General: Trainers with multiple runners in any one race advised their intended race tactics.

RACE 1 – CAMPBELLS COMMENTS PACE – 2090m MS

Stewards inquired into the reason for ZONED IN contacting marker pegs approaching the 200 metres. The evidence disclosed ZONED IN (R. Backhouse) was racing in a marker peg position with TISU SUNNY (G. Rattray) racing to his outside. In advance of those runners was IDEN ELIZA JANE who was tiring and was racing slightly wider than two wide. Near the 200 metres G. Rattray has improved into a run to the inside of IDEN ELIZA JANE, where there was insufficient room, and as a result ZONED IN has been tightened and contacted marker pegs. G. Rattray pleaded guilty to a charge under Rule 168(1)(a) of careless driving in that he drove where there was insufficient room. G. Rattray was fined \$100.

IDEN ELIZA JANE – Hung out in the score up. Over-raced in the middle stages of the race.

RACE 2 – LADBROKES SRM PACE – 2090m MS

Stewards intend to follow up with R. Ashwood regarding RESURGENT WARRIOR contacting marker pegs on the first turn.

NO NUKES SKIPPER – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination due to having started in excess of 200 races. Passed fit to start.

RACE 3 – TYPEFACE PACE – 2090m MS

AURORA REASON – Inconvenienced near the 300 metres when caught behind the tiring KENYA. J.Duggan explained AURORA REASON raced roughly and wanted to lay in near the 800 metres and as a result he contacted marker pegs.

EVERYTHING BUT THE – E. Arnott was questioned regarding the reason he contacted the sulky wheel of KENYA in the back straight on the last occasion. E. Arnott explained he was trailing KENYA and was aware M. Yole on IDEN OLIVER was improving three wide, however as began to move three wide with the intention of shifting IDEN OLIVER wider, KENYA'S momentum slowed and he had to steady and was then unable to move IDEN OLIVER wider, resulting in EVERYTHING BUT THE contacting the sulky wheel of KENYA and racing roughly. Stewards noted the circumstances and advised E. Arnott to exercise greater care in similar circumstances in future.

KENYA – Sulky contacted in the back straight on the final occasion.

COOLANDCOLLECT – It was noted the gelding completed the race with a broken carrying strap.

RACE 4 – TTC ON FACEBOOK PACE – 2090m MS

No incidents to report.

RACE 5 – SMITHAWARDS PACE – 1609m MS

MARY MOURNE – Over-raced throughout. Returned with a small amount of blood in its mouth due to having bitten its tongue. No veterinary treatment was required.

ROCK ON PLAYBOY – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination due to having started in excess of 200 race starts. Passed fit to start. After racing behind the leader, gave ground from the 600 metres to be beaten 38 metres. A post race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities.

RACE 6 – FEHLBERGS PRODUCE SPRINT LANE PACE – 2090m MS

REPETITIVE – T. Ford pleaded guilty to a charge under Rule 156(3) of using her whip in an excessive manner. T. Ford was fined \$100.

RACE 7 – WOODLANDS STUD LATHER UP PACE – 1609m MS

HALIS BOY – Dropped a shin boot after the start and as a result, raced roughly at various stages throughout the race. Galloped approaching the finish. In the circumstances, no action was taken.

DEBT TILL WE PART – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination due to having started in excess of 200 races. Passed fit to start.

CINOCAL JAMANE – Underwent a pre- race veterinary examination due to having started in excess of 200 races. Passed fit to start.

RANIERI - Underwent a pre- race veterinary examination due to having started in excess of 200 races. Passed fit to start.

An inquiry into the reason for STAROFREMEMBRANCE being checked prior to the finish has been adjourned until 19 April 2026. Required for the inquiry are J. Duggan (STAROFREMEMBRANCE) and T. Ford (EMER).
