Stewards accepted the explanation stable representative N Walsh (Trainer J Bazan) for the late rider notification on CAPITAL CHEVAL in Race 5.

Stewards fined trainer J Blacker under LR13.3 for the late rider declaration on LADY FERN in Race 4.

Trainer J Blacker was fined \$200 under LR 15.18(b) for allowing unlicensed persons to work at his Brighton stables on the 18 February 2026.

6 ROYAL SCENE

A post-race veterinary examination revealed the had Tied up for which it was treated. The horse has been stood down for ten days.

10 STRIP'N'TOUGH

Jumped outwards at the start. Raced wide throughout before compounding approaching the 400m.

Stewards inquired into the whip action of T Baker (GEE GEES BROTHER) in the concluding stages. After viewing the film and taking evidence from the rider, he was advised to modify his whip action.

Stewards advised rider J Johnson (DANDIROSE) of his obligation to take more care of fellow riders when his mounts shift ground.

RACE 4 – LADBROKES POPULAR SRM CLASS 1 HCP (1220 METRES)**2 RIPPEN GOLD**

Jumped inwards at the start and bumped with OLIVE GIRL. Raced wide early to middle stages.

4 GEEGEES DOWNPOUR

Restrained near the 1000m when tightened for room after being crossed by ZANZI.

5 ZANZI

Shifted in and tightened GEEGEES DOWNPOUR near the 1000m.

7 BUNKER JAKO

Raced wide early to middle stages.

9 OLIVE GIRL

Bumped with RIPPEN GOLD after the jump.

Steward inquired into an incident shortly after the start where GEEGEES DOWNPOUR (M Ulucinar) was tightened for room and had to be restrained after ZANZI (T Baker) crossed. After viewing the patrol film and taking evidence from both riders, Stewards issued rider T Baker with a reprimand under AR131(a) – Careless Riding. He was reminded of his obligations to ensure sufficient room when crossing.

RACE 5 – LADBROKES RACING EXTRAS IN MULTI CLASS 3 HCP (1420 METRES)**1 BENEFICIARY**

Laid out under pressure in the home straight carrying BERSERKER wide.

3 BERSERKER

Carried wide by BENEFICIARY in the home straight.

4 CAPITAL CHEVAL

Stewards granted permission for rider C Newitt to ride 1kg over.

5 COASTAL STRIKE

Fractious in barriers. Stewards placed a warning on the horse's barrier manners. Over raced early stages.

RACE 6 – LADBROKES OWNERS PROMOTION MAIDEN/CLASS 1 (2150 METRES)**6 CORSA VELOCE**

Raced wide from the 800m.

9 SOUTH GEORGIA

Tightened for room approaching the winning post on the first occasion. Shifted out and bumped with BRIGHT NIGHT.

11 BRIGHT NIGHT

Bumped with SOUTH GEORGIA approaching the winning post on the first occasion.

Stewards inquired into an incident approaching the winning post the first time when SOUTH GEORGIA (D Ganderton) was tightened for room by CORSA VELOCE (E Byrne Burke) and WOLF JUNIOR (C Newitt), causing it to bump with BRIGHT NIGHT. After taking evidence from rider D Ganderton and E Byrne Burke Stewards established that CORSA VELOCE had shifted in marginally and WOLF JUNIOR, who was racing on the inside, rolled off the rail due to the sharpness of the bend. Stewards were satisfied that all riders had exercised reasonable care in the circumstances.

RACE 7 – LADBROKES TOP 2/3/4 BETTING BENCHMARK 68 HCP (1220 METRES)**1 GEEGEE'S CITY BOY**

Off hind shoe replaced prior to race. Late scratching at 9:02. Failed to load. Stood down for one trial.

2 MADE A DECISION

Bumped with STREET DIVA on jumping.

3 MASTRETTA

Fractious in barriers. Shifted and bumped STREET DIVA in concluding stages.

5 STREET DIVA

Bumped with MAKE A DECISION on jumping. Bumped with MASRETTA in concluding stages.

8 THISISMYTURF

Raced wide throughout.

RACE 8 – LADBROKES ODDS SURGE BENCHMARK 68 HCP (1620 METRES)**1 CRUZ MISSILE (NZ)**

Raced wide early and middle stages.

3 THE TRINE

Over raced early stages.

5 MONTEZULU

Raced wide from the 800m.

8 DESIGNER DREAMER

Held up in home straight until shifting out to obtain a clear run.
