RACE 1 – MOREYS TOURS 1609M - Mobile

JUSTIFY – Broke gait placed on its last chance to race truly

RACE 2 – LADBROKES MULTI PACE 1609M - Mobile

SMOOTH REASON – shifted out under pressure in home straight

NO NUKES SKIPPER – held up for clear running early in the home straight

ROLLIN MARY – Hung out in the latter stages of the score up

RACE 3 – FEHLBERGS PRODUCE PACE 2090m – Mobile

General – Race started approximately 2 minutes after the advertised start time due to Sky Racing commitments

STAROFREMEMBRANCE – Inconvenienced at 100m by the galloping **I WANT IT ALL NZ**

I WANT IT ALL NZ – Broke gait twice in running. Stood down until completing a satisfactory trial

MACH ANGELO – Broke connecting hopple strap approximately 1400m from home and was retired from the event

CINCINNATI – Post race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities

OH NO NEVER AGAIN – Reincluded in the mobile barrier draw

RACE 4 – TASMANIAN HORSE TRANSPORT PACE 2090m – Mobile

STRANDED LOLLIPOP – Contacted a marker peg approximately 200m from home. Hopple shorteners failed to release.

SMILING MIA – Checked and raced roughly when tightened for room on the home turn

MISS DUTTON – Hung in on the home turn

SOUTHERN LUCK – Gave ground late

MONTGOMERY BURNS – Tightened nearing the home turn and contacted a marker peg

General – Stewards questioned driver Jack Watson regarding the tactics he employed on **VINCENZO** in the early stages of the race. Of particular concern was the very fast lead time recorded by Vincenzo. Mr Watson put forward that his horse races best in the lead and possesses good gate speed so he believed that he could cross **SMILING MIA**, who in his opinion was his main competition for that position. After using the whip to cross to the lead Mr Watson put forward that although conscious he was running a quick lead time, was also mindful that 'grabbing hold' too suddenly could cause his horse to choke down. In accepting Mr Watson's explanation stewards stressed to Mr Watson that he must go into races with more than one plan and to show better judgement of pace.

General – Stewards inquired into the reason for **SMILING MIA** being checked on the home turn. Evidence was taken from Jack Watson(Vincenzo), Tiarna Ford(Smiling Mia) and Todd Rattray(Miss Dutton). It was found that Vincenzo had shifted away from the peg line as he was tiring and that Miss Dutton had hung in momentarily when making a three wide move. This placed Smiling Mia in restricted room, and she was checked. After hearing the evidence and acting on their own observation's stewards took no further action.

RACE 5 – RACING CONNECT PACE 1609m – Mobile

SPOOKY GIRL – Gave ground concluding stages. Poor performance stood down until competing a satisfactory trial.

DENNY ROCKS – Hung out under pressure in the home straight

SHARMEY – Shifted out under pressure in the home straight.

LAID BACK – Utilized the sprint lane

RACE 6 – SMITHWARDS PACE 2090M - Mobile

RACE 7 – PRYDES EASIFEED PACE 2090m – Mobile

ROSE NOIRE_–_Gave ground from the 300m mark. Post race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities
