Sprint lane in operation.

Trainers with multiple runners in a race advised Stewards of intended tactics.

RACE 1 – FEHLBERGS PRODUCE SPRINTLANE PACE – 1609M MS

No racing incidents.

RAC 2 – TYPEFACE PACE – 2090M MS

RUBINS PLIGHT underwent a pre-race veterinary examination in accordance with aged horse policy and passed fit to start.

IMPERIAL LAZ (J. Watson) utilized sprint lane to win race.

RACE 3 – WOODLANDS STUD GENETIC EDGE PACE – 2090M MS

Stewards advised J. Watson (OH NO NEVER AGAIN) to ensure he allows sufficient room when crossing runners as in this race he allowed minimal room only when crossing YURUGA LASS (H. Woods) shortly after start.

A hopple carrying strap on OH NO NEVER AGAIN became detached in running.

RACE 4 – LADBROKES TASMANIA CUP HEAT ONE – 2579M MS

Approaching the finish of race PARDOE PLUGGA (C. Castles) took a tight run between DALTON SHARD (J. Laughler) and RAKADAN (J. Watson) who was inclined to lay outwards.

RACE 5 – TASMANIAN HORSE TRANSPORT PACE – 1609M MS

HEY FRANCO (D. Ford) a late scratching at 7.01pm after it had thrown itself down on the track whilst runners were circling prior to the start. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities. Trainer T. Langley advised that gelding is stood down until he completes a satisfactory trial.

The sulky stays of OUR WILLOW (L. Older) and LOUGLE (J. Chibnall) engaged briefly in back straight final occasion.

RACE 6 – SMITHAWARDS PACE – 1609M MS

SHALLOW BEACH (D. Ford) hung outwards in front straight final occasion and inconvenienced PARK LANE (G. Rattray) and SOUTHERN LUCK (R. Hillier).

A post-race veterinary examination of SHALLOW BEACH confirmed it had suffered a bleed attack. Trainer D. Ford advised the rig is stood down for Three months. R 101 (3) (a)

RACE 7 – TASMANIAN YEARLING SALE 14TH FEBRUARY PACE – 2090M MS

Reins person D. Ford (ALWAYS AURORA) fined \$ 100 for whilst leading race outside prescribed time of 65 seconds first half last mile. (66.1 seconds) R 162 (1) (y).

Stewards reminded reins person Peter Jakowenko that he is to ensure when circling prior to start of a race he does not interfere with any runner or official as following race 3 Clerk of Course Ms. S. Cotton expressed concern with the actions of Mr. Jakowenko.

Stewards questioned reins person Liam Older, in respect to remarks he made in presence Clerk of Course Ms. C. Van Munster when leaving the track following running of Race 3. He subsequently pleaded guilty to a charge of misconduct in that he used improper language for which he was fined \$100. R 231 (2).
