Jockey Dianne Parish was not approved to race ride due to inactivity. She must complete 5 trial rides before being permitted to ride in races again.

Trainer Drew Tyson advised that he had difficulty securing a rider after Apprentice Sam Kennedy became indisposed on Wednesday.

RACE 1 – LADBROKES ODDS SURGE MAIDEN- 1009 METRES

2 THE EDITORBounded on jumping and raced three wide throughout. Bumped

by ARSENALE shifting out at the 600 metres. Shifted in under

pressure near the 100 metres.

3 ARSENALE Bumped at the 600 metre turn by CLOVER HILL which had shifted

out.

4 CLOVER HILL Slow to begin. Laid out 600 metre turn and bumped ARSENALE.

6 SEDNA Raced wide until 500 metres

RACE 2 - KEVIN SHARKIE WINTER FINALE MAIDEN - 1650 METRES

1 BEAU WARRIOR Raced wide leaving home straight first occasion, steadied off heels

of runner in front at the 1200 metre turn and then commenced to

over-race.

2 KNIGHTS REIGN Bumped on jumping when OCCASIONAL GLIMPSE shifted out.

3 NO MORE ROCKS Change of tactics advised, to attempt to lead. These tactics were

adopted but rider D Pires when questioned stated the gelding was slow to muster early speed and he was unable to gain the lead in the early stages due to the strong pace. When the pace eased entering the back straight he was able to progress forward. However when asked for another effort at the 600 metres there was no response. He added that connections indicated the

gelding would be retired.

4 OPENSEA Laid in under pressure on home straight

6 OCCAZIONAL GLIMPSE Shifted out at the start and bumped with KNIGHTS REIGN.

RACE 3 – DEAN RAWLINGS SENIOR MEMORIAL C1 HCP- 1350 METRES

1 CHALONG Laid in over the concluding stages.

3 SMART ARTIE Bumped on jumping by CHALONG. Over-raced in the early stages.

4 SAY IT WITH WORDS Raced three wide in the early and middle stages.

5 THIN RED LINE Laid in over the concluding stages.

RACE 4 - COACH HOUSE C4- 1350 METRES

1 GOLDEN MEADOW Laid in over the concluding stages.

4 LION'S TOOTHThe bridle had to be refitted prior to start due to the gelding

getting its tongue over bit. Restrained in the early stages to take

up a position closer to the rail.

5 STREET DIVA Raced three wide throughout. Laid in under pressure in the home

straight.

RACE 5 - TASMANIAN HORSE TRANSPORT C1 HCP - 1150 METRES

1 TURBO CHOOK When guestioned on the performance today rider D Ganderton

stated that in his opinion the gelding had not backed up from its previous start. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no

obvious abnormalities.

2 STROAK OF ART Over-raced in the early stages. Raced three wide throughout. Laid

out making 600 metre turn placing SKY EAGLE awkwardly on its

heels.

6 GEEGEESCHASER Laid out making the 600 metre turn.

RACE 6 - 4:04PM - STABLES AT SPREYTON BM60 HCP- 1150 METRES

CORNELIAN BAY Raced wide throughout.

4 RED SPHERE Laid out making the 600 metre turn.

5 MATERIAL MADAME Over-raced in the early stages.

6 LORD WHITEGATE Raced wide until 600 metres.

RACE 7 – 4:39PM – #GOTTLUVTASSIERACING BM68 HCP - 1650 METRES

Correct weight was delayed when A. Darmanin rider of TUSKAGEE wished to view the photo of the dead heat for first place. After doing so, he was satisfied and correct weight was given.

1 VAGABOND HERO Fractious prior to start. Steadied off heels near the 1400 metres.

2 CHICANE Fractious prior to start. Checked on jumping between runners and

had to take up a position at the tail of the field. Held up for clear running on home turn. When queried on the geldings performance today rider D Ganderton stated that after being hampered at the start and being placed last he gradually improved from the home turn and believed that Chicane ran on fairly, however had peaked

on its run passing the 100 metres.

3 FAST THINKER Over-raced in the middle stages.

4 ORIGINAL GLAZE At the start jumped out and VAGABOND HERO jumped in resulting

in CHICANE being hampered.

5 TUSKEGEE Passing the winning post on first occasion rolled in hampering

VAGABOND HERO. Rider A Darmanin was reprimanded under the provisions of AR 131(a) for Careless Riding for allowing his mount

to shift in when not fully clear before being corrected.

9 EXALTED CROWN Refitted tongue tie behind barriers.

RACE 8 – 5:20PM – GOODSTONE GROUP MAIDEN/CLASS 1 HCP– 1880 METRES

3 RIPPEN GOLD Laid out at 600 metre turn. Rider K Sanderson reported the

gelding was inclined to shy away from the running rail on several

occasions passing the 600 metres.

5 GEEGEE AUNTY JESS Laid in over the concluding stages and then carried outwards when

RIPPEN GOLD rolled out marginally.

7 TWICE THE ICE Tightened on jumping between KICKPASS & RIPPEN GOLD whom

both shifted ground. Shifted in under pressure over the

concluding stages, Apprentice J Johnstone was advised to exercise

care when shifting ground.
