Shifted in marginally near the 1000m hampering ZULU FIELDS

Slow to begin 2 lengths

7 THE PIRATE QUEEN

Raced 3 wide throughout

9 ZULU FIELDS

Rider D. Pires was granted permission to ride +0.5kg over. Was hampered near the 1000m when ROUNDLE PARK shifted in which then commenced to over race.

11 WILD NIGHTS

Prior to jumping was fractious in the barriers and had contacted the front gates which prematurely opened. Then jumped awkwardly as the start was affected.

RACE 6 – 8:38PM – THE AGENCY BM60 HCP – 1200 METRES**1 HIGH TAIL EAGLE**

Late scratching at 8:41pm on veterinary advice. It was fractious in barrier had its legs over the barrier partition. Trainer J. Blacker was advised that the gelding will need a veterinary certificate prior to trialing and will have to complete a satisfactory trial.

Jumped out and brushed with NAZORIAN

7 GEEGEES LEGACY

Laid out under pressure over the concluding stages brushing with NAZORIAN

8 NAZORIAN

Brushed by SANDUAL on jumping and then brushed by GEEGEES LEGACY which shifted out near the winning post

9 I'M KEEFE

Raced 3 wide throughout

RACE 7 – 9:08PM – WESTBURY CRICKET CLUB CLASS 6 – 1100 METRES**5 MS TASMANIA**

Laid out rounding the 800m turn and then over raced thereafter

6 SILVER DAGGER

Slow to muster
