Charge	At an inquiry on 1 st March 2026, Mr. Frost pleaded guilty to a charge issued pursuant to AHRR 190 (1) in that he presented MIKI SING to race on 28 th December 2025 not free of a prohibited substance.

Summary of Facts	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Mr. Frost was at all relevant times a Harness Racing Victoria Licensed Harness Trainer and a person bound by the Australian Harness Racing Rules who was the trainer of Miki Sing.2. On Sunday 28th December 2025 Niki Sing competed in and won Race 4, the Ladbroke's Tasmanian Country Championship at Carrick Park Pacing Club.3. In January 2026 Racing Analytical Services Victoria advised that the post-race sample taken from Miki Sing following its race on 28th December 2025 was found to contain prohibited substance Arsenic.

4. At enquiry on 1 March 2026 Mr. Frost pleaded guilty to a charge issued pursuant to AHRR 190 (1) in that on 28 December 2025 he presented Miki Sing to race when not free of a prohibited substance.
5. Pursuant to AHRR 190 (1) Miki Sing is disqualified from the Ladbrokes Country Championship and the placings from that event will be amended accordingly.

Penalty Discussion

In determining penalty, the Decision Makers carefully considered all available evidence including but not limited to:

- Mr Frosts's plea of guilty
- His disciplinary history
- The objective seriousness of the offence
- The principles of general deterrence

Mr. Frost was advised of his right to appeal the decision of Stewards.
