RACE 1 - WELCOME BACK TO NIGHT RACING IN LAUNNIE MAIDEN/CLASS 1-1600 M

1 DON'T GIVE UP - Shifted in under pressure over the concluding stages.

2 **OPENSEA (NZ) -** Jumped out at the start, carrying CALLED THROUGH out onto

HARRATA.

5 CALLED THROUGH - Raced three-wide from the 700 metres.

6 HARRATA - Stewards questioned Apprentice K Lane regarding the disappointing

performance of her mount. Miss Lane stated that the gelding failed to

respond when placed under pressure. A post-race veterinary

examination revealed superficial abrasions to the off-fore heel bulb.

Stewards reminded Apprentice K Lane, in the presence of senior rider C Jordan, of her obligations regarding whip use when her mount is out of contention under the provisions of AR 132(6)(c).

RACE 2 – LADBROKES SPRING HOSTED POTS MAIDEN - 1400 M

2 KIRINYAGA - Slow into stride then raced three wide until the 800 metres. A

post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious

abnormalities. Stewards bearing in mind the tactics adopted today

continued the warning on the gelding's performance.

5 ZIGGY PLAYS GUITAR - Over-raced middle stages.

7 CAFFY - Jumped outwards at the start, brushing with ZIGGY PLAYS

GUITAR. A post-race veterinary examination revealed mild tying

up.

8 WHO'S IN DEV - Laid out entering the home straight. A post-race veterinary

examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

Rider Cody Jordan (WHO'S IN DEV) pleaded guilty to a charge of careless riding under the provisions of AR131(a), in that near the 400 metres, she permitted her mount to shift out when insufficiently clear of STIDING BAY (J Radley), that was checked and lost its rightful running and further hampering ALPINE SHOWGIRL (D Pires) to its outside. Miss Jordan had her permit to ride in races suspended for 1 Tasmanian race date. In assessing penalty, account was taken of her guilty plea, excellent record and that the incident was in the mid range. The commencement date of the suspension will be advised after Miss Jordan considers a deferment.

RACE 3 – SALTERS HIRE MAIDEN - 1100 M

1 LA ZAMPA - Over-raced early and middle stages.

3 ADDICTIVE GAS - Declared a late scratching at 7:09pm on veterinary advice after the

horse broke free and harmlessly dislodged rider Shogo Nakano. The mare then galloped for some distance. No further action was taken on the manners of the mare due to the delayed start for this race.

6 CAN'T CATCH CHILLI - Raced three wide from the 800 metres. Stood down to a satisfactory

trial for being difficult to load and delaying the start of the race by

three minutes.

7 GOLEA - Slow to muster.

RACE 4 – LADBROKES SUPPORTING ROCT CLASS 1 HCP- 1100 M

4 SUPER SNIPPY - Reared on jumping.

6 TOORAK TREASURE - Over raced early stages. A warning has been placed on the mare

for being difficult to load.

7 ANTHEIA - A warning has been placed on the mare for being difficult to load.

8 LADY FERN - Steadied off heels of ANTHEIA around the 800 metres.

11 PAULARTES Stewards granted permission for rider D Pires to ride 0.5 kgs over

the allotted weight.

14 BUNKER BOB Raced four-wide throughout.

RACE 5 - CONGRATS ROB SCHAECHE, OWNERS AWARD RECIPIENT TASRACING CLASS 3 HCP - 1400 M

2 KAKIA - Bounded in on jumping, bumping with TAHITIAN WARRIOR.

3 MILES 'N' MILES - Slow to muster.

4 GEE GEES ME BOY - Knuckles on jumping.

9 CREATIVE LICENCE - Over-raced early stages.

11 CRAZY ATOM - Re-saddled at the barriers prior to the start.

RACE 6 – JOIN RACEHORSE OWNERS CLUB TASMANIA BM72 HCP - 1100 M

1 FURNEAUX - Over-raced in the early stages. Rider accidentally dropped her whip

near the 100 metres.

2 GEE GEE ENUF SPEED - Raced three-wide throughout.

3 RUBBLE 'N' FUDD - Jumped in at the start. Held up momentarily for a clear run

entering the home straight, shifting in to obtain clear running. Rider J Radley reported when returning to scales that the gelding failed to respond when placed under pressure over the concluding stages.

A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious

abnormalities.

7 THISISMYTURF - Over-raced in the early stages.

8 CONUMDRUM - Jumped out at the start.

The announcement of Correct weight was delayed as rider apprentice S Kennedy (FUREAUX) wished to view the official photo finish. After viewing the photo finish Miss Kennedy was satisfied that there was a margin between her mount and the winner and correct weight was given.

Prior to entering the mounting enclosure, it was identified that CREATIVE LICENCE had been saddled with the incorrect saddlecloth number. Taking into account the circumstances Trainer Peter Luttrell was cautioned under the provisions of AR 106(1).

RACE 7 – ROCT SUPPORTING TASSIE RACEHORSE OWNERS BM72 HCP - 1400 M

2 PRIX DE TURN (NZ) - Near fore shoe replaced on course prior to the start and passed a

veterinary examination.

3 SH'BOURNE MIDNIGHT - Raced three-wide throughout.

4 THE SPIRIT OF ZERO - Slow to muster. Raced wide form the 800 metres to the 400

metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding

to have a superficial abrasion to the off-fore pastern.

5 GEE GEE MISS QUITA - Lost the near hind shoe in running.

6 LOVIN' BEV - Shifted out and bumped with KING ISLAND.

9 VERBANO - Restrained at the start to take up a position closer to the rail.

RACE 8 – BECOME A RACEHORSE OWNER AND REAP THE REWARDS! CLASS 2 HCP - 1200 M

1 GET 'EM WARRIOR - Shifted out, as GEEGEEHAILSTORM shifted in near the 50 metres

and steadied.

2 AL MAXIMUS - Jumped awkwardly and contacted the outside barrier partition and

was slow to muster early speed. Hung out making the home turn

and throughout the concluding stages.

4 UNCLE'S TIP - When questioned, rider K Sanderson stated that when placed under

pressure, the mare failed to respond. post-race veterinary

examination revealed no abnormalities.

5 GEEGEEHAILSTORM - Race four-wide throughout. Shifted in marginally passing the 50

metres, as GET EM' WARRIOR shifted out causing that gelding to

steady off heels momentarily.

7 RARE ORO - Slow to muster.
