Comments / Explanations:

Stewards accepted trainer P Hill's explanation for the late declaration of N Punch in race 2 today.

RACE 1 – LADBROKES LAUNCESTON CUP WEDNESDAY 25TH FEBRUARY MAIDEN – 1220 METRES

2 GEE GEES BROTHER Raced three wide early.

3 GUBER Raced four wide throughout.

4 SH'BOURNE POWER Slow to begin. Lost off fore shoe in running.

5 DENNYSON Difficult to load, a warning was issued. Over raced in the early stages.

6 MCVEIGH	Shifted ground on jumping.
7 REBEL'S GIRL	Steadied off the heels of VANSITTART at 650m mark.
10 UNA PALOMA BLANCA	Compounded over the concluding stages.
12 BAD ALIBI	Shifted inwards on jumping bumping heavily with VANSITTART. Over-raced in the middle stages.
13 RUSHONOVIA	Over raced early. Brushed running rail rounding home turn.
15 VANSITTART	Tightened for room after jumping between BAD ALIBI and MCVEIGH both who shifted ground. Raced fiercely leaving the 800 metre turn and rider B Muhcu reported that he had difficulty restraining his mount. Shifted out near the 650 metres inconveniencing REBEL'S GIRL. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a superficial abrasion to the near fore tendon.

Stewards inquired into an incident passing the 700m when VANSITTART (B Muhcu) began racing fiercely, shifted out when not fully clear of REBEL'S GIRL (C Wells) which had to be steadied. Mr Muhcu was advised to take more care when shifting ground in future. Stewards placed a warning on the racing manners of VANSITTART.

When questioned about the disappointing performance of REBEL'S GIRL, rider C Wells stated that approaching the home turn the mare resented racing between runners and failed to respond to her riding from that point on.

RACE 2 – KEVIN SHARKIE TASMANIAN OAKS NIGHT 20TH FEBRUARY MAIDEN – 1420 METRES

1 ALPINE WHISKEY	Laid out under pressure in concluding stages.
2 ISSIMA LOUVRE	Rider K Sanderson eased his mount down in the home straight when it compounded rapidly. A post-race veterinary examination revealed it had bled from both nostrils for the second time. Under the provisions of AR79(6) after bleeding for a second time the horse will be ineligible to start again in any race.
3 JUST BOBBY	Raced three wide early
6 SILVER GRANGE	When questioned on the apparent improved performance of the gelding Trainer A Brakey stated that it had suffered an injury to its withers in the previous preparation which had taken a significant amount of time to resolve.

7 ALPINE WOODS	Crowded by JUST BOBBY which shifted in on jumping.
8 COLLEEN'S CROWN	Had to check off the heels of NATALDI after it was checked on the home turn, then shifted out over the heels of ISSIMA LOUVRE when it compounded. Lost near hind and off fore shoes in running.
9 GENUINE LADY	Over raced in early and middle stages.
14 NATALDI	Slow into stride. Inconvenienced by ISSIMA LOUVRE from 400m and had to check off its heels when it compounded.

RACE 3 – FASHIONS FOR FILLIES MAIDEN/CLASS 1 – 1620 METRES

1 BELLSPROUT (NZ)	SCRATCHED
3 OPENSEA (NZ)	Performed below expectations, a post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities. .
7 CALLED THROUGH	Held up for a clear run entering the home straight between LAST TREMBLE and WYNDINTHEWILLOWS until the 150 metres when LAST TREMBLE shifted in when not clear and it had to be restrained and checked over heels.
8 LAST TREMBLE	Shifted in approaching the 150 metres checking CALLED THROUGH.
11 TIZA NICE DROP	Held up behind VORTISAR from the home turn for the remainder of the race.
13 WYNDINTHEWILLOWS (NZ)	Laid in under pressure entering the home straight.
15 MISS MABEL	SCRATCHED

Apprentice J Johnstone was found guilty of a charge under AR 131(a) Careless Riding for allowing his mount to shift in when not clear of CALLED THROUGH approaching the 150 metres. CALLED THROUGH had been held up for a run between his mount and WYBDINTHEWILLOWS. After taking submissions on penalty his licence to ride in races was suspended for 1 Tasmanian race date(commencement to be advised.)

RACE 4 – ART HOTEL BM60 HCP – 1120 METRES

1 STREET DIVA

Jumped out and bumped with NAZORIAN. Tightened and carried in shortly after the start when NAZORIAN shifted in. Held up for a clear run on the home turn before shifting in and placing Belpine Miss in restricted room. Apprentice J Johnstone was advised that he must ensure he has sufficient room when shifting ground in similar circumstances.

SCRATCHED

5 BELPINE MISS

Bumped heavily on jumping with SWINGING IT after being carried in by STREET DIVA. Tightened for racing room approaching the 1000m when runners shifted in from the outside. Raced in restricted room making the home turn and hampered When STREET DIVA obtained a tight run to its outside. .

6 GEEGEES LEGACY

Shifted in approaching the 1000 metres resulting in NAZORIAN being unable to relieve pressure to the runners inside it.

~~7 ROUNGLE PARK~~

SCRATCHED

9 SWINGING IT

Checked approaching the 1000 metres when runners to the outside were carried inwards.

11 NAZORIAN

Shifted in near 1000 metres carrying STREET DIVA in onto BELPINE MISS which in turn checked SWINGING IT.

~~12 ALPINE JOY~~

SCRATCHED

Stewards inquired into SWINGING IT being checked near the 1000 metres. It was established after jumping NAZORIAN and STREET DIVA bumped heavily which commenced NAZORIAN shifting in despite L Bingley turning her mount outward as it continued to shift in. Ultimately this led to STREET DIVA being carried in onto BELPINE MISS which shifted in checking SWINGING IT. At the same time GEEGEES LEGACY had followed NAZORIAN across and consequently NAZORIAN was unable to relieve the pressure. Stewards deemed that no one rider was responsible for the interference, however all riders were advised to exercise more care.

2 OZONICA

Laid out under pressure entering home straight and again over concluding stages.

RACE 6 – SYDESTON CUP – 2150 METRES

2 KALIUWAA FALLS (NZ)	Late scratching at 12.37pm due to injury. A veterinary certificate of soundness will be required prior to racing again.
4 FAST THINKER	Over raced middle stages
9 ZULU ANGEL	Dwelt at the start and lost substantial ground.

RACE 7 – MAGIC MILLIONS YEARLING SALES 23RD FEB CLASS 2 HCP – 1220 METRES

2 AZONTO	Laid out under pressure in home straight.
3 SIMPLY DEEP	Just awkwardly. Slow into stride.
5 SCARLETTI	Over raced middle stages.
6 MATERIAL MADAM	Laid out rounding the turn at 800m.

RACE 8 – CUP EVE LUNCHEON @ COUNTRY CLUB TASMANIA BM68 HCP – 1420 METRES

6 GEE GEE CAN WIN	Contacted the running rail passing the 800 metres.
