RACE 1 – WOODLANDS STUD DANDY PATCH HT1 2090M – Mobile

TISU JACK HIGH – Raced rough in the score up. Broke gait going into the back straight on the first occasion and was retired from the event.

SOLO SAFARI – Was inconvenienced when Tisu Jack High broke gait. Used the sprint lane

LIKEYOUFORAREASON - Was inconvenienced when Tisu Jack High broke gait

ALWAYS BETTOR - Was inconvenienced when Tisu Jack High broke gait. Raced roughly at various stages during the last lap

General – It was ascertained that Tisu Jack High's second carrier strap came undone resulting in the horse breaking gait and having to be retired from the event. Trainer Steven Davis was fined \$100 under rule 273(2)(b) for presenting a horse to race with insecure gear.

RACE 2 - MOREYS TOURS PACE - 1609M - Mobile

PERFECT CUT – Raced fiercely in the score up and contacted the gate before release.

SETTEBELLO – Gave ground from the 500m

FIVE STAR SHARK – Hung-in contacted marker pegs racing into the back straight

RACE 3 - WOODLANDS STUD EVICUS PRELUDE - 1609M - Mobile

QUETZALI – Raced roughly from the 400m until straightening. Hung-in and contacted a marker peg

RACE 4 - TASMANIAN HORSE TRANSPORT PACE - 1609M - Mobile

GOBSMACKED – Used the sprint lane

ROCK ON PLAYBOY – Tightened in the run to the first turn when Away Game shifted from a three-wide position to a one-wide position.

General – Driver Liam Older was reprimanded under rule 163(1)(A)(i) for causing crossing. Mr Older was insufficiently clear of Rock On Playboy when shifting from the three-wide line to the one-wide line in the run to the first turn resulting in that runner being tightened momentarily.

RACE 5 - WOODLANDS STUD DANDY PATCH HT 2 – 2090M – Mobile

QUAY – Raced erratically running into the straight to get the bell and lost ground. His sulky wheel was contacted by Iylac Chambe when this incident occurred.

ALLSUDSNOBUBBLES – Post-race vet examination revealed no abnormalities. Stewards questioned trainer and driver with regards to the disappointing performance. It was put forward that the 2yo had not handled the quick back up having only raced 5 days ago. Stewards accepted the explanation

IYLAC CHAMBER – Contacted the sulky wheel of Quay when that runner raced ungenerously.

RACE 6 – FEHLBERGS PRODUCE SPRINTLANE PACE – 2090M - Mobile

JUSTIFY – Broke after the start and will be excluded from future mobile draws. Raced ungenerously at various stages thereafter.

QUEENOFTHEDANCE – Raced inside a marker peg racing out of the front straight on the first occasion. Driver Liam Older was fined \$50 under rule 163(1)(C)(ii)

SMOOTH DEAL – Contacted a marker peg, no further action taken

YELLA – Gave ground from the 400m

STAROFREMEBERANCE – Used the sprint lane

RACE 7 - LADBROKES BIG BETS 2090M - Mobile

OH NO NEVER AGAIN – Inconvenienced when Cinocal Jamane gave ground

CINOCAL JAMANE – Gave ground from the 600m. Placed on its last chance to race competitively.
