Apprentice S Kennedy was unable to attend tonight's meeting due to a flight cancellation.

RACE 1 - MYLES BAKER ELECTRICAL 2YO MAIDEN - 1100 M

1 ARISTOPOLOS On jumping away was inconvenienced by KING CANDY which

shifted in. Held up rounding the home turn and was then steadied outwards away from the heels of KING CANDY.

2 BRUTAL EMPIRE Inclined to over race in the early stages and commenced to hang

out leaving the 800 metres. Trainer Mr J Blacker was advised that a warning would be placed on the colt in relation to its racing

manners.

3 KING CANDY Shifted in on jumping away and brushed ARISTOPOLOS.

6 BENGO Fractious behind the barriers dislodging C Wells. Apprentice

Wells underwent a medical examination and was subsequently

cleared to ride.

The filly then underwent a veterinary examination and was

cleared to race.

After considering the barrier manners of BENGO, Trainer Mr G Mculloch was advised that the filly will not be permitted to race until it has trialed to the satisfaction of the Stewards on one

occasion.

Shortly after the start shifted in when racing greenly and

hampered MOMENTSLIKETHESE on two occasions. Raced wide

without cover throughout

7 MOMENTSLIKETHESE For a short distance after the start was hampered on two

occasions by BENGO which shifted in when racing greenly.

9 TOO POETIC Slow into stride.

RACE 2 - LADBROKES LAUNCESTON CUP PACKAGES ON SALE NOW! MAIDEN - 1200 M

1 DARK WINTER Inclined to lay in under pressure in the home straight.

2 MISTER MANIHI Over-raced during the early and middle stages

3 PIPE DOWN ELLIE Raced wide without cover throughout.

4 FAVOURITE DEPUTY When the pace of the race eased near the 800 metres had to be

steadied when awkwardly placed on heels.

5 GEEGEES ACE When the pace of the raced eased near the 800 metres had to be

steadied away from the heels of DARK WINTER which raced up onto

the heels of SH'BOURNE RISING and shifted out.

6 MEGALITA Was inclined to lay in under pressure over the concluding stages

10 ROYAL SCENE Raced wide without cover for the majority

11 SH'BOURNE RISING When the pace of the race eased near the 800 metres had to be

steadied away from heels.

12 BAD ALIBI Tightened for room on jumping away between MEGALITA and UP TO

TORI both of which shifted ground. Inclined to over-race in the early stages. When the pace of the race eased near the 800 metres was steadied when awkwardly placed on heels. Leaving the 200 metres was disappointed for a run to the inside of MR MANIHI and was then

obliged to shift to the outside of that runner heels to obtain clear

running

13 UP TO TORI Raced wide without cover for the majority. A post-race veterinary

examination failed to reveal any significant abnormalities.

RACE 3 – CRESSY CHAFF CUTTERS LONGFORD CUP 1ST JANUARY MAIDEN - 1600 M

3 OXY BOLT Change of tactics – To be ridden on pace should circumstances permit

Settled at the rear of the field after being slow into stride. Raced wide without cover throughout. Rider reported the gelding did not feel comfortable in its action during the race. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which failed to reveal any significant

abnormalities.

10 CHEEKY TILLY Bumped with MISS MABEL on jumping away and was then restrained to

take up a position closer to the running rail.

12 MISS MABEL Bumped with CHEEKY TILLY on jumping away and then raced wide

without cover for the majority.

RACE 4 – PLAY SUMMER SWHEEPS 10TH DEC TO WIN HEAPS C1 HCP - 1600 M

2 BLOOMING EDGE Leaving the 100 metres was inclined to over-race for a short distance.

4 ZANZI A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be suffering

from thumps.

7 FLORENCE GLASS On jumping away was bumped by SAY IT WITH WORDS which after

bumping with COOL CONQUEST was then taken inwards by that runner.

8 TIZSA NICE DROP Approaching the 100 metres was inclined to lay out under pressure.

9 COOL CONQUEST On jumping away bumped with SAY IT WITH WORDS. Leaving the 1200

metres was inclined to over-race for a short distance.

10 MISS TERASITA Raced four wide without cover from the 800 metres.

12 SAY IT WITH WORDS On jumping away was bumped by COOL CONQUEST and a short

distance later was then taken inwards and bumped with FLORENCE GLASS. Rider D Parish stated that after receiving interference in the early stages the gelding was not suited racing back in the field.

RACE 5 - BWS 3YO TROPHY - 1400 M

1 MAZZINI Near the 150 metres was inclined to lay in under pressure and made

contact with the running rail.

2 CRACK THE SHUTTERS Jumped away awkwardly.

4 STROAK OF ART Inclined to over-race in the early stages.

5 BRIGHT NIGHT Raced wide without cover from the 600 metres. Rounding the home turn

was inclined to lay in and had to be eased away form the heels of WOLF JUNIOR which at the same time shifted out slightly. Thereafter continued

to lay in under pressure in the home straight.

