### Comments / Explanations:

Apprentice B. Temple was issued with a reprimand under AR 143(12)(b) for failing to bring her winning rides book to the race meeting.

## **RACE 1 – GOODSTONE GROUP MAIDEN/CLASS 1 (1880 METRES)**

<b>2 JUST BOBBY</b>	Over raced in the early stages. Was brushed by NORTHERN CHILD which shifted out from the whip at the 150m.
<b>4 NORTHERN CHILD</b>	Shifted out from the whip at the 150m.
<b>6 LAST TREMBLE</b>	Restless in barriers.
<b>7 LYCO RECO</b>	Did not overcome its wide draw and raced wide in the early and middle stages, until ridden forward at the 1000m to obtain a forward position closer to the inside running rail.
<b>8 OCCASIONAL GLIMPSE</b>	Commenced to give ground quickly at the 500m and was not perceived with thereafter. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities. Trainer L. Gaffney advised Stewards that the horse will be retired.
<b>9 SOUTH GEORGIA</b>	Raced tight and brushed TIZSA NICE DROP on several occasions in the closing stages when both horses shifted marginal ground.
<b>10 TIZSA NICE DROP</b>	Raced tight and brushed SOUTH GEORGIA on several occasions in the closing stages when both horses shifted marginal ground.

## **RACE 2 – KEVIN SHARKIE 2YO HCP (1150 METRES)**

The start of this race was delayed due to the 30-minute interval between races 1 & 2 which led to horses entering the mounting yard after the scheduled time which had an effect on the horses proceeding to the start timeously. Stewards will review the current procedures and timelines incorporating the schedules of the riders being weighed out and horses entering the mounting yard.

When questioned, Jockey A. Darmanin told the Stewards that BUZZOFSKI exhibited greenness in the barriers and in the early stages of the race where she had raced strong and out of what he believed was her comfort zone, which had led to her tiring in the concluding stages. Stewards advised Jockey A. Darmanin that they concurred that his mount had raced too strongly in the early and middle stages and that had bearing on two distinct groups being formed in the race and BUZZOFSKI coming to the end of her run in the closing stages. Jockey A. Darmanin advised Stewards that he had recommended that the filly be equipped with a tongue tie in its next start which in his opinion would assist with her breathing and would enable her to close the race off better than she had done in today's race.

### **RACE 3 – MERIDIAN HORSE TRANSPORT MAIDEN (1350 METRES)**

- 1 ALLA RUSTICA** From a wide draw when endeavoring to obtain a forward position commenced to prove difficult to settle without cover. Subsequently compounded in the home straight.
- 4 I'M A GRUNT** Laid out on the turn at the 600m.
- 6 NEED A GIGGLE** A veterinary examination was performed at the barriers prior to the start which revealed no abnormalities.
- 7 AWESOME ORPHAN** Approaching the 600m AWESOME ORPHAN, which showed a tendency to over race, had to steady off the heels of NATALDI when carried out marginally by I'M A GRUNT which commenced to lay out on the turn. As a result of this incident LIGHT WORK which was following was steadied for a number of strides off the heels of AWESOME ORPHAN. Jockey C. Atkinson, rider of I'M A GRUNT and Apprentice C. Pang, rider on AWESOME ORPHAN were advised that Stewards accepted that there were circumstances surrounding this incident but were spoken to regarding the quality of their evidence that they provided to the Stewards.
- 10 LIGHT WORK** Eased off the heels of AWESOME ORPHAN at the 600m.

### **RACE 4 – LADBROKES BIG BETS COPY NOW CLASS 4 (1350 METRES)**

- 1 GARCON D'ESPOIR** Raced wide on the turn.
- 8 EAGLEFURTHER** From a wide draw was taken in behind runners and commenced to over race in the middle stages.

### **RACE 5 – VALE JOHN ACKROYD CLASS 1 HCP (1350 METRES)**

- 4 TURBO CHOOK** Proved to be stubborn when being loaded into the barriers.
- 6 HOT AND SHAMELESS** A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.
- 9 PEAK A BOOM** Resaddled behind the barriers.
- 10 ADAVALE** A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

Shortly after straightening and approaching the 250m KNIGHTS REIGN was unbalanced and turned inwards when bumped by IKIGAI KATSUMI which shifted out slightly. As a consequence, KNIGHTS REIGN shifted out marginally and made light contact with STROAK OF ART which itself shifted inwards marginally. During this incident PEAK A BOOM was held up briefly. Stewards considered this to be a racing incident due to dual movements and took no further action in this regard.

| <b>9 VOLKANOVSKI</b>     | Raced wide on the turn.  |
| <b>11 ALPINE BEAU</b>    | Slow into stride.  |

C. Wells rider of HARTMAN was advised to give more room to other runners in similar circumstances. Commenced to over race for some distance passing the 800m. |
| <b>4 SKELMORLIE</b>      | Slow and lost 2 lengths.  |
| <b>6 LAUGH WITH ME</b>   | Over raced in the early stages.   |
| <b>7 GEE GEE CAN WIN</b> | Commenced to over race between the 700m and 500m.   |
