Sprint lane in operation.

Trainers with multiple runners in a race advised Stewards of intended tactics.

RACE 1 – DOWNBYTHE SEASIDE @ WOODLANDS STUD PACE – 2090M MS

Stewards reprimanded R. Ashwood (DEMAND RESPECT) for when going to lead one out line in front straight with a lap to travel reducing the speed which inconvenienced runners in one out line. R 162 (10 (u).

A warning placed on IDEN OLIVER (C. Salter) which raced greenly approaching winning post with a lap to run resulting in WINDY HANOVER (M. Jones) contacting its sulky and breaking gait.

RACE 2 – LATHER UP @ WOODLANDS STUD PACE – 2090M MS

Stewards reprimanded J. Watson (OH NO NEVER AGAIN) for crowding HOWSWEETTHE SOUND (D. Ford) when attempting to take lead near winning post after start. R 163 (1) (a) (i) OH NO NEVER AGAIN when checked off HOWSWEETTHE SOUND galloped.

VINCENTS RAINBOW (P. Jakowenko) inconvenienced and galloped near 350 Metres when TOP HANOVER (R. Hillier) commenced to give ground. A post-race veterinary examination of TOP HANOVER revealed no abnormalities. Trainer R. Hillier advised that he would be recommending to owners that gelding be retired.

RACE 3 – TASMANIAN HORSE TRANSPORT PACE – 2090M MS

When questioned as to what appeared an improved performance from COOLANDCOLLECT Trainer W. Yole stated that the gelding didn't handle the Carrick track at its most recent run and in today's race had been suited by having an economical run in transit.

A post-race veterinary examination of LOUTENANT (H. Woods) which was beaten 108 Metres revealed no abnormalities. Trainer W. Yole advised that gelding is stood down until it can trial competitively.

RACE 4 – LADBROKES PACE – 2090M SS

HURRICANE ROCK (J. Duggan) and GOODTIME OSCAR (D. Ford) galloped for a short distance at start.

Race 5 – FEHLBERGS PRODUCE SPRINTLANE PACE – 1609M MS

The offside sulky tyre on LUVTHAT (T. Ford) contacted and punctured near 450 Metres by HIGH ACHIEVER (R. Hillier) and a fine of \$100 imposed on R. Hillier. R 168 (1) (a).

RACE 6 – SMITHAWARDS PACE – 2090M MS

SPOOKY GIRL underwent a veterinary examination after arriving on course as it had slipped when being unloaded from float and sustained abrasions to both hocks. Acting on advice from Veterinary Officer SPOOKY GIRL was a late scratching at 4.30pm. Stood down until a veterinary clearance tendered.

Reins person C. Salter (IDEN REGAL WAVE) fined \$100 for crossing his reins near 300 Metres and using whip with a free hand. R 163 A (1)

Stewards took no action against Kayleb Williams (ITSMENOTYOU) for whilst leading through first half last mile outside prescribed time 65 seconds (.02 second) taking into account the prevailing conditions. R 162 (1) (y)

RACE 7 – GROUP 1 TASMANIA CUP 28TH FEBRUARY PACE – 2090M MS

Stewards questioned K. Willaims (ASHANTE QUEEN) who was represented at the inquiry by Driving Master Mr. N. Webberley as to why he came off the peg line to race without cover approaching front straight first occasion. Mr. Williams stated that his instructions had been to lead and when unable to do so as the mare lacks high speed, he made the decision to rate it and with second quarter last mile in 31.7 seconds this had not been detrimental to its chances. In noting his comments Stewards advised him to ensure he always drives in a manner which does not leave his intentions open for question. Post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

RACE 8 – TYPEFACE PACE – 1609M MS

HEY FRANCO (D. Ford), which threw its down on the track prior to start, underwent a veterinary examination and passed fit to start. At request of the Trainer HEY FRANCO will be excluded from mobile barrier draw however Stewards placed a warning in respect to its manners

Approaching the finish of the race MILLYCENT (M. Yole) which was held up for clear running contacted the sulky I GOTTA GO (R. Ashwood). Stewards issued a caution to M. Yole.
