near the 1200 metres.

RACE 2 - RON RILEY TTC LIFE MEMBER MAIDEN - (1600 METRES)

Prior to the declaration of correct weight, Jockey S Carr (FALCULA) viewed the patrol footage in the home straight to ascertain if there were grounds for an objection. After viewing the patrol footage, S Carr was satisfied and correct weight was declared.

COUP DE SPRY – Improved performance queried. Trainer L Gray advised that she was satisfied with the gelding's run last start and was expecting a forward showing tonight after drawing a favourable barrier draw.

FREDDY'SAJETSTAR – A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

FALCULA – Held up approaching and rounding the home turn. Held up for clear running in the early part of the home straight. Tightened passing the winning post by COUP DE SPRY (T Doyle) which shifted in. T Doyle was advised to exercise more care.

LADY SARAH – A post-race veterinary examination revealed a small laceration over the near hind cannon.

WANING WEASEL – Began awkwardly and was hampered shortly after. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

MISS PECULIAR – Approaching the home turn was steadied when crowded between LADY SARAH, shifted in marginally and COUP DE SPRY, which shifted out marginally.

SPEEDYPIN – Began awkwardly and was slow into stride. Stewards inquired into an incident near the 100 metres where the filly appeared to blunder severely. After hearing evidence from Apprentice C Baker, it was established that near the 100m the filly was disappointed for clear running obliging apprentice C Baker to shift out abruptly to obtain clear running and in doing she struck the near hind leg of the LADY SARAH. Apprentice C Baker was severely reprimanded under the provisions of AR131(a) Careless riding for allowing her mount to shift out when insufficiently clear of the heels of LADY SARAH. In not taking further action, Stewards were mindful of the racing manners of SPEEDYPIN. Trainer B McShane was advised that a warning was placed on the record of the filly for hanging in and racing greenly. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

RACE 3 – MELISSA WIMMER SCHOOL OF DANCING MAIDEN – (1100 METRES)

SQUAZEEMOTO – Began awkwardly.

STEEL MIST – Slow to muster in the early stages.

SUSHI EXPRESS – Fractious in the parade ring. Trainer G Hodges was advised that a warning would be placed on the record of the gelding. Began awkwardly and contacted the inside barrier partition on jumping.

GEEGEES GEMSTONE – Raced very greenly and shifted in when placed under pressure in the home straight.

GEEGESPOWERPLUS – Steadied rounding the home turn when FULL ZULU shifted in marginally. Jockey B Muchu advised that the mare hung out from the 600 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

MINDFUL – Slow to muster in the early stages.

GEEGEES HISWORD – Raced wide throughout. Shifted in when placed under pressure in the home straight.

RACE 4 – RAYNER TRANSPORT CONQUERING 14^{TH} DECEMBER BM62 HCP – (1100 METRES)

HANNAH'S SONG – Tightened on jumping.

WARICA – Tightened on jumping.

GEEGEE JET BY – Began awkwardly and shifted in.

OUTBOUND – Raced wide and without cover in the early stages. Performed below expectations. Rider B McCoull advised could provide no explanation for the poor performance. A post veterinary examination revealed slow post race recovery.

ARTUSO – Began awkwardly.

FAIRY MAGIC – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after being kicked behind the barriers and was passed suitable to start.

GEE GEE GOLDENLASS – Slow to begin. Overraced in the early stages.

RACE 5 - CRAIG HANSON MEMORIAL BM76 HCP - (1100 METRES)

OUR LITTLE TED – Had difficulty obtaining clear running from the 200m and was obliged to shift out nearing the 100m in order to obtain clear running.

CORONATION KEITH – Began awkwardly and shifted out. Briefly held up rounding the home turn.

RACE 6 – ALISON ARCHER TTC LIFE MEMBER CLASS 1 HCP - (1200 METRES)

DID YOU DECIDE – Laid in when placed under pressure in the home straight.

DOMINATOR'S GIRL – Held up for clear running until near the 100m.

ROCK'EM BABY – Near the 200m appeared to blunder and fell, dislodging its rider D Ganderton. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a compound dislocation of th off fore fetlock. The mare was humanely euthanised. Jockey D Ganderton was transported to Launceston General Hospital for observation.

MAGIC TYPHOON – Near the 100m had to be steadied when awkwardly placed on the heels of DID YOU DECIDE (H McCarthy) which shifted in when placed under pressure. H McCarthy

was advised to exercise more care in future. Unable to be fully tested thereafter when awkwardly placed on heels.

SHAMZOU – Hampered by the fallen horse near the 200 metres.

RACE 7 - LADBROKES CARD BM62 HCP - (1400 METRES)

MR FREEZE – Overraced in the early and middle stages. Raced wide throughout. Performed below expectations. Apprentice T Johnstone reported that the after racing wide throughout the gelding was disappointed. She further added that in her opinion the gelding failed to handle the Good (4) track conditions tonight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the near fore. Trainer G White was advised that a veterinary clearance would be required prior to racing again.

ALPINE AVIATOR – Overraced in the early and middle stages. Held up rounding and in the early part of the home straight.

IRIS WEST – Jockey T Baker reported that something may have been amiss with the mare. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

MARIPOSA – A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

HERMAN'S BELLS – Raced wide throughout.

RACE 8 – CONGRATULATIONS THE INEVITABLE CONNECTIONS CLASS 1 HCP – (1400 METRES)

LION'S TOOTH – Laid in when placed under pressure in the home straight.

SAXON MIST – Near the 1200m had to be momentarily steadied when awkwardly placed on the heels of CORONATION VERONIC (S Carr) which shifted in when not clear. S Carr was advised to exercise more care. Near the 100m was steadied when awkwardly placed on the heels of LION'S TOOTH.

LABBY ROCK – Fractious in the barriers, a warning was issued, over raced in the middle stages. Post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

ANOTHER PREDICTION – Declared a late scratching at 9:46pm after a veterinary examination revealed the mare to be unsuitable to race after being fractious in the barriers. Trainer P Hill was advised that the mare would be required to trial prior to racing again. All monies invested on the mare were ordered to be refunded in full of the following deductions.
