### RACE 1 – Tasmanian Horse Transport Maiden/Class 1 - (1650 METRES)

10. WHOLESOME      Shifted outwards on jumping carrying OPENSEA out onto RIPPEN GOLD
3. RIPPEN GOLD      Tightened and lost ground on jumping and then again shortly afterwards when HUBBABUBBAJAHN laid in placing it in restricted room. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a small laceration on the off fore cannon bone.
1. ALPINE TROUT      Over-raced in the early and middle stages momentarily tightening DYNAMIC DEEL passing the winning post.
2. DYNAMIC DEEL      Steadied passing the winning post.
6. HARRATA      Jumped awkwardly and slow to begin, raced three wide with cover and laid in over the concluding stages. When questioned on the below market expectations performance rider A Darmanin stated that he had tracked the winner throughout and that the gelding failed to show a turn of foot when asked for an effort.

### RACE 2 – The Goodstone Group Maiden - (1009 METRES)

8. MISS TINA	Jumped outwards at the start and bumped with AKIARA.
7. BELUGA'S PRINCESS	Slow to begin and muster speed.
6. AKIARA	Bumped on jumping.
9. RESPITE	Bounded on jumping and caught wide throughout. Laid in throughout the home straight and bumped with MUNICH MARBLE on several occasions approaching the winning post. Rider E Byrne Burke who had changed her whip into her left hand was unable to use it when placed in restricted room approaching the winning post.
11. ALPINE DAME	Laid out 600 metre turn.
5. ADDICTIVE GAS	Made the 600 metre turn wide. Tired over the concluding stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a poor recovery rate.
1. DARK WINTER	A warning was issued on the loading manners of this gelding. Raced greenly throughout.

### RACE 3 – –Lending 4 U Class 1 Handicap - (1009 METRES)

3. SUPER SNIPPY	Slow to begin.
11. SPECIALIZED	Slow to begin and raced wide throughout.
2. OHSHESTROUBLE	Fractious in the barriers. Bumped on jumping when GETCH GROOVE ON shifted out. Apprentice S Kennedy stated when questioned about the tactics she adopted at the 600 metres that she had been caught three wide and elected to roll forward to find the rail. However in hindsight she may have progressed further forward than intended at this point. Stewards accepted her explanation.
1. OUR PEPMENARTIE	Over-raced in the early and middle stages. Laid out making the 600 metre turn.
5. SMARTIE ARTIE	Raced wide throughout.

### RACE 4 – –Kevin Sharkie Maiden - (1350 METRES)

3. KIRINYAGA	Knuckled shorty after jumping, Stewards placed a warning on the geldings racing manners and its performance.
7. SNOW MAIDEN	Laid out round in the 1200m turn. Commences to over race until the 600m
1. BEAU WARRIOR	Raced three wide to the 800m,

10. WOLF JUNIOR	Held up for a clear run at the 250 m and then raced in restricted room between SNOW MAIDEN and BEAU WARRIOR the to the 100m.

**RACE 5 – – The Stables at Spreyton Class 2 Handicap - (1350 METRES)**

7. ZOETE'S ROCK	Declared a late scratching at 7.53pm when trainer J Luttrell advised the stewards that it was suffering from a virus. A veterinary certificate of fitness will be required before competing again.
2. GO JEANNIE	Jumped outwards at the start and then elected to work forward to the lead from its wide barrier.
8. VALIANT KHAN	Slow to begin and caught wide until the 600 metres.
9. BAYBOUGG	Raced wide in the middle stages.
1. AZONTO	Carried wider making the home turn and then shifted out under pressure in the home straight before being corrected.

**RACE 6 — The SEBA SHEETMETAL BM 60 HANDICAP - (1150 METRES)**

1. THORS OF MYR	Jumped outwards at the start carrying Capital Cheval out onto WARICA Shifted out under pressure in the home straight.
3. CORNELIAN BAY	Raced wide throughout.
8. PERIWINKLE	Raced wide from the 800 metres .
11. CREATIVE LICENCE	Raced wide throughout.
10. HOAX	Raced wide throughout.
4. AGNETE	Raced wide throughout.
7. CAPITAL CHEVAL	When questioned on today's below market expectations performance rider D Pires stated that the tempo of the race did not suit the gelding and he believes a step up in distance would be beneficial.

**RACE 7 – 3:35PM – Ladbrokes Golden Mile - (1650 METRES)**

8. CHICANE	Declared a late scratching at 10.43 am when trainer M Trinder advised that the gelding was lame in the near foreleg. A veterinary certificate of soundness will be required before trialing or racing again.
1. DISTRUSTFUL AWARD	Bumped and carried wider near the 650 metres when BLONDE SUSPECT commenced to over-race.

9. BLONDE SUSPECT	Over-raced near the 650 metres when being steadied off heels and shifted out carrying DISTRUSTFUL AWARD wider.
4. ASVA (NZ)	Restrained off the heels of GARCON D'SPOIR near the 700 metres. Dissapointed for a clear run at the 200 metres and obliged to shift to the inside of SUSHI EXPRESS.
7. GARCON D'ESPOIR	Had to be continually restrained off the heels of SUSHI EXPRESS approaching the 600 metre turn.

**RACE 8 – 4:10PM – Stall Gate KioskBM 62 Handicap - (1650 METRES)**

3. EXALTED CROWN	Stumbled on jumping and bumped with ALPINE AFFAIR
8. MIGHTYMAXI	Raced three wide to 600 metres.
5. TUSKEEGEE	Laid in near the 150 metres and had to be corrected by the rider.
6. GEE GEE CAN WIN	Slow into stride.
9. KIREINA MARUBRAH	Laid out under pressure in the home straight.
