General: The all clear was delayed by the stewards to review the score up and start of the race to ascertain whether any horse was denied a fair start. The evidence disclosed that as VICTORY GEORGE came out of the pre-race circle, E. Arnett requested the attendant replace a deafener that had come loose and as a result, VICTORY GEORGE was some distance away from the field in the early stages of the score up. Due to this, the Starter then slowed the momentum of the mobile barrier and this resulted in IDEN OLIVER breaking gait and taking no part in the remainder of the score up. YARECKON IM SWEET (H. Van Dongen) which was drawn on the second row, moved down the track during the latter stages of the score up as she believed IDEN OLIVER which she was drawn behind may have been attempting to get into its position and as a result of this movement down the track, SPOOKY GIRL was unable to fully occupy its barrier position. Stewards were satisfied all horses had participated in the score up and were not denied the opportunity of a fair start, therefore the all clear was given. Due to the slowing of the mobile barrier, no action was taken against any horse or driver.

They also verified that no contact was made with ROCK ON PLAYBOY'S hind leg.
