# Greyhound features

### Hayes calls time after over two decades

A significant chapter in the history of Tasmanian greyhound racing concluded in May with the retirement of esteemed greyhound administrator Peter Hayes. This marked the end of his extraordinary two-decade career devoted to his beloved sport and its community.

Highly respected by his peers and the racing community, Hayes finished his tenure as Racing Operations Officer for Tasracing on Thursday, 15 May, after dedicating countless hours travelling between meetings for the three greyhound clubs each week.

Peter's dedication grew into a passion for greyhounds over the years. During his teenage years, he spent most Saturday evenings at the TCA.

When the "job of a lifetime," as he describes it, became available, the opportunity was irresistible. This led to a fulfilling career, many memories, and the racing world gained an exceptional contributor who will leave a significant gap that will be hard to fill.

"It's been amazing. I've been lucky to have just two jobs in 46 years, and this one has been the longest and most enjoyable," Peter said.

"Working with greyhounds, as well as trainers, owners, handlers, catchers, and committees, starting as the HGRC manager in the beginning and progressing through the Tasmanian Greyhound Racing Council, Tote Tasmania, and finally to Tasracing, it was quite a journey. "My relaxed attitude has helped me connect with people over the years, but that wouldn't be possible without genuine passion for the job."

Working as an accountant, Peter worked for the Reserve Bank from 1978 until Westpac gained the state government banking business, which saw the closure of the Hobart branch in 1998. Faced with the choice of relocating or remaining in Tasmania, he chose to stay.

Fortunately, his decision led him to become the manager of the Hobart Greyhound Racing in 1999, a career role he fully embraced.

"At first, I didn't land the job with Hobart right away, but they reached out to me, and things took off from there," Hayes fondly recalled.

"Everything used to be done manually back then, from writing out the kennel tickets to preparing the stakes envelopes and handing out the prize money after each race, which people would collect. I was everyone's favourite person, though now it's all switched to bank deposits.

Peter was present during key moments in the industry, such as Launceston's move from White City to Mowbray Racecourse and Hobart's shift from the Royal Showgrounds



to Elwick Racecourse. Challenging times but crucial steps for progress to help the sport move forward.

He also enjoyed helping to organise the National Championships, which the state hosted, along with other prominent key feature race days. Over the years, the clubs held many promotions, but none were as famous or successful as the People's Mercury giveaway dog and its success.

"There were plenty of challenges with both clubs relocating to new facilities, and many groups had to be managed throughout," Peter said. "I've really missed being with my family, especially around the public holidays, but now I can finally unwind, relax, and step back."

"It wasn't easy, but the clubs have now moved to better facilities that are easier to maintain, even if the racing experiences have changed."

As the Racing Operations Officer, he brought structure to three greyhound clubs. During his tenure, Peter carried the title with great distinction and class, always going above and beyond the call of service during busy periods to always ensure everything ran smoothly.

Peter has been lucky to work with people like Gary Sutton, Richard Stamford, Peter Wesley, and Michelle Collis who helped him transition into the role as an outsider. Their guidance and expertise have been crucial in helping him manage the race clubs' operations.

"My position was established because Barry Lee retired as manager of Devonport, and the governing body at the time wanted someone to take on a statewide role. It stemmed from that, and I've had fantastic club and track staff who were all great to work with," Peter shared. His brief involvement with the Australian Greyhound Racing Association, now Greyhound Clubs Australia opened the doors to meeting former high profile racing administrators such as Geoff "Smokey" Dawson, Marg Long and Ken Norquay and was certainly a highlight.

Peter has seen some of the greatest stars on the racetrack, including Buckle Up Wes, Brett Lee and Chinatown Lad, during their careers.

The support of his loving wife Angel, along with his children and grandchildren complimented his working life and made it truly enjoyable.

"Due to some health issues, I decided to retire, but I'll still be able to follow this wonderful industry with the same passion," Peter said.

"I've really missed being with my family, especially around the public holidays, but now I can finally unwind, relax, and step back."



