RACE 1 – 6:04PM – HOUSE OF ARRAS FASHIONS ON THE FIELD MAIDEN – 1200 METRES

1 ALPINE WHISKEY

Jumped inwards at start. When jockey C Newitt was questioned about the performance, he explained that when put under pressure its action was not fluent and inclined to hang outwards. A post race vet examination revealed no abnormalities.

2 ILOVETHISTOWN	Laid out under pressure over the concluding stages.
4 TRIBAL COUNCIL	Jumped awkwardly. Slow into stride.
5 GENUINE LADY	Jumped outwards at start
7 RUSHONOVA	Steadied off heels near 800m.

**RACE 2 – 6:34PM – BOOK NOW FOR HOUSE OF ARRAS CORPORATE MARQUEE CUP DAY
C3 HCP – 1600 METRES**

1 DAYTONA DIVA	Over raced in early stages. Laid out under pressure in concluding stages.
5 STEELE MY SUNSHINE	Stewards granted permission for C Newitt to ride 1kg over his allotted weight.

**RACE 3 – 7:10PM – LADBROKES LAUNCESTON CUP DAY WEDNESDAY 25TH FEBRUARY C2
HCP - 1200 METRES**

1 ALPINE FURY	Fractious in barriers prior to start.
4 ALPINE TROUT	Jumped out at start and brushed HARTMAN.
5 STAR WALKIN'	Raced three wide throughout.

Prior to correct weight being called the rider of WEDNESDAY'S BOSS wished to view the photo finish. After viewing the photo B Muhcu was satisfied with the placings and correct weight was given.

RACE 4 – 7:40PM – GALLOPING GOURMET TOUR HEADING TO RICHMOND C1 HCP - 1400 METRES

1 BENEFICIARY	When questioned, apprentice C Wells stated that after initially being held up by a tiring runner, when in the clear her mount wanted to lay out. After straightening, the gelding ran on strongly over the concluding stages.
4 AMAHLOSI	A post race vet inspection revealed no abnormalities.

7 PACIFIC WITNESS	Raced three wide early to middle stages. At the 250m rolled in crowding WHISPERING MATILDA into GIE IT LALDY. Rider L Burke was shown the film and advised to exercise care when her mount shifts ground.
11 WHISPER OF MATILDA	Restrained after jumping to take up a position closer to the rail. Crowded on straightening when PACIFIC WITNESS rolled in.
14 GAZZA'S SPIRIT	Raced four wide from the 800m.

RACE 5 – 8:20PM – LADBROKES CUP EVE LUNCHEON @ COUNTRY CLUB TASMANIA BM50 HCP - 2100 METRES

1 JOHNNIE PINCH	Laid out under pressure home straight.
2 IFFYCOULD (NZ)	Restrained just after the start to find a position closer to the rail.
3 ZURICH	Raced wide throughout
4 CAPTAIN MORGAN (NZ)	Slow away.
7 JUDGE JENNI	Jockey C Newitt stated that in his opinion the mare failed to back up from its previous start and failed to run on from the 1200m. A post-race vet examination revealed no apparent abnormalities but trainer advised should anything arise on return to stables that stewards be informed.
8 THIN RED LINE	Cast off hind shoe.
9 FLORENCE GLASS	Raced four wide from the 800m.
10 THE CAST OFF	Raced five wide from the 800m.

RACE 6 – 8:50PM – KEVIN SHARKIE LAUNCESTON GUINEAS – 2000 METRES

1 CRACK THE SHUTTERS	Shifted out under pressure and hampered WOLF JUNIOR.
2 CAELIUS	Bumped by WOLF JUNIOR at the start. Raced four wide from 600m.
3 WOLF JUNIOR	Jumped in at the start and bumped with CAELIUS. Hampered and carried wider at 200m.

5 ROUSING LEVI

Three wide middle stages.

Stewards issued jockey A Darmanin with a severe reprimand under AR131(a) for allowing his mount to shift out under riding near the 200m, resulting in WOLF JUNIOR (C Newitt) being carried out over the heels of DAD AND DAVE (E Walsh).

RACE 7 – 9:20PM – FASHION FOR FILLIES OAKS NIGHT BM68 HCP – 1400 METRES

3 CAPTAIN CAM

Fractious in barriers prior to the start. Over raced early to middle stages. Raced three wide from 800m.

5 BLOOMTIME

Shifted in at the start and bumped DESIGNER DREAMER and brushed NICCO THE GREEK. Steadied off heels rounding the turn at 800m. When questioned, jockey A Darmanin stated he was disappointed with the performance of the mare which had enjoyed an economical run and when placed under pressure near the 200m, failed to respond.

6 AGNETE

Over raced early to middle stages.

7 GEE GEE CAN WIN

Slow into stride

RACE 8 – 9:51PM – KEVIN SHARKIE TASMANIAN OAKS FRIDAY NIGHT 20TH FEB BM60 HCP – 1100 METRES

1 EASTCOAST MISS

Momentarily held up approaching the home turn. Shifted out under pressure over concluding stages.

3 GET 'EM WARRIOR

Laid in under pressure from the 100m

5 NAZORIAN

Jumped inwards at the start.
