RACE 1 – 12.00 PM - LADBROKES MAIDEN – 3 YO UPWARDS (SET WEIGHTS) 1200 METRES

The start of this event was delayed 2 minutes due to the re saddling of DRESSED IN SATURN.

2. ADDICTIVE GAS -

Failed to run on over the concluding stages and was eased down over the final 100 meters.

3. ALPINE DAME -

Shifted inwards at the 1000 meters. Rider suspended.

4. ARTILLERY FIRE -

A post race swab sample was taken from this winner for analytical testing.

5. DRESSED IN SATURN -

Had to be resaddled behind the barriers. Tightened for room at the 1000 meters and had to be checked by its rider. Shifted outwards at the 450 meters to gain a clear run. Failed to run on over the concluding stages.

6. MISS DELPHI -

Tightened for room at the 1000 meters and had to be checked by its rider.

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| 7. PUZZLE MISS - | Disappointed for a clear run at the 250 meters between runners and was in restricted room. |
| 8. SNOW MAIDEN - | Laid in under pressure in the home straight and had to be straightened by its rider. |
| 9. TIZSA NICE DROP - | Held up for a clear run entering the home straight between runners and finished strongly once clear room was gained. |
| 10. WARRIORA - | Held up for a clear run entering the home straight and had to shift outwards over heels to gain a clear run. |
| 11. WHAT'S NEW
PUSSYCAT - | Was slow to muster early speed in the event. |
| 12. ZULU FIELDS - | Raced wide from the 800 meters. Had to be steadied by its rider at the 450 meters because of another runner shifting outwards. |
| 13. GOLEA - | Was slow to muster early speed. |
| 16. HALEN - | Raced wide with cover from the 800 meters until leaving the 600 meters. Shifted wider entering the home straight to gain a clear run. |

Stewards questioned riders Apprentice L Bingley (ALPINE DAME), Kasi Boxall (DRESSED IN SATURN) & Apprentice Sam Kennedy (MISS DELPHI) along with Jockeys advocate Mr. Kevin Ring into an incident at the 1000 meters when MISS DELPHI had to be checked by its rider and lose its position. After taking evidence from all riders and stewards acting on their own observations and viewing the official patrol films issued a charge to apprentice L Bingley under provisions of AR131(a) for carelessness. The particulars were that approaching the 1000 meters while being urged forward apprentice L Bingley allowed her horse to shift inwards tightening the racing room of DRESSED IN SATURN in onto MISS DELPHI resulting in that mare having to be checked by its rider. Apprentice Lauren Bingley pleaded guilty to the charge and had her jockeys license suspended for 1 Tasmanian race meeting. Stewards, when considering a penalty, considered her excellent record under this rule. The suspension will commence immediately and expire on the completion of the race meeting at the Tasmanian Racing Club on 10-08-2025. Apprentice L Bingley was reminded of her appeal rights.

Stewards questioned trainer Ms. K Paterson the trainer of DRESSED IN SATURN into reasons why the mare had to be resaddled behind the barriers following a report from the starters, as the girth had slipped right back towards the mare's flanks. When the trainer was questioned, she advised stewards that this has been an ongoing problem with the mare, as she is high withered, which results in this happening. The trainer further explained that the mare would be going out for a spell to allow her to mature and gain further weight. Stewards reminded the trainer of her obligations under provisions of AR 106.

RACE 2 – 12.35 PM– GUY NEWITT MEMORIAL CLASS 1 HANDICAP - 1400 METRES

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| 2. DON'T GIVE UP - | Bumped at the start. Caught racing wide in the early stages and tended to over race. |
| 3. TUSKEGEE - | A post race swab sample was taken from this winner for analytical testing. A post race veterinarian examination revealed the gelding to be suffering from the thumps, and it was resolved upon a further inspection a couple of hours later. |
| 5. SAY IT WITH
WORDS - | Bumped at the start by another runner. Restrained at the start to gain a position closer to the rail. |
| 6. SHE'S SLICK - | Had to be eased off heels over the concluding stages. |
| 7. COOL CONQUEST - | Jumped outwards at the start, bumping another runner. Shifted wider making the home turn. |
| 8. HUBUBBAJAHN - | Stewards agreed for the rider to ride the gelding 1 kg over its allotted minimum weight of 54 kg. Bumped at the start. It had to be restrained off heels at the 1200 meters when over racing and shifted wider to improve its position. Tended to over race throughout the event. Laid in under pressure in the home straight. |
| 9. TWICE THE ICE - | Rolled out marginally over the concluding stages. |
| 11. SIR JAG - | Shifted inwards over the concluding stages of the event. |

