– Stewards conducted an inquiry into a report that was received regarding a social media post made by licensed Owner, Trainer and Breeder Cameron Betts on the Facebook group 'Save Greyhound Racing in Tas".

After reviewing the relevant post stewards issued a charge under rule 165(a) – Conduct detrimental to the interests of greyhound racing. Mr Betts offered a guilty plea and was subsequently issued with a severe reprimand.

In arriving at penalty, Stewards considered all available evidence including Mr Betts's excellent disciplinary history and that the comments were on the low end of the scale in regard to offensiveness.

Tasracing has made concerted efforts to educate all stakeholders and participants on respectful behaviours and appropriate use of social media, and once again, would like to remind everyone of their obligations in regard to this topic
