RACE 1 – PRYDES EASIFEED PACE 1609M - Mobile

OH NO NEVER AGAIN – Contacted marker pegs in the home straight. Driver fined \$100 under rule 163(1)(c)

MEL RUSTY KITA – Lost a shoe (right hind) shortly after the start. Gave ground over the concluding stages. A post-race vets examination revealed no abnormalities

POST LAZARUS – Broke gait and will be stood down until completing a satisfactory trial

IAMAHUNTER – Was inconvenienced at the 1200m when Post Lazarus broke gait

RACE 2 – MOREYS TOURS PACE 2090M – Mobile

JUSTIFY – Broke after the start. Will be excluded from future mobile barrier draws. A post-race vets examination revealed a cut to its right-fore medial. A 10 day stand down period was imposed.

EMER – Hung in around the home turn to get the bell and contacted marker pegs

COLBY ART - Hung in around the home turn to get the bell and contacted marker pegs

ROYAL CADENCE – Was inconvenienced shortly after the start when Justify broke gait.

RACE 3 – LADBROKES ODDS SURGE PACE 2090m – Mobile

VOODOO RANGER – Raced roughly after the start, placed on its last chance in the draw

ROCKNROLL MCRAE – Hung out and locked wheels with Shades Of Silk. A warning was issued against the horses racing manners

EVERYTHING BUT THE – Was disappointed for a run in the home straight and broke gait for a few strides. Under the circumstances a warning was issued

SPORT WATCHER – Gave ground over the concluding stages

SHADES OF SILK – Slipped its head-check at the 800m. Tightened by Luvthat at approximately the 700m mark and locked wheels with Rocknroll Mccrae shortly after resulting in a flat tyre. Gave ground over the concluding stages

LUVTHAT – Hung in at the 700m tightening the racing room of Shades Of Silk. A warning was issued against the horses racing manners.

UNOBETTER – Hung inwards at various stages of the race and was subsequently placed on its last chance to race truly. Gave ground over the concluding stages. A post-race vets examination revealed significant nasal discharge. A 10 day stand down period was imposed

RACE 4 – FEHLBURGS PRODUCE PACE 2090m – Mobile

FIVEFORTY – Broke in the score up and was out of position at the start. Subsequently placed outside the draw in future mobile events. Inconvenienced by the galloping Starofremeberance at the 1200m

MY BAD – Inconvenienced behind the galloping Whattagoodreason

NAPATTACK SAM - Inconvenienced behind the galloping Whattagoodreason. Gave ground over the concluding stages

STRAWBERRY BLING - Inconvenienced behind the galloping Whattagoodreason

WHATAGOODREASON – Broke gait at the 600m and was retired from the event. A post-race vets examination revealed a fracture to the offside hindleg. On advice from the on-course vet the gelding was humanely euthanized.

STAROFREMEBERANCE – Stumbled and broke gait at the 1200m. Gave ground over the concluding stages and was placed on its last chance to race competitively.

RACE 5 – TASMANIAN HORSE TRANSPORT PACE 1609m – Mobile

AURORA REASON – Tightened running into the first turn and commenced to race roughly

MONEYS NO ISSUE - Tightened running into the first turn

PUNTARNO STRIDE – Sulky wheel contacted by Modern Jive

MODERN JIVE – Contacted the sulky wheel of Puntarno Stride

SOUTHERN LUCK – No clear run

GENERAL – Driver Mitch Ford was reprimanded under rule 168(1)(a) for careless driving in that he caused tightening to Moneys No Issue and Aurora Reason running into the first turn.

RACE 6 – VALE TED MCSPADDEN PACE 2090M - Mobile

CAN FEEL THE FURY – Contacted markers pegs running out the home straight on the first occasion when racing in restricted room

NIKITA JO – No clear run in home straight

EYE SEE DOUBLE – Contacted marker pegs running into the straight to get the bell when racing under pressure. Notwithstanding this stewards reminded Jordan Chibnall to exercise more care

RACE 7 – DOWNBYTHESEASIDE@WOODLANDS PACE 2090m – Mobile

ROYAL REACTOR – Gave ground and was placed on its last chance to race competitively. A post-race vets examination revealed an elevated heart rate. Stewards spoke to trainer Ben Richardson who could offer no explanation for the poor performance and stated that he was very disappointed with the run. Mr Richardson advised he would monitor the gelding closely in coming days and advise the stewards of any relevant outcomes.

DEBT TILL WE PART – Inconvenienced by a tiring runner

YAPPAS COURAGE – Performed poorly giving ground from approximately the 1000m. The gelding has been stood down until the satisfactory completion of a trial. A post-race vets examination revealed no abnormalities