Stewards questioned rider A Darmanin (SIR JAG) into the reasons why SHE'S SLICK (T Baker) had to be eased off the heels of SIR JAG over the concluding stages. Stewards are of the opinion that rider A Darmanin allowed his horse to shift inwards under pressure when using the whip and failed to stop and straighten his mount. On this occasion it was established that TWICE THE ICE (app J Johnson) had contributed marginally to this incident by shifting outwards under pressure. Stewards gave jockey A Darmanin the benefit of a doubt on this occasion and reminded him of his obligations in future.

RACE 3 –1.15 PM- NATIONAL JOCKEYS TRUST MAIDEN – 3YO & UP (SW) –1400 METRES

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| 1. DARK NIGHT - | Began slowly. |
| 3. HARRATA - | Stewards ordered a post race veterinarian examination of the horse, and it performed below market expectations. The veterinarian examination revealed that the horse showed signs of an abnormal noise to its right hand side of its lungs and recommended that the horse be scoped. The trainer advised the stewards that the horse will be undergoing a full veterinarian check, including scoping on returning to the stables. It was noted that HARRATA may not be suited to soft to heavy going as its previous good form has been on firm surfaces or synthetic surfaces. |
| 4. LOST LOGIC - | Reared upon jumping and lost ground. |
| 5. RAPIDS AHEAD - | Restrained at the start to gain a position closer to the rails. Shifted outwards under pressure and brushed with another runner over the concluding stages of the event. |
| 7. ELLA MAY - | Over raced and got its head up and raced ungenerously in the early stages of the event and shifted outwards and bumped another runner at the 1200 meters. Raced wide from the 800 meters to the 600 meters. |
| 8. PURR SEFANEE - | Raced in the lead throughout the event. |
| 10. SIENA WOLF - | Momentarily held up for a run approaching the 100 meters and had to shift inwards to gain a clear run. |
| 11. SISTER ROYAL - | Bumped by another runner at the 1200 meter turn. A post race swab sample was taken from this winner for analytical testing. Stewards questioned the trainer in relation to the above market expectations and improved performance of SISTER ROYAL. The trainer advised that the mare was having its first start in the state of Tasmania since coming from Melbourne for his stable, and had worked well leading into this event, and expected an improvement. Stewards noted the trainer's comments for future reference. |
| 12. SKELMORLIE - | Shifted outwards at the 450 meters brushing another runner. Laid in under pressure in the home straight. |
| 14. BELLA CHINKARA- | Brushed another runner at the 450 meters. Brushed another runner over the concluding stages of the event. |

RACE 4 – 1.55 PM - J K B RACING BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP – 1200 METRES

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| 1. WARICA - | It had to be eased off the heels of the runners in front at the 450 meters and shifted inwards. Reluctant to take an inside run inside another runner in the home straight. |
| 2. ETHICAL DILEMMA - | Had to be eased and inconvenienced at the 400 meters off the heels of the runners in front. Shifted outwards over the concluding stages to gain a clear run. |

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| 6. AGNETE - | It began slowly and raced wide throughout the event. A post race swab sample was taken from this winner for analytical testing. |
| 7. HOAX - | Disappointed for a run in the home straight and shifted outwards to gain a clear run. |
| 8. CREATIVE LICENSE - | Raced wide throughout. |
| 9. PASHEONA - | Bumped by another runner upon jumping. |
| 10. AMANCAYA - | Jumped awkwardly. Buffeted between a runner and the running rail at the 450 meters. |
| 11. GEEGEE STRAWBERRY - | It had to be severely checked off heels at the 450 meters as a result of a horse on its outside having to be checked and shifted inwards to avoid the heels of the runners in front. |
| 15. SCRIPTA - | Bumped by another runner upon jumping. Stewards ordered a post race veterinarian examination as the mare performed below market expectation. The veterinarian report revealed that the mare at the time of inspection revealed a rapid and erratic heart rate which was signs of an Atrial fibrillation. The mare was given some sedation, and the trainer was advised that an ECG would be recommended as soon as possible. The trainer was advised that the mare must complete a 1000 meter gallop in front of stewards and an ECG test prior to being nominated to trial or race again. |
| 16. MANDATE - | Raced wide throughout the event. |
| 19. LORD WHITEGATE- | Raced wide throughout. |

RACE 5 – 2.35 PM – R F FERGUSON MEMORIAL - CLASS 4 HANDICAP - 1100 METRES

The start of this event was delayed as a towel had dropped and was in the vicinity of the horse front legs in barrier 1. It was finally removed, and the race was given the “all clear” to proceed.

