Stewards accepted trainer Barry Bakers reason for the late declaration of rider in race 1.

1 - CRESSY CHAFF CUTTERS LONGFORD CUP NEW YEARS DAY MAIDEN 1200M

1 MONCLEREBumped by ZANZI on jumping. Raced three wide from the 600 metres.

2 TASSIE POWER Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

3 TROTSKY Momentarily held up on the home turn before shifting in to obtain clear

runnina.

4 ARIANNA'S GOLD Bumped with FROSTY RUDGE on jumping and then bumped with TROTSKY

Lodged a protest against TROTSKY alleging interference approaching the

winning post.

5 FROSTY RUGE Bumped on jumping.

7 ZANZI

8 GEEGEESDOUBLECROSS Tightened between TASSIE POWER and TROTSY on jumping.

11 SEND ME GOLD Shifted out near the 200 metres abruptly obliging MONCLERE wider on the

track.

On return to scale Rider T Baker (ARIANNAS GOLD) viewed the films of the home straight and lodged a protest against the winner TROTSKY(S Nakano) alleging interference in the home straight approaching the finish. After viewing the films and taking evidence, it was established that ARIANNA'S GOLD had shifted in marginally bumping with TROTSKY at the 100 metres. After this nearing the winning post TROTSLY had shifted out and bumped with ARIANNA'S GOLD. Taking into account the margin at the end of the race (a head) and the proximity to the winning post of the interference Stewards did not believe that the interference exceeded the margin at the finish and the protest was dismissed. Rider S Nakano was issued with at reprimand under AR 131(a) for careless riding for allowing his mount to shift out and contact ARIANNA'S GOLD approaching the winning post.

RACE 2 - MAYHEM IN THE MOUNTING YARD FRIDAY NIGHT 21ST NOVEMBER MAIDEN- 1600 M

2 STRIDING BAY Lost the near hind plate.

5 CAFFY Tightened on the home turn between STRIDING BAY and JUDGE JENNI both

horses having shifted marginally. Rider reported the mare felt amiss in its action. A

post-race veterinary examination revealed that she had "tied up".

7 JUDGE JENNI Slow to muster early speed.

8 LUNA LINDT Slow to begin and raced wide throughout.

9 SWING LOW Raced three wide throughout.

RACE 3 – JACKSON SECURITY TASMANIAN NEWMARKET 21ST NOVEMBER C1 HCP – 1600M

1 NAVARRE RIVER Carried outwards by THIN RED LINE at the 150M

2 ZURICH Caught three wide throughout. Carried wider on the home turn when SAKURE HIME

was carried wider.

3 CATCH A BREAK Over-raced in the early stages.

4 RIPPEN GOLD

Bucked on one occasion shortly after the start, a warning has been issued.

5 STRATOJACK

Carried in after the start by KICKPASS which had shifted away from RIPPEN GOLD.

6 THIN RED LINE Trainer fined \$50.00 for the late addition of Winkers.

THIN RED LINE shifted out at the 150M and brushed with NAVARRE RIVER

8 KICKPASS Crowded after the start by RIPPEN GOLD shifting in.

9 COOL CONQUEST Shifted out making the home turn carrying SAKUME HIME wider on the track.

Apprentice J Radley was advised to exercise care when shifting ground.

10 SAKURA HIME Carried wider on the home turn.

14 ROCHEAUX Over-raced in the early and middle stages and raced wide throughout.

RACE 4 – THE BAKER GROUP 3YO CUP 21ST NOVEMBER C3 HCP- 1400 M

1 RED SPHERE Layed out making the 1200 metre turn carrying WHIPPIN PICCADILLY wider.

5 IT'S JAGGER TIME Bumped at the 1200 metres. Caught three wide throughout.

6 NIGHT INVADER Slow to muster early speed.

7 WHIPPIN PICCADILLY Steadied off the heels of RED SPHERE at the 1200 metres and shifted out bumping

with IT'S JAGGER TIME.

10 GEEGEES MISTY Restrained after the start from a wide barrier.

RACE 5 - KACHOO FASHIONS ON THE FIELD NEW YEARS DAY BM76 HCP- 1200 M

2 FURNEAUX Disappointed for a clear run on the home turn between GEE GEE ENUF SPEED and

THOROS OF MYR.

8 MASTRETTA Momentarily held up for a clear run entering the home straight.

9 CONUMDRUM Restrained on jumping from a wide barrier.

RACE 6 - COUNTRY CUP MARQUEE NEW YEARS DAY AT LONGFORD C2 HCP- 1200M

2 GET 'EM WARRIOR Tightened by UNCLE'S TIP laying in near the 150 metres and checked losing its

position.

4 UNCLE'S TIP Laid in near the 150 metres tightening the running of GET 'EM WARRIOR which had

to be checked. Stewards found Apprentice C Pang had attempted to relieve the pressure however his mount had laid in at this point despite his efforts. The gelding

then had to be checked outwards over the heels of WITHIN SIGHT.

6 WITHIN SIGHT Shifted in when insufficiently clear of UNCLE'S TIP which was being checked

outwards at that point to relieve pressure on GET 'EM WARRIOR. Rider D Pires was

severely reprimanded for allowing his mount to shift in when not fully clear.

7 RARE ORO Raced wider throughout.

RACE 7 - BOOK YOUR XMAS PARTY FUNCTION @ THE LADBROKES RACING CENTRE BM64 HCP- 2100 M

1 CHICANE Jumped awkwardly.

5 I'M CHEV Over-raced in the early stages and bumped with MOORBOOZIE leaving the home

straight.

7 MOORBOOZIE Continually steadied off heels passing the winning post on the first occasion.

Apprentice S Kennedy eased the gelding out of the race near the 1200 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed an injury to the off-fore flexor tendon and MOORBOOZIE has been stood down from racing until a veterinary certificate of soundness is received. Trainer K Hamilton advised the gelding would be retired.
