Rider L Bingley further stated that the horse had shortened its action suddenly shortly after the finish and she had dismounted as she was concerned that there may be something amiss. The horse was transported by the horse ambulance for a veterinary examination. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the horse could not bear weight on its left hind and had swelling above its stifle, medially in muscles of thigh. A Veterinary Certificate is required before this horse is accepted to race again.
