Comments / Explanations:

Stewards accepted the explanations from trainers for the late declaration of riders.

RACE 1 – LADBROKES BIG BETS MAIDEN (1200METRES)

- 1 I'M A MACHINE** Slow to muster at start. Raced 3 wide with cover in the middle stages.
- 2 MONCLERE** Raced 3 wide in the middle stages.
- 5 ARIANNA'S GOLD** Jumped out at start. Laid out under pressure entering the home straight.

RACE 2 – GOOD FRIDAY EASTER EGG GIVEAWAYS MAIDEN (1600 METRES)

- 1 ALPINE WHISKEY** Over raced in the early stages.
- 2 CALLED THROUGH** Crowded and held up for clear running when racing inside ALPINE WHISKEY near the 400m. Shortly after, had to shift out to obtain a clear run.
- 7 TURFACTION** Nearing the 400m rolled in marginally and brushed with ALPINE WHISKEY, who was at that point shifting out.
- 9 JOEJOE** Raced 3 wide through-out.
- 10 STAR PERFORMER** Entering the home straight was held up for clear running behind GEE GEE'S BROTHER, before commencing to over-race then shifting out to obtain a clear run.
- 12 A QUEENS BUZZ** Raced wide through-out.
- 13 MISS MABEL** Rider C Wells reported on return to scale that she believed the filly choked down during the run. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the filly is lame in the near foreleg.
- 14 UP TO TORI** Fractious in the barrier before jumping.

RACE 3 – GO RACING ON GOOD FRIDAY 3RD APRIL 3YO MAIDEN (1200 METRES)

- 1 DENNYSON** Over-raced in the early stages.
- 2 LUCKY COUNTRY** Contacted inside barrier partition on jumping before bumping with KHALEESI'S DREAM shortly after the start.
- 3 MR TOD** Over-raced in the early stages. Rolled in and contacted the running rail at about 1000m.
- 5 BASSEIN** Obligated to check off the heels of KHALEESI'S DREAM near the 200m, before laying in under pressure over the concluding stages.
- 6 CONSCIOUS BIAS** Jumped outwards at the start. Laid out under pressure rounding the 800m turn and then shortly after, shifted out abruptly off the heels of LUCKY COUNTRY, carrying WALKING STREET wider up the track.
- 8 KHALEESI'S DREAM** Tightened between LUCKY COUNTRY and CONSCIOUS BIAS shortly after jumping.

RACE 4 – BOOK A FUNCTION @ THE LADBROKES RACING CENTRE CLASS 1 HANDICAP (1200 METRES)

3 GEEGEE'S DOWNPOUR	Laid out under pressure over the concluding stages
5 RUSHONOVA	Laid out entering the home straight
6 CHRISTOPHER ROBIN	Jumped outwards at start and brushed with REDAIR
7 REDAIR	Over-raced in the early stages and had to steady off heels at the 1000m
9 SUPER SNIPPY	Steadied off the heels of runners in front at the 400m. Tended to over-raced in the middle stages.
10 WILD NIGHTS	Bounded on jumping and slow to muster early speed
11 FRUIT OF DE VINE	Stewards granted permission for apprentice L Bingley to not claim any portion of her allowance.

RACE 5 – LADBROKES MATES CODE CLASS 4 (1400M)

6 NATIVE CLAN	Jumped awkwardly, before commencing to over-race in the early and middle stages

RACE 6 – LADBROKES MATES MODE CLASS 4 (1400 METRES)

2 VIXEN'S MOON	Bounded on jumping and slow to muster early speed
3 ACCUSANT	Laid out under pressure in the home straight
6 THE PIRATE QUEEN	Bounded on jumping and commenced to over-race in the early and middle stages
7 LADY FERN	Raced 3 wide in the early stages
9 GIE IT LALDY	Raced ungenerously in the middle stages
11 WHISPER OF MATILDA	Jumped awkwardly

Stewards questioned rider Erica Byrne-Burke into the reasons behind ACCUSANT shifting ground over the concluding stages. Miss Byrne Burke stated that the knot on her reins had released during the event, placing her at some disadvantage. Furthermore, her horse has had limited race starts and as such still tends to race greenly.
