### **RACE 1 – FEHLBERGS PRODUCE SPRINTLANE PACE – 1609 Mobile**

*The start of this event was delayed approximately 2 ½ minutes due to connections unable to find sulkies for COVEFFE HUSTLER, and BRIAN WHO. Ultimately, BRIAN WHO was declared a late scratching from the event at 5:50pm. Connections were advised a further inquiry into the circumstances surrounding the reasons of no sulky being available for use.*

**COVEFFE HUSTLER** – Lost its near side rein burr near the 200 metres.

### **RACE 2 LADBROKES SAME RACE MULTI PACE – 2090m Mobile**

**MODERN JIVE** – Hung in under pressure, contacting marker pegs during the run, particularly on the home turn.

**ANGELSHAVTIME NZ** – Dropped a near side shin/tendon boot shortly after the start was affected.

**TWILIGHT BEACH** – Held up for clear running in the early stages of the home straight in run to the finish.

### **RACE 3 – LADBROKES ODDS SURGE PACE – 2090m Mobile**

**A SHADOW OF DOUBT** – Raced wide in the early stages of the event, before working forward to lead the event. Pulled hard and tending to over-race.

#### **RACE 4 – PRYDES EASIFEED PACE – 2090m Mobile**

**COUGAR EXPRESS NZ** – Tended to hang out, and pull hard.

**JUSTIFY** – Over-raced throughout the event.

**TWILIGHT BONNIE NZ** – Began to give ground at or around the 600 metres to be beaten in excess of 75 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed poor overall condition, along with loose manure, and stocked up fetlock joints. Stewards, acting under Veterinary advice, stood TWILIGHT BONNIE NZ down from racing or trialing until a veterinary clearance is received.

#### **RACE 5 – MOREY’S TOURS PACE – 1609m Mobile**

**NAPATTACK SAM** – Raced roughly in the early stages, and hung in, resulting its sulky wheel striking marker posts near the 1200 metres. Contacted marker pegs again before utilizing the sprint lane in the run to the finish.

**SCRUB BASHER** – Broke gait free of interference leaving the 400 metres. Connections were advised the gelding would be required to trial on one (1) occasion to the satisfaction of stewards before racing again.

**DEADLY ASSASSIN** – Hung in shortly after the start. Over-raced throughout.

**KIAVINO STRIDE** – Over-raced and pulled hard throughout.
