#### **RACE 1 – GOOD FRIDAY FREE ENTERTAINMENT FOR THE KIDS MAIDEN (1400 METRES)**

| <b>8 LIGHT WORK</b>     | Tended to over-race through-out. Raced wide from the 800m. Post race veterinary report found that the gelding was lame in the off foreleg, Trainer advised horse is stood down 7 days and requires veterinary clearance to race. |

## **9 STRIP'N'TOUGH**

Approaching the 400m ROYAL SCENE shifted out to improve, at the same time STRIP'N'TOUGH rolled in marginally resulting in that filly being bumped and unbalanced. Stewards issued a reprimand to rider B MUCHU and advised him to ensure he is fully clear before shifting ground to improve.

Stewards inquired into an incident at approximately the 400m in where STRIP'N'TOUGH (C Pang) appeared to be tightened by ROYAL SCENE (B Muchu). It was ascertained that while ROYAL SCENE had shifted out to obtain clear running when not fully clear, apprentice Pang reiterated that the gelding had been giving ground at the time, and as such the apparent incident had not interfered with his mount. In assessing penalty, Stewards took into consideration Apprentice C PANG's evidence and issued B Muchu with a reprimand for careless riding.

### **RACE 2 – GO RACING GOOD FRIDAY @ LADBROKES RACING CENTRE MAIDEN (1200 METRES)**

#### **1 BARRINGTON POWER**

Slow to begin. Cast a near fore plate in running.

#### **2 GEEGEES BIG BIRD**

Jumped awkwardly and slow to muster. Raced wide from the 800m to the 400m.

### **RACE 3 – EASTER BUNNY VISIT ON GOOD FRIDAY CLASS 4 (1200 METRES)**

#### **3 IT'S JAGGER TIME**

Laid out under pressure entering the home straight.

#### **4 MASTRETTA**

Shifted out under pressure over the concluding stages.

#### **5 LADY GALADRIEL**

Reared as the start was affected and missed the start by approximately 4 lengths.

### **RACE 4 – GOOD FRIDAY EASTER EGG GIVEAWAYS MAIDEN/CLASS 1 (2100 METRES)**

#### **2 PIPING WILLOW**

Raced wide in the early stages

#### **4 LORD HEAR US**

Fractious prior to the start and bounded on jumping

#### **8 STAR PERFORMER**

When questioned into the mare's improved performance, Trainer J Blacker stated it had little luck in running previously and step up to 2100m suited.

Stewards fined apprentice J Johnstone \$100 for the number of occasions he used his whip prior to the 100m. In assessing penalty, Stewards took into consideration Apprentice J JOHNSTONE's record and his guilty plea. (AR132(7)(ii))

## **RACE 5 – LADBROKES SPRING HOSTED POTS BM60 HCP (1600 METRES)**

<b>2 DESIGNER DREAMER</b>	Jumped awkwardly and slow to muster and then shifted to take up a position closer to the rail.
<b>3 MONTEZULU</b>	Raced wide down the back straight.
<b>4 ELEGANTLY WRITTEN</b>	Laid out under pressure in the concluding stages.
<b>5 SNOW EAGLE</b>	Post race vet exam revealed swelling to the off fore lateral cannon bone. Treated and trainer advised the mare stood down for 7 days.
<b>6 ALPINE BLAST</b>	Underwent veterinary examination prior to start at the jockey's request and passed fit to run.
<b>10 THONATUS</b>	Raced wide down the back straight.

Stewards cautioned Apprentice C Pang for the manner in which he used his whip, particularly over the concluding stages. C Pang was advised to modify his action in future.

## **RACE 6 – FREE KIDS MOVIE ON THE BIG SCREEN GOOD FRIDAY CLASS 2 HCP (1400 METRES)**

<b>5 ARTILERRY FIRE</b>	Tendency to lay out under pressure in the home straight, resulting in the rider having to stop and straighten his mount on two occasions. Cast a near fore plate shortly after the start.
<b>7 JENNI THE CAT</b>	Over-raced early to middle stages
<b>8 COASTAL STRIKE</b>	Fractious in the barrier prior to the start then jumped inwards
<b>9 SKY EAGLE</b>	Raced 3 wide and over-raced middle stages. Post race veterinary report found that the mare showed signs of tying up.

## **RACE 7 – GOOD FRIDAY FAMILY FUN DAY BM76 HCP (1400 METRES)**

<b>1 MAGNAPRIME</b>	Entering the home straight, MAGNAPRIME shifted in and brushed with EARENDEL.
<b>2 SH'BOURNE MIDNIGHT</b>	Raced wide with cover middle stages.

**5 NICCO THE GREEK**

Held up entering the home straight before it came into clear run. When questioned into what appeared to be an improved performance from the gelding, Trainer John Keys stated that the stronger rider had suited the gelding and he enjoyed an economical run in tonight's event.

**7 PEROLA**

Fractious in the barriers.

**8 ZEWINNA**

Slow away.

**9 GO JEANIE**

Raced wide middle stages. Laid in under pressure home straight.

**10 ZANY GIRL**

Raced wide with cover middle stages.

**RACE 8 – LADBROKES RACING EXTRAS IN MULTI BM68 HCP (2100 METRES)**

**1 SPRING BEAN**

Raced wide early and middle stages.

**3 ROYAL DISPATCH (NZ)**

Tightened on jumping between LINDRUM and THIN RED LINE when they have shifted ground. Raced wide from 800m.

**8 MIGHTYMAXI**

Post race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.