### Raider's Guide wins the Group 1 Sandown Cup

Raider's Guide emerged as Tasmania's greatest ever stakes earner after an impressive front-running display to claim victory in Victoria's Group 1 Sandown Cup Final (715m) on 23 May.

Claiming his third Group 1 victory in a stellar career, Raider's Guide secured the \$150,000 winner's cheque in Australia's premier staying event, boosting his earnings to \$586,570 and surpassing the late Buckle Up Wes's total of \$551,965.

The son of Zambora Brockie and Sacred Shadow has not only become the highest earner from the Apple Isle but also the only Tasmanian-bred greyhound to secure three Group 1 titles, with wins in the National Distance Championship and Rookie Rebel.

He has surpassed Chinatown Lad and Buckle Up Wes, who each claimed two Group 1 victories, further solidifying his place in history.

Tasmanian Hall of Fame trainer Gary Fahey was thrilled with the outstanding performance of his champion home-bred chaser.

- "I don't think I'll get any sleep tonight it's hard to top that!" said a thrilled Gary Fahey from home after the race.
- "Once he took the lead, the two favourites couldn't catch him.
- "Three Group 1 wins is incredible, and he has also secured second place in two other major races."
- Raider's Guide claimed his 39th career victory in the Sandown Cup for Gary

and his brother Greg Fahey, springing from box 5 with remarkable sectional splits, proving too strong to catch and leaving his competitors scrambling in an outstanding performance.

Lady Wilson and Pass Mark secured the minor placings, finishing 3-1/4 lengths behind with a time of 41.57 seconds.

Gary Fahey's daughter, Carol Martin, and his wife, Bev Fahey, have played vital roles with Raider's Guide traveling interstate.

- "We'll never see another like him," Gary proudly declared about his exceptional Raider's Guide.
- "Even if I never see another winner, I wouldn't mind, this has been the pinnacle.
- "If he hadn't been such a calm, adaptable dog and a great traveler, we probably wouldn't have gone through with it."
- Tasmania now boasts four Sandown Cups to its name, following the achievements of Wynlee Wonder, Chinatown Lad, and Bronski Beat.

The 80-year-old trainer from Mangalore has enjoyed numerous career highlights, but Raider's Guide has undoubtedly surpassed them all, cementing this victory and legacy into the rich history of Tassie racing folklore.

# Feature race information

### Tasracing feature events policy

#### 1. Objective

 The objective of this policy is to document the Special Conditions (minimum number of nominations/ heats to be programmed) for feature events.

#### 2. Policy

#### 2.1. Short sprint and sprint races

- 2.1.1. Special conditions for a series conducted in heats, semi finals and a final
- 2.1.1.1 Any series conducted in Heats, Semi Finals and Finals (excluding Breeders Classics) shall be conducted in accordance with the conditions defined in the Feature Race Conditions for the event, subject to the following:

2.1.1.2. In the event of insufficient nominations to conduct at least 3 Heats with at least 7 eligible nominations in each heat then no Heats will be conducted. In this case two Semi Finals and a Final will be conducted on the dates advertised provided there are at least 7 eligible first preference heat nominations for each Semi Final. The fields for the Semi Finals shall be selected from those greyhounds with a first preference nomination for the Heats with eligibility and field selection on the grade and order of choice at the time the fields for the Semi Finals are drawn.

2.1.1.3. If there are insufficient eligible first preference nominations to conduct Heats or Semi Finals then, provided there are at least 7 eligible first preference nominations for a Final, a Final only will be conducted on the date advertised for the Final. If there are 8 or more eligible first preference nominations for the Heats, the field for the "Final Only" shall be selected from those greyhounds with eligibility and field selection on the grade and order of choice at the time the fields for the final are drawn. If there are less than 8 eligible first preference nominations for the Heats. then new nominations shall be called for the "Final Only" and connections must re-nominate for the "Final Only" and the field shall be selected from the nominations received with selection preference going to those greyhounds that had an eligible first preference nomination for the heats.

