### ***Comments / Explanations:***

Jockey J.W Stanley was given permission by Stewards to ride his mount in Race 7 WHISPER OF MATILDA at +1kg over the carded weight.

Stewards investigated the reason for Jockey B. Muhcu being carded to ride WILD NIGHTS and HUBUBBAJAHN in contravention of AR 127. It was established that he had made a firm commitment to ride HUBUBBAJAHN and ruled that he be replaced on WILD NIGHTS. In assessing penalty, Stewards gave due consideration to his clean record regarding prior contraventions of being double engaged and he was accordingly reprimanded.

Jockey M. Ulucinar was given permission by Stewards to ride his mount in Race 7 WINDARA WOLF at +0.5kg over the carded weight.

### **RACE 1 – RON BANKS LIFE MEMBER MAIDEN (1600 METRES)**

<b>1 ALLA RUSTICA</b>	Over raced in the early stages.
<b>2 ALPINE DRIFT</b>	Raced wide on the turn.
<b>3 CALLED THROUGH</b>	Slow to muster in the early stages.
<b>4 CROWNED BEAU</b>	Commenced to give ground in the home straight and finished tailed off. A post-race veterinary examination was requested by Stewards. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.
<b>6 TIMELY NEEDS</b>	Raced wide into the home straight. Jockey A. Darmanin pleaded guilty to a contravention under AR 132(7)(a)(ii). After giving due regard to his guilty plea, his submissions and his recent record, he was fined \$300.
<b>7 LIGHT WORK</b>	Commenced to lay out under pressure shortly after straightening until the concluding stages.
<b>8 LITTLEMISSALLSORTS</b>	Slow to muster in the early stages.

### **RACE 2 – TERRY CLAYTON LIFE MEMBER MAIDEN (1200 METRES)**

<b>2 DON TURBOAS</b>	Slow into stride and was ridden forward to maintain position.
<b>3 ENUFF DOSH</b>	Bumped with GOLD TIANNA at the start after both horses shifted ground. Commenced to weaken and give ground on the home turn. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.
<b>4 FUEL ON THE FIRE</b>	Showed a tendency to lay in in the early part of the home straight.
<b>6 GOLD TIANNA</b>	Bumped with ENUFF DOSH at the start after both horses shifted ground.
<b>11 EMPRESS ANGEL</b>	Commenced to give ground in the home straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the filly had a high heart rate and slow recovery time.

### **RACE 3 – LADBROKES HOSTED POTS MAIDEN (1200 METRES)**

<b>1 MIDWAY POINT</b>	Jumped out at the start.
<b>2 ALPINE RUBY</b>	Jumped out at the start.
<b>3 CAFFY</b>	A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to have a high heart rate as well as a slow recovery time.
<b>5 POETIC LIGHT</b>	A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.
<b>8 THERMAL MISS</b>	Jockey E. Byrne-Burke pleaded guilty to a contravention under AR 132(7)(a)(ii). After giving due regard to her guilty plea, her submissions and her recent record, she was fined \$200.
<b>11 WHEELEWE</b>	Approaching the 900m was steadied momentarily off the heels of MIDWAY POINT which shifted in to obtain a position closer to the rail. Jockey D. Ganderton, the rider of MIDWAY POINT, was advised to ensure there is sufficient clearance before shifting ground in similar circumstances.

**12 WHITE STAR SUZIE**

Fractious in the barriers.

**RACE 4 – EIS PROPERTY CLASS 1 HCP (1200 METRES)****1 BENEFITSOFMINE**

Held up for a clear run until the 150m where it was directed out to obtain a clear run.

**2 MEGALITA**

Made slight contact on several occasions with LAWRENNY BOYS shortly after the start when both horses shifted marginal ground.

**4 LAWRENNY BOYS**

Made slight contact on several occasions with MEGALITA shortly after the start when both horses shifted marginal ground.

**7 BELLA CHINKARA**

Laid out on the home turn.

**RACE 5 – CARBINE CLUB 3YO WINTER CLASSIC (1390 METRES)****3 DAYTONA DIVA**

Raced wide early and made contact with ZAMBEZI BLONDE at the 400m. Showed a tendency to lay in, in the home straight.

**7 JEDD'S JET**

Dislodged its rider before the start and bolted the course. The filly was subsequently scratched by Stewards acting on veterinary advice.

**RACE 6 – RAINE AND HORNE CLASS 2 HCP (1100 METRES)****1 ALPINE FURY**

Made light contact with ROYAL DETECTIVE at the start.

**2 GEMS EAGLE**

Fractious in the barriers. A warning was placed on the gelding regarding his barrier manners. Commenced to lay inwards and gave ground and was not persevered with shortly after straightening. A post-race veterinary examination revealed that the gelding had an elevated heart rate and slow recovery time.

**5 ROYAL DETECTIVE**

Made light contact with ALPINE FURY at the start. Held up for a clear run on two occasions, firstly at the 250m and then again in the closing stages when it was directed outwards into clear running.

**7 WILD NIGHTS**

Over raced in the early stages.

**8 HUBUBBAJAHN**

Raced wide on the home turn.

**10 FIRST LINE**

Continually gave ground in the home straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

**12 SWINGING IT**

Over raced in the early stages.

## **RACE 7 – STEELINE ROOFING CLASS 2 HCP (1390 METRES)**

<b>7 WINDARA WOLF</b>	Stewards gave Jockey M. Ulucinar permission to ride +0.5kg over the carded weight.
<b>9 COASTAL STRIKE</b>	Raced wide in the early and middle stages.
<b>10 MATEUS</b>	Held up for clear running on two occasions at the 300m and the 150m.
<b>11 PURR SEFANEE</b>	Leaving the 1000m whilst being restrained in its forward position shifted out abruptly and had to be straightened.
<b>12 APRIL'S DANCE</b>	Raced with its head up when it commenced to over race in the middle stages.
<b>14 WHISPER OF MATILDA</b>	Stewards granted Jockey J.W. Stanley permission to ride +1kg over the carded weight. The mare was examined at the start by the veterinary surgeon and was subsequently declared a late scratching by Stewards acting on veterinary advice.

## **RACE 8 – TAS INSURANCE BROKERS CLASS 6 (1200 METRES)**

<b>2 RESTRICTED ACCESS</b>	After racing prominently commenced to give ground in the home straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.
<b>3 SHY GUY</b>	Slow away from the barriers and was steadied off heels at the 800m.
<b>5 THESPIAN WATERS</b>	Slow away from the barriers.
<b>14 FLUFFY'S GIRL</b>	Jumped in at the start.
<b>15 TASSIE POWER</b>	After racing prominently commenced to lay out under pressure and had to be straightened leaving the 200m.

## **RACE 9 – AINTREE CONTRACTING BENCHMARK 68 HCP (1390 METRES)**

<b>2 FIGHTING FLOYD</b>	Raced wide and shifted in away from the whip and had to be straightened on two occasions between the 300m and 200m.
<b>8 DANCING WOLF</b>	A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to have a high heart rate and slow recovery time.
<b>9 RUNAWAY STATEMENT</b>	Fractious in the barriers.
<b>10 STARDARMUS</b>	Raced wide on the home turn and entering the home straight.
<b>12 GEEGEE STRAWBERRY</b>	A veterinary examination was requested by the rider prior to the start and the mare was declared fit to race.
<b>13 STEELE MY SUNSHINE</b>	Commenced to over race and had to be steadied off heels in the middle stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to have a high heart rate.
