Race 1 –J & S MUIR MEMORIAL MAIDEN

MISS CUMBERLAND was a late scratching at 12:40pm after becoming fractious and rearing in the parade area dislodging rider J Gibbons. Mr Gibbons was uninjured. Connections were advised that MISS CUMBERLAND has been placed on its last chance with respect to its manners and tractability.

AVIDA was a late scratching at 12:46pm after becoming fractious in the barriers and striking its head: Connections were advised that a warning had been placed on the mare with respect to its barrier manners.

After the field had been dispatched AVIDA escaped from the Clerk of the Course and galloped back riderless in the direction of the field. AVIDA remained on the outside of the track and passed the balance of the field near the 200 metres and was recaptured shortly after. The Stewards addressed containment of horses with the appropriate track personnel.

NODDLE SOUP – gave ground over the concluding stages.

Race 2 -KING ISLAND STOCKFEEDS CLASS A HCP

BROTHER BOOMER – began awkwardly and got back.

MAYWYN IS THE WORD – made the turn near the 750 metres awkwardly when leading and became briefly unbalanced.

VOODOO MOON – held up for a short distance past the 350 metres.

Race 3 - OCEAN DUNES GOLF COURSE MAIDEN

LENY'S READY – slow in the early stages.

DISCLEVABOY – travelled wide throughout.

Race 4 - DOWLING MCCARTHY TYRES CLASS B HCP

AFRIDI – slow to begin; made the final turn awkwardly.

Race 5 - KING ISLAND MOTORS MAIDEN

MAKE FALSE REPORT - became fractious after being loaded away with rider B Neto sustaining a leg injury. MAKE FALSE REPORT was declared a late scratching at 4:16pm. Mr Neto was examined by the on-course medical personal post-race who reported bruising to his legs but otherwise no injury.

MAYORAL PRIVILEGES – began awkwardly and got back.

TYSON'S REEF – raced wide through the early stages.
