RACE 1 – 1:22PM – T A BRICKNELL MAIDEN - 1800 METRES

| 1 LORD HEAR US | Three wide in middle stages. Entering the home straight shifted in and bumped heavily with STRIDING BAY. At the 100m mark was bumped when STRIDING BAY shifted out. |
| 2 OXY BOLT | Connections advised that after the disappointing performance in today's event, the Gelding will be retired. |
| 4 STRIDING BAY | Bumped by LORD HEAR US entering home straight. Approaching 100m shifted out and bumped LORD HEAR US. |
| 5 ROCKESTJERNE | Fractious in the gates underwent vets' examination. Passed fit to run. Trainer R Hamer was advised that ROCKESTJERNE will need to undergo a satisfactory trial before racing again. |

Prior to correct weight being called the connections of LORD HEAR US wished to view the official patrol film in view of lodging an official protest. After viewing the film, the connections were satisfied and correct weight was declared.

RACE 2 – 1:54PM INCITEC PIVOT MAIDEN - 1400 METRES

1 ALPINE HONEY	Raced wide throughout.
2 GRIM TRIGGER (NZ)	Raced ungenerously near 1200m and gave ground from the 400m. Underwent post-race veterinary examination which revealed it had suffered a cardiac arrhythmia episode. Trainer C Oliver advised that a veterinary report including an ECG examination needs to be tendered. The horse will then be required to complete a gallop of at least 1000m and be subjected to cardiac auscultation within fifteen minutes of the horse completing that gallop.
4 MISTER MANIHI	Over raced early.
6 PROSPEROUS MISS	Raced three wide throughout.
7 SEDITIOUS AWARD	Slow to muster.

At the conclusion of the race, Jockey Shayleigh Ingelse was dislodged from NICALBI. Horse recaptured without incident. Jockey examined by Medical Edge officers and passed fit to fulfill riding engagements.

RACE 3 – 2:29PM TASMANIAN LIVESTOCK SERVICES BM68 Hcp - 1400 METRES

2 RUBBLE 'N' FUDD	Over raced early and middle stages. Laid out making the turn at 1200m and brushed with ARAYA SUNSHINE.
3 KAKIA	Inclined to shift out home straight.
5 DIESEL'S SUNSHINE	Upon straightening had a run between ARAYA SUNSHINE and KAKIA however was not fully established in the position. As a result was steadied and taken back to the inside of KAKIA. Stewards were satisfied that no further action was to be taken.
6 ARAYA SUNSHINE	Slow away. Inclined to lay in home straight.

Prior to correct weight, A Roach, trainer of DIESEL'S SUNSHINE viewed film of home straight in run to the finish. After viewing film trainer was satisfied and correct weight was declared.

RACE 4 – 3:09PM LADBROKES SPRING HOSTED POTS BM60 Hcp - 1400 METRES

1 COOL HEART Jumped awkwardly losing 2 lengths

3 MIGHTYMAXI Over raced early stages.

7 VALIANT KHAN Hung out throughout.

RACE 5 – 3:49PM TTMI & CASE IH BM60 Hcp - 1400 METRES

2 ETHICAL DILEMMA Three wide early

4 STEEL MIST Slow Away

RACE 6 – 4:29PM ARMIDALE STUD BM68 Hcp - 800 METRES

1 WHEELING Brushed AMANT FRANCAIS approaching 600m

4 AMANT FRANCAIS Approaching 600m brushed WHEELING.

7 VOLKANOVSKI Laid out approaching home turn. Laid in under pressure concluding stages.

8 CAPABELLE Resaddled behind barriers. Slow away.

RACE 7 – 5:09PM CRESSY CHAFF CUTTERS LONGFORD CUP - 1800 METRES

1 DISTRUSTFUL AWARD Slow away.

3 GENERAL ASSEMBLY Stewards granted permission for Lauren Bingley to not claim any portion of her allowance. Rider Luren Bingley explained that her mount overreacted leaving the home straight when she steadied to allow SNOW EAGLE to cross.

5 FAST THINKER Shifted out under pressure in run to the finish.

8 RICH GLOW Fractious in barriers. Jumped crossing near 1400m then commenced to over race.

1 ZURICH Slow away.

2 AL MAXIMUS Slow away.
