Kasi Boxall was indisposed after a trackwork incident on Thursday, she must submit a medical clearance prior to riding again.

RACE 1 - THANK YOU ROCT, SUPER OPENING NIGHT! MAIDEN - 1400 M

4 SWEAR HE IS GOOD Raced wide from the 800 metres. Compounded over the concluding stages. Rider

D Pires reported his mount want to lay away from SWING LOW and failed to

respond when placed under pressure from the 400 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

5 TIDEFORD Fractious in the barriers. Raced three wide throughout. Shied approaching the

crossing after the finish line, harmlessly dislodging rider K Sanderson.

6 ZURICH Laid out over the concluding stages.

9 LUNA LINDT Tightened and lost ground between ARSENALE and WARRIORA on jumping.

11 WARRIORA Resaddled behind the barriers prior to the start.

RACE 2 - LADBROKES MEGA MULTI MAIDEN - 1200 M

3 THE EDITOR Knuckled on jumping, unbalancing rider Apprentice J Radley. Lost the near fore

plate in running.

4 ARGYLL DIAMOND Dislodged near hind shoe prior to the start. In the exceptional circumstances

the other hind plate was removed. Steadied off the heels of CARNOTAURUS at

the 300 metres.

5ARIANNA'S GOLD Laid out under pressure over the concluding stages.

7 FROSTY RUGE Jumped in at the start. Slow to muster. Raced wide from the 800 metres.

10 SEDITIOUS AWARD Steadied off the heels of SUNRISE AT KIRRA near the 300 metres.

12 SUNRISE AT KIRRA Shifted out to improve resulting in SEDITIOUS AWARD having to steady.

14 MISS MABEL Declared a late scratching at 2:08pm after dislodging rider L Annells at the

barriers and galloping back to the mounting yard. A warning has been placed

on the pre-race manners of MISS MABEL.

Stewards questioned riders apprentice J Radley (THE EDITOR) accompanied by senior rider D Ganderton, and K Sanderson (ARCADE BOY) into reasons why ARCADE BOY had clipped the heels of THE EDITOR approaching the 800 metres. After taking evidence from all riders and acting on their own observations and viewing the official patrol films it was established that THE EDITOR layed in marginally, while ARCADE BOY shifted out also marginally, resulting in ARCADE BOY clipping heels. Stewards deemed that there was no blame attributed to either rider therefore no further action was taken.

Stewards questioned riders, apprentice C Pang (SUNRISE AT KIRRA) and apprentice S Kennedy (SEDITIOUS AWARD) into reasons SEDITIOUS AWARD had to be restrained by its rider at the 300 metres. Stewards, after taking evidence from all riders and acting on their own observations and viewing the official patrol films it was established that Apprentice C Pang allowed his mount to shift when not fully clear of SEDITIOUS AWARD which had to be momentarily steadied. Mr Pang was reprimanded for careless riding under the provisions of AR131(a) in not taking further action the low level of interference was considered.

Trainer P Dargan was reprimanded under the provisions of AR228(b) for misconduct, for his language when removing Miss Mabel from the track after being scratched.

RACE 3 – BOOK IN MAYHEM IN THE MOUNTING YARD 21ST NOVEMBER C1 HCP - 1200 M

2 RESPITE Laid out in the home straight.

3 STAR WALKIN' Trainer T Wells was questioned in relation the apparent improved performance of

the gelding. Mr Wells stated that the odds dd not reflect the geldings ability on the

turf and that todays conditions suited the horse. Stewards noted Mr Wells'

comments.

8 COOL CONQUEST Shifted in, inconveniencing SKY EAGLE at the 400 metres. Rider D Pires was

reminded to be fully clear when he shifts ground.

12 SKY EAGLE Tightened and steadied approaching the 400 metres when COOL CONOUEST

shifted in.

13 BOUNTY BAY Slow to muster early speed. Over-raced middle stages.

14 MISS TERASITA Over-raced early and middles stages. Raced wide throughout. . Trainer P Dargan

was advised that the mare would be stood down until completing a satisfactory trial for its pre-race manners after dislodging rider L Annels near the 1400 meters

after which she was unable to remount until arriving at the barriers.

RACE 4 - LADBROKES BIG BETS MAIDEN - 1100 M

1 DENHAM BAY Restrained after the start to take up a position closer to the rail.

2 GLADDING Restrained off the heels of SKY OF GOLD near the 50 metres. Laid in over the

concluding stages.

4 TMIELY NEEDS Raced wide throughout.

7 LITTLE EL Tightened shortly after the start between SILVER GRANGE and ZOE OF ROME.

both shifting ground.

Stewards questioned riders, apprentice J Johnstone (SKY OF GOLD) and S Nakano (GLADDING) into reasons GLADDING had to be restrained by its rider at the 50 metres. Stewards, after taking evidence from all riders and acting on their own observations and viewing the official patrol films it was established that Apprentice J Johnstone allowed his mount to shift when not fully clear of GLADDING. Apprentice Johnstone was severely reprimanded for careless riding under the provisions of AR131(a) in not taking further action the low level of interference to GLADDING was taken into account.

RACE 5 - FIELD FAMILY Y CL 6 - 1400 M

2 CHICANE Fractious prior to the start. Steadied off the heels of ADACHI making the 800

metre turn.

4 ADACHI Buffeted and became unbalanced making the 800 metre turn when SHY GUY laid

in despite the efforts of the rider.

7 SHY GUY Shifted in near the 1200 metres and checked GO JEANIE. Laid in making the 800

metre turn.

8 GO JEANIE Bounded on jumping and lost ground. Checked off the heels of SHY GUY making

the 1200 metre turn when that gelding shifted in when insufficiently clear.

Rider Kelvin Sanderson (SHY GUY) pleaded guilty to a charge of careless riding under the provisions of AR131(a), in that near the 1200 metres, permitted his mount to shift in when not sufficiently clear of GO JEANIE (C Jordan), that was checked and commenced to over-race. Rider K Sanderson was severely reprimanded. In assessing penalty, account was taken of his guilty plea and good record which showed that he had not been dealt with under this rule since 2012.

RACE 6 - DINE AT THE TTC THIS SPRING WWW.TASMANIANTURFCLUB.COM CL3 HCP - 1100 M

4 RESTRICTED ACCESS Approaching the 200 metres, shifted in over the heels of NGAPALI BEACH to

improve.

9 CAPABELLEJumped in at the start, bumping with NGAPALI BEACH. Wid throughout A post-

race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

RACE 7 - BOOK IN JACKSON SECURITY NEWMARKET NIGHT 21ST NOVEMBER BM60 HCP - 1600 M

3 AGNETE Raced three-wide throughout.

4 I'M CHEV Held up for a clear run entering the home straight and again approaching the

200 metres.

11 DOONICAN Slow into stride.
