General – The announcement of correct weight was delayed affording jockey A. Darmanin the opportunity of viewing the patrol film footage. Subsequently he, as the rider of FUEL ON THE FIRE lodged a protest against the winner, SH'BOURNE POWER (apprentice K. Lane), alleging interference between the 300m and the 200m. After taking evidence from both riders, the connections, and carefully considering the patrol film footage, Stewards dismissed the protest and all-clear was given on the result confirmed by the Judge. In dismissing the protest, Stewards considered that both horses had shifted ground nearing the 300m and had made minor contact. Shortly afterwards, SH'BOURNE POWER (K. Lane) shifted outwards to avoid the heels of NANDI CLAN (E. Byrne-Burke), which had laid outwards, and this had a bearing on SH'BOURNE POWER bumping with FUEL ON THE FIRE. As Stewards were not satisfied with the requisite degree that SH'BOURNE POWER was the sole contributor to the incident, and that FUEL ON THE FIRE would have finished ahead of SH'BOURNE POWER had this incident not occurred, the protest was dismissed.

Stewards also inquired into an incident approaching the 1200m where several runners were tightened for galloping room. After taking evidence from apprentice Lauryn Bingley (ALPINE RUBY) and apprentice Christopher Pang (GOLDEN SWEET HEART) Stewards could not attribute the incident to the actions of any one rider but reminded both apprentices Bingley and Pang of their obligations to ensure that they are not an undue influence on other runners when shifting ground.

General – Stewards inquired into why HUBUBBAJAHN was tightened and STARS IN THE NIGHT was checked and lost her position nearing the 600m. Stewards took evidence from jockeys T. Baker (TRIBAL COUNCIL), K. Lane (STARS IN THE NIGHT) and B. Muhcu (HUBUBBAJAHN).

After hearing the evidence and considering the patrol footage, Stewards charged jockey T. Baker (TRIBAL COUNCIL) under rule AR131(a) – Careless Riding. The particulars of the charge being that jockey Baker permitted TRIBAL COUNCIL to shift inwards nearing the 600m when not clear of HUBUBBAJAHN causing that horse to be tightened and which resulted in STARS IN THE NIGHT being checked. Mr. Baker pleaded guilty to the charge and was suspended from riding at one Tasmanian race meeting suspension. In arriving at this penalty, Stewards considered Jockey Baker's guilty plea, his good riding record and that the interference and consequence thereof was in the mid-range. Mr. Baker was advised of his rights of appeal.