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| 2. PRESS FOR BOOM - | A post race swab sample was taken from this winner for analytical testing. |
| 7. CHEROKEE DANCER- | Jumped outwards at the start bumping another runner. |
| 8. FEAR THE STING - | Bumped by another runner at the start. Showed early speed to lead the event. |
| 9. POPILITA - | Permission was granted for the apprentice to ride the mare without claiming a portion of her allowance. |

RACE 6 – 3.15 PM – BLAIR SAWMILL & SONS DELORAINÉ PLATE- CLASS 5 – (SW) –1600 METERS

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| 2. JUST A NEEDS - | Raced wide from the 800 meters with cover. Shifted wider entering the home straight to gain a clear run. |
| 3. MOVEFORLEX - | A post race swab sample was taken from this winner for analytical testing. |
| 7. ADACHI - | Stewards agreed to the rider to ride the gelding ½ kg over its allotted weight. |
| 9. BLONDE STAR - | Stewards agreed to the rider to ride the gelding ½ kg over its allotted weight. It began slowly and was tightened between runners shortly after the start. Raced wide throughout. A post race swab sample was taken from this winner for analytical testing. |

The announcement of correct weight was delayed allowing jockey C Newitt (JUST A NEEDS) placed third by the judge to view the official photo finish as in his opinion he thought he may have won. After viewing the judges’ official print and seeing the small margin to third, he was satisfied with the judges’ placings, and the announcement of correct weight was declared.

RACE 7 – 3.52 PM – BREASIDE PARK BENCHMARK 68 HANDICAP - 1400 METRES

4. ALPINE AFFAIR -	Shifted ground and bumped another runner upon jumping.
6. FIGHTING FLOYD -	Bumped by another runner upon jumping. Slow to muster early speed.
7. JUST CRUISIN' -	Shifted outwards under pressure in the home straight. A post race swab sample was taken from this winner for analytical testing.
9. EXALTED CROWN -	Tended to over race in the early and middle stages of the event.
12. GEE GEE CAN WIN -	Shifted inwards making the home turn checking another runner.
13. MOORLANDS MISS -	Inconvenienced making the home turn.
14. FIGHTING FOR GOLD -	Stewards agreed for the rider to ride the gelding ½ kg over its allotted weight.

Stewards questioned riders apprentice J Radley (ALPINE BLAST) accompanied by senior rider C Newitt, E Byrne Burke (GEE GEE CAN WIN) & K Sanderson (MOORLANDS MISS) into reasons why MOORLANDS MISS had to be severely checked by its rider approaching the home turn. Stewards after taking evidence from all riders and acting on their own observations and viewing the official patrol films it was established that racing to the 300 meters GEE GEE CAN WIN was attempting to take a run to the inside of ALPINE BLAST and the outside of MOORLAND MISS where there was doubtful racing room. As GEE GEE CAN WIN attempted to take this run, there was a slight shift inward from ALPINE BLAST and GEE GEE CAN WIN laying inwards and away from ALPINE BLAST resulted in the racing room of MOORLANDS MISS being tightened in onto the rail and being severely checked by its rider. Stewards in not acting against the license of jockey E Byrne Burke, considered other mitigating circumstances leading to this incident. And deemed it a racing incident.

RACE 8 – 4.27 PM – THANK YOU COLIN MCNIFF BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 2100 METRES

2. MATEUS -	Raced wide from the 800 meters.
4. ROWING POWER -	Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.
5. TAHITIAN WARRIOR (NZ) -	Brushed with another runner over the concluding stages.
6. KIREINA MARUBRAH -	Shifted outwards under pressure over the concluding stages.
8. DOONICAN (IRE) -	A post race swab sample was taken from this winner for analytical testing.
9. KAY OH ELL (NZ) -	Raced four wide from the 800 meters until the 400 meters.
