Comments / Explanations:

Stewards accepted the reason furnished by Trainer Paul E Jones for the late rider declaration in Race 8.

Rider A. Darmanin was issued with a reprimand under rule AR 190(3) for accepting a ride in race 3 (NATIVE CLAN) in which he was unable to make the carded weight and was replaced on. When assessing this matter, the Stewards gave due regard to the fact that Darmanin had not ridden for a lengthy period due to injury.

Rider M. Ulucinar was given permission by Stewards to ride his mount in race 5 (MATERIAL MADAM) at 1kg over the carded weight.

Apprentice S. Kennedy was issued with a reprimand under AR 143(12)(b) for failing to bring her winning rides book to the race meeting.

RACE 1 – WINNING EDGE PRESENTATIONS MAIDEN (1380 METRES)

1 ALPINE DRIFT	Jumped awkwardly unbalancing its rider and lost a length at the start. Raced greenly and showed a tendency to lay out on the home turn. H McCarthy, the rider of ALPINE DRIFT was reprimanded under rule AR 132(6)(c) for using her whip on a horse which was out of contention.
2 CROWNED BEAU	Raced wide in the early stages.
6 SORELL EAGLES	Raced wide in the middle stages.
7 TIMELY NEEDS	Raced wide on the home turn.
11 JEDD'S JET	Was fractious in the barriers, a warning was issued.

RACE 2 – KEVIN SHARKIE MAIDEN (1100 METRES)

1 ENUFF DOSH	Was bumped by TEA WITH THE QUEEN which jumped out at the start and was steadied off heels in the middle stages.
2 GOLD AMOUR	Jumped out at the start.
3 KIMBA	Was bumped by THE BIG FELLA which jumped out at the start. Over raced in the early stages
6 ANASAZI	Raced greenly and laid out in the home straight.
7 BALLERINI	Was ridden forward from a wide barrier to obtain the lead.
8 CAFFY	Stewards inquired into an incident where FROSTY RUGE was steadied for several strides approaching the 100m. After interviewing riders H. McCarthy (FROSTY RUGE), apprentice B. Temple (CAFFY) and apprentice L. Bingley (STOLLAWAY NED) it was established that FROSTY RUGE had to be steadied when it endeavored to improve into a narrowing run between STOLLAWAY NED and on the heels of CAFFY which shifted in slightly. Stewards after carefully considering the evidence tendered by riders considered it appropriate that Apprentice B. Temple, rider of CAFFY, be advised to exercise more care in similar circumstances.
11 SUNRISE AT KIRRA	Jumped out at the start and was wide on the home turn

RACE 3 – LADBROKES MEGA MULTI BENCHMARK 68 HCP (2100 METRES)

2 FLORENCE GLASS

Rider T. Baker advised Stewards that in his opinion the mare had come to the end of her preparation and had felt flat in the running.

3 GODDESS OF ROCK

Slow away, lost 2 lengths and was taken in behind runners. Over raced in the early and middle stages.

4 ALWAYS A WINNER

5 NATIVE CLAN

Jockey G. Catania pleaded guilty to a charge under rule 131(a) in that as the rider of NATIVE CLAN she permitted her mount to shift inwards and across the rightful running of HIGH TAIL EAGLE approaching the 1700m, which had to be steadied for several strides. After considering that this incident fell in the low to medium range of carelessness and in the medium range of consequence, Stewards considered it appropriate that rider G. Catania be suspended from riding in races for a period incorporating one (1) Tasmanian Race meeting commencing at midnight tonight and expiring on 14/06/2026. Jockey G. Catania was advised of her rights of appeal.

7 HIGH TAIL EAGLE

Was fractious in the barriers and was steadied for several strides approaching the 1700m.

RACE 4 – MINGARI + CO BENCHMARK 76 HCP (1380 METRES)

3 ROMARY

A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities. The trainer advised Stewards that the mare would be retired.

4 ZEWINNA

6 DON'T GIVE UP

Raced wide with cover in the early and middle stages. Raced wide in the early and middle stages. Near the 200m commenced to lay out under pressure and shifted in suddenly and had to be straightened.

8 FLYING BILLIE

Commenced to lay out under pressure from the 200m.

RACE 5 – LADBROKES HOSTED POTS BENCHMARK 68 HCP (1200 METRES)

5 ADACHI

Was restrained and directed inwards shortly after the start to obtain a position closer towards the inside running rail.

6 WHEELING

A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities. The trainer advised Stewards the gelding would be retired.

9 MATERIAL MADAM

16 AL MAXIMUS

Showed a tendency to lay out rounding the home turn. A post-race veterinary examination of AL MAXIMUS identified an irregular heart rhythm. AL MAXIMUS shall not be permitted to start in any race until the Stewards have

received a satisfactory veterinary report. The report must include the results of an ECG performed at rest and cardiac auscultation performed within 30 minutes of completing a satisfactory gallop of at least 1000 meters

RACE 6 – AVISO TAS INSURANCE BROKERS CLASS 1 HCP (1200 METRES)

3 LAWRENNY BOYS

Shifted out under pressure at the 100m.

7 STRIDING BAY

Raced in restricted room on the outside of FRUIT OF DE VINE which jumped out at the start.

9 RAPIDS AHEAD

Was bumped by ACCUSAIENT which jumped out at the start.

10 COLLEEN'S CROWN

Raced in restricted room on the outside of FRUIT OF DE VINE which jumped out at the start.

11 CELESTIAL GLOW

Over raced in the early and middle stages. Stewards inquired into an incident approaching the 100m where CELESTIAL GLOW was carried in marginally by WILD NIGHTS which shifted in slightly and was immediately straightened.

CELESTIAL GLOW then had to be steadied to avoid the heels of LAWRENNY BOYS which commenced to shift outwards under pressure. After considering evidence tendered by Jockeys H. McCarthy (WILD NIGHTS) apprentice S. Kennedy (LAWRENNY BOYS) and E. Byrne-Burke (CELESTIAL GLOW) it was established that there were circumstances leading up to the incident which had a bearing on CELESTIAL GLOW being carried in slightly prior to being steadied off the heels of LAWRENNY BOYS and ruled that no further action would be taken except for advising Apprentice S. Kennedy that she is required to straighten her mounts immediately when they commence to shift ground in similar circumstances. Jockey Byrne-Burke was advised to ride her mounts out to the finish with sufficient vigor and determination to avoid any room for query from the Stewards.

13 WILD NIGHTS

Over raced in the early and middle stages.

14 FRUIT OF DE VINE

Returned having cast its left hind plate.

RACE 7 – PINK CUP RAISED 28,100 FOR NBCF BENCHMARK 60 HCP (1600 METRES)

5 STARDARMUS

Raced wide in the early stages.

8 SIR JAG

At the 250m was steadied and directed inwards when it was disappointed for clear running between the heels of BERSERKER which shifted out marginally and STARDARMUS which commenced to lay in. Returned having cast its right fore plate.

9 THE LITTLE BAY

Laid out under pressure in the concluding stages.

10 MATEUS

Was slow to muster speed in the early stages. Apprentice L. Bingley's helmet cover was detached leaving the 1500m.

RACE 8 – WINNING EDGE PRESENTATIONS BENCHMARK 60 HCP (1000 METRES)

5 MCSWEYN

Was fractious in the barriers prior to the start.

9 CREEK LODGE

Was slow to muster speed early and finished tailed off. A post-race veterinary examination revealed that it was thick winded post-race.

11 APRIL'S DANCE

Over raced in the middle stages.

12 RARE ORO

Finished tailed off. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities, but it was noted that it had its tongue over the bit
