General – All advertised start times were adjusted due to the abandonment of the Newcastle Harness meeting and to fit the Sky 1 schedule

RACE 1 – LADBROKES QUICK MULTI PACE – 1680m Mobile

POST LAZARUS – Broke gait running out of the back straight on the first occasion, placed on its last chance to race truly

General: Steward queried the driving tactics employed by DYLAN FORD (HORATIUS SPECULO) in particular his reasons for not moving to a three-wide position in advance of POST LAZARUS with a lap to run. Mr Ford put forward that he was mindful that the slow sectionals early were going to make it difficult for him to make ground late out wide on the track. He also put forward that the horse was racing first up from a break and that he

would not have been suited to making a long-sustained run at this stage of his preparation. Stewards noted the explanation

General: Stewards reprimanded driver Mitch Ford under rule 159A(1)(a)(i) for not having his helmet strap done up when entering the parade ring and going onto the track.

RACE 2 – TASSIE WASH STAKES – 1680m Mobile

ANGELSHAVETIME – Held up for clear running early in the home straight

ARMA ROLLING STONE - Held up for clear running early in the home straight

GOBSMACKED – Held up for clear running in the home straight

RACE 3 – NUTRIEN SUPPLIES STAKES – 2200m Mobile

CONSTANTINA – Broke in the score up and as a result was out of position at the start. The horse will be placed outside the draw in future mobile events. Paced roughly after the start. Hung inwards running out of the home straight on the first occasion.

FLEETWOOD ROCK – Contacted marker pegs on the home turn

ANDAMAN BAY – A post-race veterinary examination revealed minor laceration to left foreleg

CONSTANTINA – A post-race veterinary examination revealed minor laceration to left foreleg

ASHANTE QUEEN – Gave ground from the 600m mark. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no significant findings. Trainers representative Mr Phillip Ford was asked about the mare's performance, and he put forward that Ashante Queen has had some tough racing in recent starts and that this, along with the early effort to make ground from the second line draw, told on her over the concluding stages. Stewards noted Mr Fords comments.

RACE 4 – LADBROKES MATES PACE – 1680m Mobile

SCRUB BASHER – Broke gait racing into the back straight on the final occasion. Stood down until the completion of two consecutive satisfactory trials

ONLINE MODEL – Gave ground approximately 500m from the finish. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities

CHRIS BE QUICK – Checked racing into the back straight on the final occasion when Scrub Basher broke gait.

RACE 5 – LADBROKES SRM MULTIS STAKES – 2200m Mobile

JUDITH GWENDA – Driver Georgia Hayward dropped her whip with approximately 400m to run

RACE 6 – VICTORY IMAGES PHOTOGRAPHY PACE – 2200m Mobile

EMER – Had to be checked in the home straight when SOULWRITER attempted to shift ground. Nearside ear plug failed to release

FLY LIKE AN ANGEL – Gave ground from approximately the 500m mark

LAID BACK KENNY – Pulled hard in the early to mid-stages of the race

BUDD SEWINDER – Held up for clear running in the early part of the straight

RACE 7 – TASMANIAN HORSE TRANSPORT PACE – 2200m SS

A false start was declared at the first attempt when the starting mechanism jammed which failed to release the tapes.

DAZZLE ME – Was a declared a late scratching (9:02PM) after bolting for a lap of the track and having to be steered onto the thoroughbred track due to its rein becoming detached.

ONEOFHELADS – No clear running in the home straight.

DIAMONDSANDBLUE – Broke after the start, no action taken due to the false start.

COLBY SANDS – Raced roughly at approximately the 1800m mark

General; Stewards spoke to trainer Wayne Yole with regards to DAZZLE ME's rein becoming detached. Stewards inspected the gear and found it to be of good quality. Stewards fined Mr Yole \$200.00 under rule 273(2)(b) for failing to present Dazzle Me with secure gear

General; Stewards spoke to driver Mitch Ford with regards to his right foot being out of the sulky rest from the commencement of the race to just prior to the winning post on the first occasion. Stewards reprimanded Mr Ford under rule 170(1)(a) for not driving with both feet in the rests of the sulky at all times, unless he is activating gear.

RACE 8 – VIZPIX SERVICES PACE – 1680m Mobile

COOLANDCOLLECT – Broke gait shortly after the start and will be placed outside the draw win future mobile events

CHEYS ANGEL – Gave ground over the concluding stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities

LAID BACK – Held up for clear running in the early part of the home straight
