Comments / Explanations:

Rider A Darmanin was cleared by Medical Edge to compete in todays race meeting after being declared unfit to ride during the Tasmanian Turf Club meeting on Wednesday the 26th of November 25.

Stewards questioned trainer G Stevenson as to the reasons why THE LONGEST YARD,

BLAMEITONTHEBOOGIE and I'M CHEV were scratched from this evening's race meeting, resulting in race 2 being held with three runners only.

Mr. Stevenson stated the following:

Longest Yard – after consultation with the owner he stated that the Sheffield cup was the preferred option.

BLAMEITONTHEBOOGIE, the owner wanted to run over 1100, 1600 not suitable.

I'M CHEV had been worked shortly after acceptances and there were signs of respiratory distress after working so the horse was not considered fit to run tonight.

Mr. Stevenson further stated that it was common for his stable to nominate horses without prior consultation with the owners but scratch after consultation.

Mr Stevenson's explanations were noted and he was advised of the provisions of AR 74(b) with reference to accepting for races to affect the total number of acceptors.

RACE 1 – BOOK YOUR CHRISTMAS PARTY 10TH DECEMBER CLASS 6 – 1100 M

1 MAKE A DECISION ***Scratched***

4 ALPINE THUNDER ***Scratched***

5 JAGUAR STONE Jumped awkwardly and was slow to muster early speed. Shifted in at the

200 metres when not sufficiently clear of WHEELING (A Darmanin), causing him to steady off heels. Rider E Byrne Burke was severely reprimanded for careless riding under the provisions of AR 131(a). Held up over the concluding stages when attempting to establish a run inside

MISS TASMANIA.

6 MS TASMANIA Bounded out on jumping.

RACE 2 - BOOK NOW FOR THE CUOUNTRY CUP MARQUEE LONGFORD CUP DAY BM68 HCP - 1400 M

1 CAPAIN CAM Bounded in on jumping.

4 THE LONGEST YARD ***Scratched***

5 BLAMEITONTHEBOOGIE ***Scratched***

6 I'M CHEV ***Scratched***

RACE 3 - BOOK NOW FOR THE HOUSE OF ARRAS CORPORATE MARQUEE MAIDEN- 1200 M

1 ALPINE WHISKEY ***Scratched***

2 CALLED THROUGH Slow to muster early speed. Warning issued for manners behind the

barrier.

3 MAY WE ALL Raced three-wide throughout.

4 MESSENGER OF GOD A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

5 SURF SOULJumped inwards at the start, bumping with NIKOLSKY. Raced wide

throughout.

7 GEEGEES ACE ***Scratched***

8 VORTISTAR ***Scratched***

10 NIKOLSKY Bumped with SURF SOUL at the start. Held up for a clear run

approaching and rounding the home turn.

RACE 4 - LADBROKES LAUNCESTON CUP WEDNESDAY 25TH FEBRUARY BM60 HCP - 1200 M

1 RED SPHERE Shifted out near the 100 metres but unable to obtain a clear run before

shifting in and being placed awkwardly on the heels of RED FOX. Apprentice C Pang was advised to exercise more care when shifting

ground.

2 COOL HEART Over-raced in the early and middle stages. Shifted out near the 150

metres and contributed to the tightening of SPEED ROCK which was

checked.

5 NGAPALI BEACH Raced wide from the 800 metres.

7 POWER MAGNUM Laid in from the 200 metres and tightened the running of SPEED ROCK

at the 150 metres. Apprentice L Burke was advised she must correct her mounts sooner than she had on this occasion when they are shifting

ground.

8 SPEED ROCK Checked off the heels of COOL HEART when that mare shifted out and

POWER MAGNUM laid in.

The declaration of correct weight was delayed while the Stewards viewed vision of the start of this race. It was established that GEE GEES ME BOY (C Wells) placed its head down in the barrier as the starting gates opened. As the starting procedure had been followed and the incident had been instigated by the geldings manners the gelding was deemed to be a runner and correct weight was declared.

