

RE: APPLICATION FOR ASSESSED DISCLOSURE – RIGHT TO INFORMATION ACT 2009 – GREYHOUND AT BRIGHTON

What is the racing name of the greyhound seized by stewards at the Brighton thoroughbred training facility?

The greyhound did not have a racing name. He was unraced.

Who is the current owner of the greyhound?

The owner at the time of the incident was Mr Jordan Young.

Which vet was the greyhound transported to when it was seized?

The greyhound was transported to Southern Beaches Vet.

What is the result of the veterinary examination? (please provide the report)

Signs of emaciation, mild hydration, mild abdominal discomfort. A copy of the veterinary report is *enclosed*.

What has happened to the dog? Where is it now and under whose care?

The dog is in the care of another person now. The name of that person is personal information and was not disclosed following assessment.

Is an investigation under way relating to the circumstances the greyhound was kept under?

The investigation is complete and Steward's Inquiry has also been finalised, as per the publicised Inquiry Report. A copy is *enclosed*.

If so, are charges being considered under the Animal Welfare Act 1993?

No, as Tasracing does not have any enforcement power under the Animal Welfare Act 1993. Any breaches identified relate to the applicable Rules of Racing, as outlined in the Steward's Inquiry Report.
