### RACE 1 – FIND US ON FACEBOOK AND INSTAGRAM PACE – 1680m MS

SUGAR COAT ME – Gave ground. A post-race vet examination revealed soreness in the stifle and back. A vet clearance will be required before racing again

FAR LEFT FLETCH – Inconvenienced by Sugar Coat Me at the 400m when that horse gave ground.

HEY FRANCO – Performed poorly, warning issued. A post-race vet examination revealed no abnormalities.

### RACE 2 – LADBROKES TWO-YEAR-OLD – 1680m MS

BETTOR THAN READY – Out of position at the start. Shifted out under pressure in the home straight

SOUL OF KARALTA – Hung in the score up. Out of position at the start. Raced roughly racing into the first turn. Hung in at various stages of the race and contacted a number of marker pegs in the back straight. A warning was issued against the 2yos racing manners. Gave ground from the 400m

OUR ROB ROY – Out of position at the start.

General – Stewards issued reprimands to Drivers Tiarna Ford and Kayleb Williams under AHR 162(1)(j) for failing to maintain their positions at the start. Stewards did not reprimand Gareth Rattray for the same offence as his horse was intractable in the score up, consequently, a warning was issued against his horse

### RACE 3 – TASMANIAN HORSE TRANSPORT PACE – 1680m MS

IDEN KAMAKAZI – Broke gait racing into the back straight on the final occasion and was retired from the event. Placed on its last chance to race truly

MISS CRUNCHY – Broke gait at the first turn and placed on its last chance to race truly.

EMER – Slow in the score and out of position at the start. A warning was placed against the horse's barrier manners

RANIERI – Inconvenienced when Emer tired at the 350m

IDEN REGAL WAVE – Was well out of position at the start and will continue to be out of the mobile draw

### RACE 4 – BE AT THE EASTER CUP SATURDAY 4 APRIL STAKES – 1680m MS

MY MATES LUKE – Held up for clear running early in the home straight.

FEELINKINDALUCKY – Pulled hard in the early

### RACE 5 – VICTORY IMAGES PHOTOGRAPHY STAKES – 1680m MS

General – Prior to the running of the race stewards received a report from the on-course vet regarding Hay Miki. Stewards also took evidence from the horse's trainer Mark Jones. Acting on the report from the vet, stewards ordered the withdrawal of Hay Miki at 7:31pm. A further inquiry into the matter will be held at a later date.

ASHANTE QUEEN – Held up for clear running in the home straight

COOLANDCOLLECT - Held up for clear running in the home straight

YARECKON IM SWEET – Contacted marker pegs approaching the home turn when racing in restricted room. Held up for clear running thereafter

### RACE 6 – LADBROKES ODDS SURGE PACE – 2200m SS

SPOOKY GIRL – Began badly and placed on its last chance in the draw

ROLLWITHARTY – Swung sideways at the start and began badly. Placed on its last chance in the draw

GOODTIME OSCAR – Began badly and placed on its last chance in the draw

KOSTYUK LEIS – Inconvenienced after the start

HURRICANE ROCK – Reared at the start. Swung sideways and began slowly. Placed on its last chance in the draw

MAJOR DAVIN – Inconvenienced at the start

ROCKS ROY – Inconvenienced at the start

### RACE 7 – FAMILY FUN NIGHT SATURDAY 4 APRIL PACE – 1680m MS

SHEZALLHEART – Shifted out under pressure in home straight

BETTERTHANPRETTY – Gave ground. Stood down until completion of a satisfactory trial

ALBY PRIDDY – Tightened and inconvenienced on the home turn and shortly after straightening

DARE YOU TO MOVE – Held up early in the straight

HES FIRST CLASS – Hung in on the home turn. Tightened and inconvenienced shortly after straightening

FANCY ANOTHER – Hung in badly on the home turn and again in the home straight. A warning was placed against the horses racing manners

KNG BART – Hung in under pressure in the home straight and contacted several marker pegs

General – Stewards inquired into an incident on the home turn where a number of runners were tightened for racing room. After taking evidence from JOHN WALTERS (Hes First Class), MALCOLM JONES (Alby Priddy) and MARK YOLE (Shez All Heart) it was ascertained that while Mr Yoles shift away from the marker pegs was a major factor in the incident, Hes All Class and Alby Priddy had already been placed in tight quarters by Fancy Another, who was racing to their outside, when that horse hung inwards noticeably just prior to straightening for home. Hes First Class had also hung inwards placing him tight towards Mr Yoles wheel. All drivers were reminded to give more room, especially on the turns. My Yole was further reminded to ensure that he is completely clear when attempting to shift ground.