RACE 5 - CRESSY CHAFF CUTTERS LONGFORD CUP 1ST JANUARY C1 HCP - 1200 M

3 SNOWDONIA Over-raced early stages. Laid out and bumped TROTSKY entering the

home straight.

4 TROTSKY Bumped and became unbalanced when SNOWDONIA shifted out

entering the home straight.

8 SNOW MAIDEN Jumped awkwardly.

9 SUPER NIPPY ***Scratched***

10 ANTHEIA Raced three wide throughout.

12 STAR FORTIAN ***Scratched***

14 SMIFFY ***Scratched***

16 RED FOX ***Scratched***

RACE 6 - LADBROKES OUTDOOR ENCLOSURE CUP DAY OPEN HCP - 1600 M

1 SHARMA'S LAST Shifted in at the start, tightening THE SPIRIT OF ZERO. Raced wide from

the 800 metres.

2 GENERAL ASSEMBLY Over-raced in the early stages.

3 ASHY BOY ***Scratched***

5 SH'BOURNE MIDNIGHT Over-raced middle stages.

6 SHY GUY Shifted out at the start, tightening THE SPIRIT OF ZERO. Over-raced in

the early stages.. Bumped with EARENDEL near the 1300 metres and commenced to over-race when being restrained. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities. Trainer B Campbell stated that SHY GUY may have trained off and he would be considering spelling the

gelding.

9 EARENDEL Apprentice C Wells was questioned on the tactics adopted. She stated

that she had no firm instructions from the trainer but intended to be further forward today. After being positive from the start, she had obtained the lead but then had difficulty restraining her mount and had not intended to establish such a forward position in the early stages although she had lead on the gelding before. Stewards also questioned trainer B Campbell on the instructions to Miss Wells and he confirmed her comments, however did not expect to see EARENDEL lead by the margin it did tonight. Stewards noted their comments at this stage.

10 THE SPIRIT OF ZERO Steward's permitted rider D Pires to ride 1 kg over the allotted minimum

weight. Tightened between SHARMA'S LAST and SHY GUY at the start.

11 ES AND ES Momentarily held up for a clear run, shifting wider the track to obtain

clear running.

RACE 7 - ART HOTEL C2 HCP - 1600 M

1 AL MAXIMUS Over-raced early stages. Raced wide throughout.

2 TASSIE POWER Over-raced early stages. Laid out under pressure over the concluding

stages.

3 HENLEY EXTREME Rider C Jordan accidently dropped her whip at around the 200 metres.

5 BOUNTY BAY Stewards permitted rider C Newitt to ride 1 kg over the allotted

minimum weight.

7 RUBICK'S AFFAIR Declared a late scratching at 5 .45 pm after trainer R Hamer advised

the mare had suffered a hoof injury. A veterinary certificate of

soundness will be required before trialing of racing.

RACE 8 – LADBROKES BIG BETS BM60 HCP – 2100 M

1 ZURICH Brushed with SKELMORLIE on jumping.

2 CAPTAIN MORGAN Raced three-wide middle stages.

3 DYNAMIC DEEL Held up for a run over the concluding stages when tightened between

EXALTED CROWN and SUGOI LEGEND both of which had shifted ground

marginally. .

4 EXALTED CROWN Shifted out over the concluding stages.

5 SUGOI LEGEND Shifted in over the concluding stages.

6 SKELMORLIEBrushed with ZURICH on jumping. Restrained to take a position closer to the

rail. Over-raced in the early stages.

7 JUDGE JENNI Shifted out over the concluding stages.

GENERAL TTC 26/11/2025

E Byrne Burke was found guilty of Careless Riding in race 4 at the TTC meeting on 26/11/2025 for allowing her mount CORSA VELOCE to shift in passing the 200 metres carrying SAY IT WITH WORDS (D Parish) over the heels of TALK LIKE THAT (B Muhcu) resulting in contact and SAY IT WITH WORDS blundering. After considering submissions on penalty including her good record, E Byrnr Burke's license to ride in races was suspended for two Tasmanian Race dates. The commencement of this will be advised after Miss Byrnre Burke considers a deferment.
