RACE 1 – JBM GROUP MAIDEN - 1000 M

2 MISTER MANIHI Performed below market expectations. Apprentice C Van Munster

reported to stewards that she felt the gelding failed to handle today's

heavy track conditions.

5 GYPSEY CHARM Fractious in the barriers. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination

after rearing in the barriers and was subsequently passed fit to run. Difficult to re-load into the barriers further delaying the start. Trainer

R Hall was advised the mare would be required to trial to the

satisfaction of stewards before racing again. Trainer R Hall requested the mare be re-examined post-race, which revealed a cast plate, and a

small abrasion to the Off-hind fetlock.

6 LITTLE RIVER LASS Difficult to load. The current warning will be continued.

8 SMASH 'N' GRAB Raced three wide without cover throughout. Shifted in under pressure

approaching the 100 metres, then continued to lay in for the

remainder of the event.

9 CELESTIAL GLOW Disappointed for clear running on the home turn.

10 GEEGEES MERCEDES Shifted out on jumping, tightening CELESTIAL GLOW, causing that filly

to lose ground.

12 PACIFIC WITNESS Shifted in under pressure approaching the 200 metres, and then

continued to lay in under pressure from around the 100 metres.

RACE 2 - GRAHAM FAMILY FUNERALS MAIDEN - 1600 M

1 ALPINE HONEY Rider T Baker reported his mount laid in throughout. Checked and

tightened between STRIDING BAY and SEDNA near the 200 metres.

3 KNIGHTS REIGN Laid out onto I'M A MACHINE near the 1400 metres, before continuing

to lay out throughout.

4 OXY BOLT Raced three wide throughout.

5 STRIDING BAY Shifted in under pressure on straightening, and again near the 200

metres, tightening ALPINE HONEY, before laying in for the remainder of the home straight, despite the efforts of Apprentice J Radley.

6 ARSENALE Shifted in under pressure abruptly near the 100 metres. Apprentice C

Pang was advised to correct his mounts sooner than he had on this

occasion.

RACE 3 - DAVE GARNIER BIRTHDAY CUP CLASS 1 HANDICAP - 1100 M

2 ALPINE FURY Held up for a clear run prior to the 200 metres. Shifted in to gain clear

running in the run to the finish.

9 SMIFFY Raced three wide without cover throughout.

RACE 4 - AVISO TAS INSURANCE BROKERS BM60 HANDICAP - 2020 M

6 SUGOI LEGEND Raced keenly throughout. Steadied off the heels of DOONICAN (IRE)

around the 1400 metres. Underwent a post-race veterinary

examination which revealed no significant findings.

9 DOONICAN (IRE) Over raced throughout the middle stages.

RACE 5 - KEVIN SHARKIE CLASS 4 - 1000 M

RACE 6 – LADBROKES SPRING HOSTED POTS BM60 HANDICAP - 1200 M

2 MAKE A DECISION Slow to muster early speed.

4 RESTRICTED ACCESS Difficult to load. Raced wide in the early stages.

RACE 7 - MINGARI+ CO BM68 HANDICAP - 1400 M

3 FIGHTING FLOYD Raced wide throughout.

5 VERBANO Raced three wide throughout.

7 THE LONGEST YARD Inclined to over race though the middle stages.
