### Comments / Explanations:

Stewards accepted the explanation from trainer G McCulloch for the later declaration of rider.

Jockey K Sanderson was unable to fulfil riding engagements due to an injury prior to the meeting.

After sustaining an injury prior to the start of Race 1, rider S Ingelse was assessed unfit to complete her remaining rides. A medical certificate will be required prior to resuming trackwork or race riding.

## **RACE 1 – LADBROKES MAIDEN – 1100 METRES**

- 2 JUST PLAIN NUTS** Late scratching prior to the race after dislodging rider (S Ingelse) on the way to the barriers who was deemed unfit to fulfil the ride.
- 3 STRATO KEN** Raced three wide throughout. Laid in under pressure in home straight.
- 8 DIZZ BOOGIE TIME** Reared on jumping and shifted outwards. Raced ungenerously in early stages. Shifted in at the 900m carrying ROOSSIS CAT on an inwards passage. Was held up for a clear run in home straight and shifted out abruptly over the heels of STRATO KEN. A post-race veterinary examination revealed an old wound on rear fore fetlock had reopened and a small laceration to right hind inside coronary band.
- 9 ROOSSIS CAT** Carried in by DIZZ BOOGIE TIME at the 900m.

## **RACE 2 – ROY & DORA COGHLAN MEMORIAL CLASS 1 HCP – 1200 METRES**

- 1 RAWABI** A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.
- 6 ARTILLERY FIRE** Laid in making the turn at the 1000m.
- 7 BAD ALIBI** Raced erratically throughout. Rider (L Burke) lost her irons and dropped her whip rounding the home turn after the saddle had shifted forward.
- 12 ALPINE JOY** Dwelt at the start.
- 13 VANITY STAR** Slow away.

## **RACE 3 – HARVEY NORMAN/SMEG BENCHMARK 60 HCP – 1600 METRES**

- 2 ALWAYS A WINNER** Had to steady off heels rounding the home turn,
- 5 ALPINE TROUT** Raced five wide from the 1000m.
- 10 RICH CLAN** Over raced early and middle stages. Hampered by WHO CAN IT BE NOW rounding the home turn.

**12 WHO CAN IT BE NOW**

Laid in hampering RICH CLAN rounding the home turn.

**RACE 4 – McCORMACK WINES CLASS 1 HCP – 1400 METRES****3 NANDI CLAN**

Jumped out at the start.

**4 BELLSPROUT (NZ)**

Laid in rounding the turn at the 1200m. Raced three wide throughout.

**6 THEM'S THE BREAKS**

Laid in over the concluding stages.

**7 THONATUS**

Laid in under pressure in the home straight.

**9 THE PIRATE QUEEN**

Laid out under pressure in the home straight.

**11 GIE IT LALDY**

Raced four wide from the 1000m. Laid out rounding the home turn carrying THONATUS and THEM'S THE BREAKS wider.

**RACE 5 – THE AGENCY, KATRINA GARWOOD & IAN McCALLUM GOLD SOVEREIGN STAKES – 1200 METRES****1 ARISTOPOLOS**

Brushed with OLINDAH after the start. Laid out under pressure in the home straight.

**2 KING CANDY**

Tended to over race early stages.

**3 RAMIRO**

Jumped out at the start.

**6 OLINDAH**

Jumped out and brushed with ARISTOPOLOS. Shifted out and crowded MOMENTSLIKETHESE.

**7 ALL INTRIQUE**

Bumped with WHOOSH on jumping

**8 WHOOSH**

Bumped with ALL INTRIQUE on jumping.

**RACE 6 – ART HOTEL 3YO/4YO HCP – 1400 METRES****4 WHIPPIN PICCADILLY**

Jumps in bumps THE TRINE.

**5 CRIPPS**

Laid in home straight.

- 6 SKY LAND** Raced three wide throughout.
- 7 THE TRINE** Bumped by SOUTH GEORGIA and WHIPPIN PICCADILLY after the jump. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a small superficial wound above the left fore fetlock.
- 8 BAYBOUGG** Over raced early. Shifted out carrying THE TRINE wider rounding the home turn.
- 10 SOUTH GEORGIA** Jumped out and bumped THE TRINE.

Stewards inquired into an incident entering the home turn where BAYBOUGG (C Wells) shifted and carried THE TRINE (C Newitt) wide resulting in him having to ease his mount. After taking evidence from both riders and viewing the film, Stewards charged Apprentice C Wells under AR131(a) Careless Riding and suspended her for two Tasmanian race meetings. In assessing penalty Stewards took into account her plea of not guilty, her previous record and degree of interference as mid-range. She was advised of her right to appeal.

### **RACE 7 – KEVIN SHARKIE TASMANIAN OAKS – 2100 METRES**

- 3 BRIGHT NIGHT** Held up for a clear run for most of the home straight.
- 9 OUR PIERRO** Late scratching acting on veterinary advice on veterinary advice at 8.23PM. As in the opinion of the veterinarian, the filly has a ring worm infection.
- 10 JUST MY LOT** Over raced early. Had to be steadied off heels leaving the winning post on the first occasion. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.
- 11 ZULEIKA** Slow into stride.
- 12 STELLETTA** Raced three wide throughout.

The start of the race was delayed by two minutes due to ground staff removing several wallabies from the track.

Following the race, Jockey D Gandterton was examined by the on-course medical team and was treated for exhaustion.

### **RACE 8 – SHANE YATES MEMORIAL CLASS 4 – 1100 METRES**

- 1 MASTRETTA** Laid in under pressure in home straight.

**2 MOVE ON OVER**

A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities. Connections advised the mare will be retired.

**6 FLYING CONCELLO**

Laid in under pressure in home straight.

**10 CAPABELLE**

Fractious in the barriers. Performed poorly. Connections advised the mare will be retired.
