Comments / Explanations:

Rider C Wells was replaced on all engagements today due to being indisposed.

RACE 1 – KEVIN SHARKIE 3YO MAIDEN (1150 METRES)

- 1 DON TURBOAS** Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after becoming fractious in the barriers, and was subsequently passed fit to race.
- 2 STRATO KEN** Tended to lay in under pressure in the closing stages and had to be straightened by its rider.
- 4 GOTTERUP** Apprentice C Pang was shown the patrol film and advised against using the whip while out of contention.

RACE 2 – LADBROKES RACING EXTRAS IN MULTI MAIDEN (1009 METRES)

- 1 GUBER** Raced wide throughout.
- 4 FRANCIUM** Jumped awkwardly at the start.
- 8 EGYPTIAN FOR GOLD** Slow away. Raced greenly throughout and laid out when making the 600m turn.
- 9 FIERCE SPIRIT** When questioned, apprentice Bingley reported that from the wide draw she had elected to restrain the gelding to secure a rearward position closer to the rail. The gelding then commenced to give ground, which in her opinion was due to it resenting the kickback. She added that once she had been able to direct her mount outwards to secure clear running in the home straight, the gelding had improved and finished off strongly. Stewards noted her explanation.

RACE 3 – GOODSTONE GROUP MAIDEN (1350 METRES)

- 7 STRATOVISION** Over-raced in the early and middle stages, before shifting outwards near the 800 m, carrying STARCRACKER wider.
- 8 TAMBRO'S TIME** Raced erratically near the 600m, veering outwards before giving ground. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no apparent abnormalities. Trainer S Davis was advised that the mare would be required to trial to the satisfaction of stewards prior to racing.

RACE 4 – MATT SAV CONSTRUCTION BM60 HCP (1350 METRES)

- 1 OBVIOUSLY GOOD** Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after grazing its face en-route to the track and was subsequently passed fit to race.
Raced wide throughout.
- 2 BAYSIDE** Raced three wide throughout.
- 5 ROUNDLE PARK** Tended to lay in under pressure over the concluding stages.
- 6 SIMPLY DEEP** Over-raced in the middle stages.
- 9 GEE GEE CAN WIN** Rider D Parish was fined \$200 under AR132(6)(a), for using her whip 5 times forward of the shoulder area in the home straight.

RACE 5 – MERIDIAN HORSE TRANSPORT MAIDEN/CLASS 1 (1650 METRES)

- 6 RIPPEN GOLD** Fractious in the barriers and then stood flat footed missing the start by 3-4 lengths. Rider K Boxall reported the gelding had felt as though it may buck after the start, so she had elected to ride cautiously in the early stages. She further stated that she had limited visibility until obtaining clear running in the home straight.
- 8 ALPINE JOY** Tended to over-race during the early and middle stages.

RACE 6 – LENDING 4 U CLASS 1 HCP (1150 METRES)

- 2 THE REAL MAN** Tended to over-race in the early stages.
- 9 GEEGEE AUNTY JESS** Apprentice L Bingley pleaded guilty to a charge under AR131(b), for failing to ride her mount out fully to the finish line which in the opinion of the Stewards prejudiced the chances of the mare obtaining her most favourable finishing position. In assessing penalty, Stewards considered her guilty plea, her submissions which included that the mare has a history of laying in under pressure and her clean record in relation to any previous breaches of this rule. Apprentice Bingley's license to ride was suspended for two (2) Tasmanian race dates.

11 WILD NIGHTS

Bounded on jumping, before bumping with TROTSKY shortly after the start. Over-raced in the early stages.

RACE 7 – STABLES AT SPREYTON BM60 HCP (1009 METRES)**5 PLATINUM REGGAE**

Bounded on jumping.

Notwithstanding that in the opinion of the stewards, the finishing position of the mare had not been affected, Ms Parish's attention was drawn to her riding of PLATINUM REGGAE over the concluding stages of the race, and she was advised to ensure that she rides her mounts with sufficient vigor and determination to leave no room for query from the Stewards.

Furthermore, Ms Parish was reminded of her obligation to report anything which might affect the performance of her mounts.

8 STAR FORTIAN

Raced wide throughout.

RACE 8 – CARO'S CREATIVE CREW BM72 HCP (1150 METRES)

No racing incidents to report.
