K Sanderson advised he was unfit to ride at today's meeting. Before riding again, he must submit a medical certificate.

RACE 1 – KEVIN SHARKIE BM76 HANDICAP - 2000M

5 RUBBLEONTHEDOUBLE Shifted out on jumping. Became unbalanced when racing over the

crossing at about 1800 metres.

6 STEEL MIST Threw it's head up on jumping and was slow to begin.

RACE 2 - WINNING EDGE PRESENTATIONS MAIDEN - 1100M

The start of this race was delayed approximately 5 minutes due to the late scratching of Alpine Whiskey and Jenni The Cat at the barriers.

1 ALPINE WHISKEY Declared a late scratching at 3:06pm on veterinary advice after the

gelding's muzzle became wedged in the front of the barrier gates. Trainer B Franklin was advised the gelding would be stood down pending a veterinary clearance. No further action was taken as this gelding had reacted after JENNI THE CAT became fractious in the adjoining barrier.

2 CARDIOSPHERE Raced three wide from the 600 metres.

3 COLONEL BOGEY Held up for a clear run approaching and rounding the home turn.

5 THE LITTLE BAYBumped with CARASOUILLO on jumping and as a result lost its position.

9 SOUTHERN AURORAS Hung in under pressure over the concluding stages.

10 A QUEENS BUZZ Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after becoming fractious in

the barriers and was passed fit to run. Raced three wide throughout.

13 JENNI THE CAT Declared a late scratching at 3:05pm on veterinary advice after becoming

fractious in the barriers, when a barrier attendant's shoe contacted the mares off side flank, resulting in the mare kicking out multiple times. Trainer D Tyson was advised the mare would be stood down pending a veterinary clearance. No further action was taken due to accidental nature

of the incident.

14 NANDI CLAN Laid in over the concluding stages.

16e NO SURPRISES Re-saddled behind the barriers.

RACE 3 – LIFE MEMBER MR BARRY TARRANTO MAIDEN - 1400M

1 LORD HEAR US Laid in throughout the run to the finish.

2 MONCLERE Shifted in at about the 300 metres, tightening ALPINE ALFIE.

3 NEED A GIGGLE Held up for the majority of the home straight. Checked off the heels of

NICALBI approaching the 200 metres.

5 VERHOEVEN Held up for clear running in the run to the finish. Bumped by NICALBI at

about the 300 metres.

6 CEEYA SUNSHINE Laid in entering the home straight.

11 GLOBAL MIRACLE Hung out throughout the home straight.

15e NICALBI Held up for clear running in the run to the finish. Checked over the heels of

MONCLERE when that horse shifted in marginally.

16e ALPINE ALFIE Laid in entering the home straight.

RACE 4 - LADBROKES MEGA MULTI BM60 HANDICAP - 1400M

2 KAKIA Laid in over the concluding stages. Rider B Muchu was advised to

exercise more care when his mounts are shifting ground.

3 RUNAWAY STATEMENT Held up for clear running in the run to the finish.

5 RALPH THE ROCKET Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed the

gelding to have bled from both nostrils. Trainer J Blacker was advised the gelding will be stood down under AR79(4)(b); the gelding must not be trained on an official racetrack, private establishment, or any other place for a period of two (2) months, then must not start in an official race for a period of three (3) months, and only after a satisfactory 1000

meter gallop in the presence of stewards.

6 GINGERSON Raced three wide from the 800. Inclined to over race throughout. Held

up for clear running from about the 150 metres when KAKIA laid in.

RACE 5 - AVISO TAS INSURANCE BROKERS CLASS 3 HCP - 1400M

4 GEORGARONI Held up momentarily behind ROYAL DISPATCH (NZ) before shifting

outwards abruptly.

6 GEMS EAGLE Bounded on jumping and as a result was slow to begin. Raced three wide

throughout. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to

have a high heart rate and slow recovery.

RACE 6 - KEVIN SHARKIE CLASS 1 HANDICAP - 1100M

4 SH'BOURNE ANGEL Raced three wide throughout. A post-race veterinary examination

revealed a high heart rate and slow recovery.

6 HUBUBBAJAHN Shifted in under pressure over the concluding stages.

7 FILLENTINA Held up for clear running until nearing the 200 metres.

8 GAZZA'S SPIRIT Rider T Baker reported his mount felt amiss throughout the run. A post-

race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

10 AZITKALA Apprentice C Van Munster reported the mare felt amiss in her action

throughout. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no

abnormalities. A warning was placed on the mare for poor performance.

RACE 7 – LADBROKES BIG BETS BM68 HCP – 1000M

1 ETOSHA Shifted in on jumping, bumping with ARAYA SUNSHINE. Raced three wide

early. Compounded over the concluding stages.

4 STARDARMUS Jumped awkwardly, brushing the outside barrier partition.

6 POPILITA Shifted in under pressure over the concluding stages.

9 ARAYA SUNSHINE Carried in after the start, bumping with SWEET LUCIFER.

RACE 8 – LIFE MEMBER MR ANDREW SCANLON MAIDEN/CLASS 1 - 2000M

1 CATCH A BREAK Compounded over the concluding stages.

3 STRATOJACK Shifted in, approaching the 600 metres , tightening the running of ALPINE

COWGIRL, obliging E Byrne Burke to stop riding. Stewards issued a reprimand to apprentice J Johnstone for Careless Riding under the

provisions of AR 131(a).

4 TASSIE POWER Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

5 ALPINE COWGIRL Had to be steadied off the heels of SIR JAG on the home turn. Stewards will

inquire into the reasons for this occurring at the next race meeting on

10/12/2025. .

7 TIDEFORD(NZ) Caught three wide throughout.
