Comments / Explanations:

Stewards fined Trainer J Luttrell \$50 pursuant to LR 13.3 for late rider declaration on STEELE MY SUNSHINE in Race 6.

RACE 1 – LADBROKES HOSTED POTS 2YO & UPWARDS MAIDEN (1400 METRES)

- 4 KION'S KINGDOM** Over raced early.
- 5 MONCLERE** Over raced early. Raced wide throughout. Laid in rounding the home turn and brushed with I'M A MACHINE. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities. Trainer S Gandy advised of his intention to retire the gelding.
- 6 VOSTOK STATION** When questioned about the performance, Trainer T Evans stated it was his intention to discuss with the owners the geldings racing future. Stewards have stood the horse down to a satisfactory trial.
- 7 LUCKY COUNTRY** Fractious in barriers. A warning has been placed on the gelding for barrier manners.
- 9 A QUEENS BUZZ** Held up for a clear run until the 100m before shifting out to obtain clear running.

RACE 2 – WINNING EDGE PRESENTATIONS 2YO & UPWARDS MAIDEN (1200 METRES)

- 1 CARDIOSPHERE** Dislodged rider in mounting yard. Rider L Annells was assessed as fit to ride.
- 2 RAIDER'S OWN** Laid in under pressure in home straight.
- 3 PRIMROSE BOY** Raced wide throughout.
- 5 UP THE CUPS** Rider L Bingley was dislodged shortly after the winning post. Trainer J Luttrell advised of intention to spell the gelding.
- 7 QUEEN OF RAP** Slow away. Held up for a run in the home straight.

RACE 3 – LADBROKES OWNERS PROMOTION CLASS 1 HANDICAP (1200 METRES)

- 3 SUPER SNIPPY** Fractious in the barriers prior to the start. A post-race veterinary examination revealed lacerations and lameness to the geldings off hind. Veterinary certificate required prior to resuming racing.

- 4 CRYSTAL MOONBEAM** Eased off heels approaching the 600m. Laid in under pressure concluding stages.
- 6 MASTER OF MISCHIEF** Slow to muster speed.

RACE 4 – KEVIN SHARKIE MAIDEN/CLASS 1 (1200 METRES)

- 5 LORD HEAR US** Fractious in the barriers prior to the start. Jumped out at the start and brushed with STAR PERFORMER. Over raced in the early and middle stages.
- 10 SOUTH GEORGIA** Raced wide throughout.
- 12 THEM'S THE BREAKS** Held up for a clear run from the 500m until the 200m.
- 13 WHISPER OF MATILDA** Raced wide until the 1400m.

RACE 5 – KEVIN SHARKIE BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP (2000 METRES)

- 3 SCARLETTI** Hit the running rail near the 500m.
- 6 MOORLANDS MISS** Raced wide early to middle stages.
- 7 FASHION FOX** Steadied off heels of runners in front at the 1700m when the pace slowed.
- 9 ALPINE TROUT** Reshod behind the barriers. Fractious in the barriers.
- 12 SPEED ROCK** A post-race veterinary inspection revealed the gelding had suffered a bowed tendon on the off fore. Stewards stood the horse down until a veterinary clearance is received.

RACE 6 – AVISO TAS INSURANCE BROKERS CLASS 4 (1100 METRES)

- 1 OBVIOUSLY GOOD** Rider T Baker advised Stewards that the horse appeared to be coming towards the end of its preparation and will now be spelling.
- 4 MISS KEEDS** A post-race veterinary inspection revealed no abnormalities.

6 MATERIAL MADAM

Stewards granted permission for rider M Ulicinar to ride 0.5kg over his assigned weight.

9 SWINGING IT

Laid out under pressure in concluding stages.

RACE 7 – OTT SHOWCASE RACE DAY APRIL 26TH CLASS 1 HANDICAP (1400 METRES)

1 ALPINE HONEY

A post-race veterinary inspection revealed no abnormalities.

2 RIPPEN GOLD

Jumped awkwardly. Slow to muster speed. Raced wide throughout. Rolled in and brushed with GEUNINE LADY rounding the home turn.

3 BLOOMING EDGE

Raced wide rounding the home turn.

4 GENUINE LADY

Laid out shortly after straightening and bumped with RIPPEN GOLD. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare had a small hematoma about left elbow.
