## STEWARDS REPORT

**General:** Trainers with multiple runners in any one race advised their intended race tactics.

Out of competition testing was conducted on the following horses:

HARRYS DEAL, JEREMY WELLS, PARK LANE, TOP GUN TED, SOHO TUXEDO, JAMES CAGNEY, IRON CLAD, CAN FEEL THE FURY, SOLO SAFARI, LORD JAYDO, DREAM MELODY, NO NUKES SKIPPER, WHERE'S THE SAVS, QUETZALLI, BROOKFIELDS BEAUTY, ALL ABOUT SADIE, QUALIFY, UNMATCHED, VICTORY GEORGE.

### RACE 1 – 6TY STAKES – 1680m MS

WHERE'S THE SAVS – Shifted out under pressure in the run to the finish.

QUETZALLI – Raced roughly approaching the first turn.

PETALI BEACH – Hung in and contacted marker pegs near the 200 metres.

General: Drivers B. Davis (OUTBACK LASS) and K. Williams (CMON SHARK) were advised they must make a greater effort to be fully in position at the start.

## RACE 2 – NUTRIEN AG SUPPLIES STAKES – 2200m MS

JAY MILLER – Suffered a gear malfunction when the ring holding the deafener cords contacted the gelding's rear leg near the 500 metres, resulting in it galloping.

RANIERI – Underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection due to having in excess of 200 races. Passed fit to start.

## RACE 3 – LADBROKES POPULAR SRM PACE – 1680m MS

A LOT LIKE PENDLES – Shifted out under pressure in the run to the finish.

NO NUKES SKIPPER – Failed to secure clear running and was not fully tested.

GOT THE GLOW – Over-raced in the early and middle stages of the race.

NO NUKES SKIPPER – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination due to having in excess of 200 races. Passed fit to start. Failed to secure clear running and was not fully tested.

## RACE 4 – TASSIE WASH PACE – 1680m MS

EYE SEE AMOUR – D. Ford was questioned regarding the performance of EYE SEE AMOUR, which started \$1.55 favourite and was placed eighth beaten 19.5 metres. D. Ford stated from his wide barrier draw he progressed forward at the start and was able to gain a three wide trail on LA PIERRE who was trailing NOBLEZZZ ADVICE. He added he was obliged to wait for NOBLEZZZ ADVICE and LA PIERRE, to find their forward positions which NOBLEZZZ ADVICE did near the 1000 metres. However LA PIERRE was unable to muster sufficient speed to find a position in the running line and remained three wide, therefore leaving the 800 metres he elected to improve four wide around LA PIERRE. He stated once he moved four wide the tempo increased which made it difficult to take ground off the leading runners. D. Ford stated he was not disappointed with the performance of EYE SEE AMOUR, due to the circumstances of the race.

FIVE STAR SHARK – Broke gait in the score up but was in position at the start.

## RACE 5 – IMPRESS PRINT PACE – 2200m MS

CENTURIAN MISS – Over-raced in the early and middle stages of the race.

UNMATCHED – Shifted out under pressure in the run to the finish.

## RACE 6 – LEES ORCHARD STAKES – 2200m MS

JAMES CAGNEY – Over-raced in the early and middle stages of the race.

WILL HE PIKE – A warning was issued for hanging out in the score up, resulting in the gelding being out of position at the start.

WINDY HANOVER – Underwent a veterinary examination due to being twelve years of age.

INVITATION ONLY – Tended to hang in approaching the 1400 metres when racing three wide.

HAMMER DAN – Failed to secure clear running and was not fully tested.

IRON CLAD – Raced in a rearward trailing position and began to give ground from the 400 metres to finish ninth, beaten 52 metres. A post race veterinary examination failed to reveal any

abnormalities.

**RACE 7 – LADBROKES QUICK MULTI STAKES – 2200m**

TOUGH FIGHTER – Over-raced in the early and middle stages of the race.

ART HUNTSMAN – Was retired from the race near the 1800 metres when the hopple shortener cord became entangled around the gelding's hind leg.

PUNTARNO STRIDE – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination due to having had in excess of 200 races. Passed fit to start. Failed to secure clear running until leaving the 100 metres.

**RACE 8 – [NAME] – [DISTANCE] [MS/SS]**

CAN FEEL THE FURY – Hung in during the score up however was in position at the start.

General: Stewards inquired into the reason CEE TEE CHELSEA raced roughly near the 500 metres. The evidence disclosed CEE TEE CHELSEA (C. Castles) was racing to the outside of REPETITIVE (H. Van dongen) who had a tendency to hang out at various stages of the race. Near the 500 metres, REPETITIVE again hung out resulting in a contact to the nearside hind leg of CEE TEE CHELSEA which caused it to race roughly. Stewards were satisfied H. Van dongen was not attempting to shift wide at the part of the race, therefore the incident was noted.

**Supplementary Report**

On Saturday 16 May 2026, trainer T. Rattray advised that BROOKFIELDS BEAUTY had suffered a bout of colic and although administered treatment, she had passed away.
