Stewards advised Mr. Wells that they accepted his explanation, however he is to desist from making any abrupt hand or jerking movements whilst having hold of the horse's reins or lead rope. Stewards also advised him that he is required to ensure that necessary remedial actions are taken to ensure the gelding parades in a tractable and orderly fashion. Furthermore Mr. Wells was advised that his conduct in the Stewards room fell short of what is acceptable and he was accordingly cautioned in this regard.
