Comments / Explanations:

Rider M Ulucinar was dislodged from his horse after the running of Race 4 and was stood down by medical staff for the remainder of his rides. Rider M Ulucinar must provide a medical clearance prior to riding again.

RACE 1 – GOODSTONE GROUP MAIDEN – (1350 METRES)

A LITTLE DECEIT – Very slow to begin and shortly after contacted the outside barrier partition. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be coughing.

BAHIA BAY – Over-raced in the middle stages.

KREGLINGER – Shifted in and away from PINANDI near the 200 metres.

MOORBOOZIE – Raced wide and without cover in the early and middle stages.

PINANDI – Laid in when placed under pressure near the 200 metres and had to be steadied.

RISIST CAPTURE – Slow to begin and shortly after was crowded.

SAKURA HIME – Raced wide and without cover in the early and middle stages.

REWARD FOR ROSIE – Over-raced in the middle stages and had to be restrained off heels near the 900 metres. Performed below market expectations. Rider A Darmanin explained that the mare failed to quicken when placed under pressure and was disappointing. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

Rider A Darmanin (REWARD FOR ROSIE) pleaded guilty to a charge under the provisions of AR132(7)(a)(ii) for using his whip on consecutive occasions twice prior to the 100 metres.

RACE 2 – LENDING4U 2YO & 3YO MAIDEN – (1150 METRES)

GENERAL ASSEMBLY – Held by a barrier attendant on jumping, resulting in the gelding missing the start by a considerable margin. Prior to the declaration of correct weight stewards inquired into the matter to determine if the gelding had been afforded a fair start. After considering evidence from all parties, it was determined that the gelding had been held by a barrier attendant as the start was affected, resulting in it missing the start by approximately three lengths.

On the announcement of correct weight stewards ordered that all monies invested on GENERAL ASSEMBLY be refunded, with the following deductions to apply to successful wagers placed prior to 11:51am.

Deductions

(1st) GOLDEN MEADOW – 11 cents a win & 9 cents a place

(2nd) SHE PLAYS GAMES – 13 cents a place

(3rd) KIREINA MARUBRAH – 8 cents a place

All monies bet after the withdrawal to be paid at face value of the ticket.

LIGHTNING HAMMER – Steadied near the 400 metres when awkwardly placed on the heels of GENERAL ASSEMBLY.

OLI ALPINE – Raced four wide without cover throughout. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

ANUDDASTORM – Raced wide throughout.

GEEGEES EASYRIDER – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination behind the barriers and was passed suitable to start.

ZELDEE – Rider D Parish reported that her saddle slipped near the 800 metres placing her at a disadvantage throughout. Raced wide throughout.

ALPINE VISTA – Very fractious in the barriers. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and deemed unsuitable to start. Declared a late scratching at 11.51am on veterinary advice after becoming fractious in barriers and hitting its head. On the announcement of correct weight Stewards ordered that all monies invested on ALPINE VISTA to be refunded, with the following deductions to apply to successful wagers placed prior to 11.51am. Trainer T Hanson was advised that the gelding must complete a satisfactory trial prior to racing again.

Deductions

(1st) GOLDEN MEADOW – 14 cents a win & 12 cents a place

(2nd) SHE PLAYS GAMES – 18 cents a place

(3rd) KIREINA MARUBRAH – 11 cents a place

All monies bet after the withdrawal to be paid at face value of the ticket.

GOLDEN MEADOW – Hampered on jumping.

KIREINA MARUBRAH – Shied away from the fractious horse in the barrier and as a result harmlessly dislodged rider A Darmanin. Over-raced in the middle stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

RACE 3 – LADBROKE 4U 2Y0 & 3YO MAIDEN – (1150 METRES)

CAPTAIN CAM – Raced in restricted room near the 200 metres.

FLYING BILLIE – Jumped awkwardly. Steadied off heels near the 700 metres, steadied entering the home turn.

STEAKS 'R' HIGH – Tightened on jumping.

MISS CHICA MALA – Raced wide and without cover throughout. Near the 200 metres laid and shifted in further when its rider applied the whip. D Pires was advised to exercise more care. Performed below market expectations. Rider D Pires reported that the filly resented the kickback and did not handle the synthetic track today.