6 DAYTONA DIVA Was inclined to lay in under pressure in the home straight.

RACE 6 - BOOK FOR THE HOUSE OF ARRAS CORPORATE MARQUEE CUP DAY C2 HCP - 1100 M

2 LADY GALADRIEL Rounding the home turn was taken wider on the track by COAL RIVER

which shifted out to improve.

4 COAL RIVER Rounding the home turn shifted out to improve taking LADY GALADRIEL

wider on the track.

5 OHSHE'STROUBLE Fractious in the barriers. Reared as the start was affected and lost

considerable ground. Inclined to lay in under pressure in the home

straight.

8 PLATINUM REGGAE Raced wide without cover throughout. Rider D Parish reported she had

to make use of her mount in the early stages to take up a forward position. D Parish further added that when placed under pressure the mare failed to respond to her riding and didn't finish the race off. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be lame in the left foreleg as well as making respiratory noises. Trainer T Wells was advised that the mare will not be permitted to race until a veterinary

clearance has been provided.

9 RED FOX Permission was granted to allow Jockey C Newitt to ride 1kg over its

allotted weight. Raced wide without cover for the majority.

RACE 7 - PFD FOOD SERVICES CONOUERING STAKES - 1400 M

1 BANK MAUR Tightened near the 1200 metres by SHUSHI EXPRESS shifting in and was

taken in onto the hindquarters of ALVARINHO and had to be checked.

Raced three wide without cover throughout.

5 DURAZZO Near the 1200 metres had to be checked when ALVARINHO was

crowded and taken inwards. Held up rounding the home turn and in the

early stages of the home straight.

9 SUSHI EXPRESS Shifted in at the 1200 metres and momentarily tightened the running of

BANK MAUR.

10 ASHFALL Near the 1300 metres had to be steadied when tightened for room

between FIRST ACCUSED and THESPIAN WATERS which shifted in. Jockey T Baker the rider of THESPIAN WATERS was issued a severe reprimand for Careless Riding under the provisions of AR 131(a) and was advised that he is to ensure that he is sufficiently clear of runners when shifting ground. Near the 1100 metres had to be checked when

shifting ground. Near the 1100 metres had to be checked when tightened for room to the inside of JUST CRUISIN' which shifted in..

11 JUST CRUISIN' Shifted in at the 1100 metres when not clear of ASHFALL which was

checked.

12 ALVARINHO Near the 1200 metres had to be checked.

The Stewards inquired into an incident near the 1200 metres. Evidence was taken from the riders of BANK MAUR (C NEWITT), DURAZZO (K SANDERSON), THESPIAN WATERS (T BAKER), SUSHI EXPRESS (L BINGLEY) and ALVARINHO (E BYRNE BURKE). It was established that near the 1200 metres SUSHI EXPRESS had shifted in momentarily when not clear of BANK MAUR. BANK MAUR'S hindquarters contacted ALVARHINO and these runners bufferted for some distance and shifted in resulting in DURAZZO to their inside having to be checked off the heels of ALVARHINO and THESPIAN WATERS which had shifted out marginally at the same time. Apprentice L Bingley was severely reprimanded for Careless Riding under the provisions of AR 131(a) for being insufficiently clear of BANK MAUR when shifting in. In not taking further action Stewards took into account that the initial tightening was momentary and had been corrected by Miss Bingley.

The Stewards inquired into an incident near the 1100 metres where ASHFALL had to be checked. Evidence was taken from the riders of ASHFALL (S TSAIKOS) and JUST CRUISIN (J STANLEY). J STANLEY pleaded guilty to a charge of Carless Riding under AR 131(a) for Carless Riding in that near the 1100 metres he permitted JUST CRUISIN to shift in when insufficiently clear of ASHFALL which had to be checked. After considering his submissions on penalty including his good record, J Stanley was suspended from riding in races for one (1) Tasmanian race date being Sunday 14 December 2025. He was advised of his rights of appeal.

RACE 8 - CRAIG HANSON MEMORIAL BM68 HCP - 1600 M

2 LOVIN' BEV Near the 200 metres shifted out abruptly and had to be corrected by its

rider.

3 FLOSSING (NZ) Slow to begin. Near the 200 metres had to be eased and was taken wider

on the track by LOVIN' BEV which shifted out abruptly before being

corrected by its rider.

RACE 9 – BOOK INTO THE COUNTRY CUP MARQUEE LONGFORD CUP DAY BM64 HCP - 1200 M

2 BAYSIDE Was bumped by WITHIN SIGHT on jumping away which shifted in slightly.

5 WITHIN SIGHT Shifted in on jumping away and bumped with BAYSIDE.

10 GIE IT LALDY Slow to begin.
