Trainer's explanations for the late declaration of the above named riders were accepted.

RACE 1 – HYPE PRODUCTIONS MAIDEN - 1200 M

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| 1 NORTHERN CHILD | Shifted out on jumping and bumped with TEA WITH THE QUEEN. |
| 2 D'AMBIDEX | Laid in near the 150 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed some blood in the mouth from a superficial abrasion. |
| 4 SOUTHERN AURORAS | Late scratching at 12.21 when it became fractious and reared in the barrier. The mare must trial satisfactorily prior to racing again. |
| 6 ZANZI | Slow to muster early speed. |
| 7 HIGHLAND CRYSTAL | A warning was issued for the loading manners of this filly. Laid in approaching the winning post. |
| 8 TEA WITH THE QUEEN | Bumped at the start and brushed the rail at the 400 metres and shied outwards. |

RACE 2 – RAINE & HORNE NORTHERN SUBURBS MAIDEN - 1200 M

1 ALPINE ALFIE	Tightened on jumping between MIDWAY POINT and MONCLERE both of which shifted ground. Over-raced in the early stages. Laid in entering the home straight and steadied off the heels of NICALBI.
3 INFRINGEMENT (NZ)	Tightened on jumping between DON TURBOAS and NICALBI both of which shifted ground
4 MONCLERE	Laid out near the 100 metres and carried NICALBI wider.
6 NICALBI	Raced wide throughout. Laid out passing the 200 metres.
8 VERHOEVEN	Slow into stride.
9 DON TURBOAS	Laid in under pressure approaching the winning post.
10 MIDWAY POINT	Shifted out on jumping crowding ALPINE ALFIE.

RACE 3 – RAINE & HORNE HOBART & KINGBOROUGH RENTALS MAIDEN - 1430 M

2 TASSIE POWER	Over-raced in the early and middle stages and laid in in the home straight.
5 CLIMBEVERYMOUNTAIN	Taken wider on the home turn when TASSIE POWER shifted out.
7 PLAYED STRONG	Bounded on jumping and lost ground. Over-raced in the early and middle stages.
8 SEDITIOUS AWARD	Hung out making the 1200 metre turn and raced three wide until the 800 metres where it was able to obtain a position with cover.
10e SILVER GRANGE	A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

RACE 4 – LYDEN BUILDERS MAIDEN/CLASS 1 - 2050 M

1 CATCH A BREAK	Restrained off the heels of OCCASIONAL GLIMPSE neat the 1600 metres and again shortly afterwards when KICKPASS shifted in.
3 KICKPASS	Shifted in near the 1600 metres and bumped with CATCH A BREAK which was carried in and had to be restrained. Shifted in when not quite clear of CATCH A BREAK near the 1500 metres. Apprentice C Pang was severely reprimanded for careless riding under the provisions of AR 131(a).
6 ZURICH	Steadied off heels at the 1600 metres when CATCH A BREAK had to be eased.
15e SAKURA HIME	Declared a late scratching at 8 54am when trainer Y Nishitani advised the mare had sustained a minor laceration. A veterinary certificate of soundness will be required before trialing or racing again.

RACE 5 – KELLY CIVIL CONTRACTING CLASS 2 HANDICAP - 1600 M

3 MILES 'N' MILES	Slow to muster early speed. Momentarily held up for clear running entering the home straight.
6 SPECIALIZED	Raced three wide throughout.

RACE 6 – TONY CARRICK GOODWOOD HANDICAP - 1100 M

1 DURAZZO	Restrained from a wide barrier.
2 AND BEYOND	Proved difficult to load, Rider A Darmanin was directed to adhere to the starters orders when instructed by the starter to re-mount his horse.
3 TSUNAMI SAM (NZ)	Over-raced in the middle stages and shifted out approaching the 600 metres when not quite clear of GALENUS which was carried out marginally. Rider D Pires was advised to exercise care when shifting ground. Laid in near the 50 metres.
5 GALENUS	Carried wider near the 600 metres.
7 CAPTAIN CAM	Became fractious in the barriers.

RACE 7 – RAINE & HORNE COMMERCIAL HOBART BM60 HCP - 1430 M

Correct weight was delayed to view the start of the race when riders E Byrne Burke and A Darmanin stated that the gates had opened before they were ready. After viewing the films and consulting with the starter the Stewards deemed it to be a fair start and correct weight was given.

3 ETHICAL DILEMMA	Had its heels clipped passing the 400 metres by OPALSON. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.
5 STEEL MIST	Slow to begin.
8 OPALSON	Attempted to take a run between ETHICAL DILEMMA and FIORENTE DE LEGEND passing the 400 metres where there was insufficient room. As a result the gelding clipped heels blundering badly, almost dislodging Apprentice C Pang. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a laceration to the near foreleg and lameness. A veterinary certificate of soundness will be required prior to trialling or racing again. At a subsequent inquiry Apprentice C Pang was found guilty of careless riding pursuant to AR 131(a) and after taking into account his submissions on penalty, record and the high level of interference his licence to ride in races was suspended for three Tasmanian race dates. The commencement date of the suspension is to be advised at a later date.