SHA'ARAWI – Near the 200 metres had to be steadied when MISS CHICA MALA shifted in. Rider D Ganderton reported that filly raced very greenly throughout.

RACE 4 – KEVIN SHARKIE MAIDEN – (1009 METRES)

POP A HONDA – Hung in when placed under pressure in the home straight.

ALPINE LEGEND – Over raced in the middle stages. Near the 100 metres had to be momentarily steadied when LITTLE SAL (App C Wells) shifted out when not entirely clear. App C Wells was advised to exercise more are.

PROSPEROUS MISS – Raced very wide in the middle stages.

WESTERN TEARS – Began awkwardly and slow to begin. Over raced and hung out throughout.

RACE 5 – TASMANIAN HORSE TRANSPORT MDN/CL1 – (1880 METRES)

AFRICAN THUNDER – Had to be checked near the 100 metres. Upon inquiry it was established that near the 100 metres, CHI MAZEL shifted out marginally and PUMA shifted in marginally, resulting in AFRICAN THUNDER having to be checked. As Stewards could not be satisfied that any one rider was careless, the matter was deemed a racing incident.

CHI MAZEL – Over raced in the lead in the early and middle stages.

HAMPTON BAY – Raced wide and without cover in the early and middle stages.

POET WARRIOR – Laid in when placed under pressure in the home straight before being corrected near the 200 metres.

GEEGEELOCKDOWN – Bumped on jumping. Raced wide and without cover in the early and middle stages.

RACE 6 – GREAT NORTHERN BM60 HCP – (1650 METRES)

ALPINE AVIATOR – Tactics queried. Rider D Pires explained that his instructions were to lead today however if there was pace early, he was content to settle in a handy position. D Pires went on to further explain that after obtaining the lead FAST THINKER improved to his outside which resulted in his horse commencing to over race. He further added that during the middle stages his mount continued to over race which resulted in a strong tempo being set during the middle stages. D Pires further explained that in hindsight, he may have been better off allowing his mount to maintain this tempo from the 600 metres noting that in his opinion the gelding is very one paced.

DARGO – Slow to begin.

EIGHT MARGARITAS – Rider A Darmanin reported that the mare hung out throughout and that he had actions with concerns with its action over the concluding stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed stiffness in the nearside neck.

GEE GEE SILENTNITE – Raced wide throughout.

RACE 7 – SERIES ELECTRICAL + SOLAR BM64 HCP - (1150 METRES)

NEED TO BE UNIQUE – Raced wide and without cover throughout.

FAR AWAY HIT – Had difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 100 metres.

QUICKEN UP – Near the 200 metres had to be steadied when awkwardly placed on the heels of GEEGEE'S HISWORD (D Pires) which shifted in when under riding. Rider D Pires was reprimanded for careless riding.

TILTHEREWARSYOU – Declared a late scratching at 2:02pm due to no rider being available.

WOLF REIN – Slow to begin. Held up in the early part of the home straight and again near the 100 metres.

BERRUTI – Over raced in the middle stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

Rider D Pires (GEEGEE'S HISWORD) was reprimanded under the provisions of AR131(a) careless riding for allowing his mount to shift in at about the 200 metres when not fully clear of QUICKEN UP, which had to be steadied by its rider.

RACE 8 – THAI IMPERIAL CLASS 1 HCP – (1350 METRES)

MIRROR ONE NZ – Slow to begin.

SLIPSLOPSLAP – Began awkwardly and was slow into stride.

NO ACCESS – Over raced in the middle stages.

DUMPUS – Slow to begin.

MISIRLOU – Rider D Ganderton reported that the mare was making abnormal repository noises throughout the run and in his opinion the mare may have choked down. Trainer G Stevenson advised that the mare had pulled up well and was eating in the morning and that he was currently assessing the mare's racing future.

FURTHER SHE GOES – Raced wide and without cover throughout.

RACE 9 – HOPE IN A SUITCASE CLASS 3 HCP (1350 METRES)

POWER MAGNUM – Over raced in the early stages, carried wide rounding the home turn.

STEEL MIST – Slow to begin and shortly after was hampered, over-raced in the early stages.

SILVER PERSUASION – Slow to begin.

ZADE'S STORIES – Raced wide and without cover throughout. Rider T Baker reported that the mare over raced and hung out throughout. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.