- 2.1.1.4. The number of Heats scheduled for each series shall be the maximum number of Heats to be conducted. The number of Heats to be conducted shall be reduced in accordance with the number of eligible first preference nominations received as per the Heats/ Nominations table.
- 2.1.1.5. A greyhound must contest and finish in a race in a series or in the case of an abandoned or No Race have been entitled to contest the race at the time the race was abandoned or was declared a "No Race", before being eligible for and/or listed in the field of a further race in the series.

### 2.1.2. Special conditions for a series conducted in heats and a final

- 2.1.2.1. Any series conducted in Heats and Final shall be conducted in accordance with the conditions defined in the Feature Race Conditions for the event, subject to the ruling that if there are insufficient first preference nominations to conduct at least 2 Heats with at least 7 eligible nominations in each heat then no Heats shall be conducted.
- 2.1.2.2. If Heats are not conducted, provided there are at least 7 eligible first preference nominations for a Final, then a Final only will be conducted on the date advertised for the Final. If there are 8 or more eligible first preference nominations for the heats, then

the field for the "Final Only" shall be selected from those greyhounds with eligibility and field selection on the grade and order of choice at the time the fields for the final are drawn. If there are less than 8 eligible first preference nominations for the heats. then new nominations shall be called for the "Final Only" and connections must re-nominate for the "Final Only" and the field shall be selected from the nominations received with selection preference going to those greyhounds that had an eligible first preference nomination for the heats.

- 2.1.2.3. The number of Heats scheduled for each series shall be the maximum number of Heats to be conducted. The number of Heats to be conducted shall be reduced in accordance with the number of eligible first preference nominations received as per the Heats/ Nominations table.
- 2.1.2.4. A greyhound must contest and finish in a heat or in the case of an abandoned or No Race have been entitled to contest the heat at the time the heat was abandoned or was declared a "No Race", before being eligible for and/or listed in the field to contest the Final.

#### 2.1.3. Special conditions for a series conducted in two sets of heats and final

2.1.3.1. Any series conducted in two sets of Heats and Final shall be

conducted in accordance with the conditions defined in the Feature Race Conditions for the event, subject to the ruling that if there are insufficient first preference nominations to conduct at least 2 Heats with at least 8 eligible nominations in each heat then no Heats shall be conducted on the first day of the series.

- 2.1.3.2. If Heats are not conducted on the first day of the Series, then the Series shall be conducted as a Heats and Final Series only under the grades and distances laid down for the second series of Heats and the Final and connections must re-nominate for the new "Heats and Final" only series. The Special Conditions for a Series conducted in Heats and a Final as defined in Clause 2.1.2 then apply to the new series.
- 2.1.3.3. The number of Heats scheduled for each series shall be the maximum number of Heats to be conducted. The number of Heats to be conducted shall be reduced to provide at least 8 eligible first preference nominations for each Heat.
- 2.1.3.4. A greyhound must contest both sets of heats or in the case of an abandoned or No Race have been entitled to contest the heat at the time the heat was abandoned or was declared a "No Race", to be eligible for and/or listed in the field to contest the Final

#### 2.1.4 Special conditions for a feature event conducted without heats

- 2.1.4.1 Any Feature Event scheduled to be conducted without Heats shall only be conducted provided there are at least 7 eligible nominations unless Tasracing, in exceptional circumstances, grants approval for the event to be conducted with fewer eligible nominations.
- 2.2. Mid distance and distance races
- 2.2.1. Special conditions for a series conducted in heats and a final
- 2.2.1.1. Any series conducted in Heats and Final shall be conducted in accordance with the conditions defined in the Feature Race Conditions for the event, subject to the ruling that if there are insufficient first preference nominations to conduct at least 2 Heats with at least 6 eligible nominations in each heat then no Heats shall be conducted.
- 2.2.1.2. If Heats are not conducted for a Mid Distance or Distance series (not being Free-to-All heats) then an event for the same grade as the heats will be programmed provided there are at least 6 eligible nominations that have stipulated a second choice for the grade of the heats over that distance. Provided there are at least 6 eligible first preference nominations for a Final, a Final only will be conducted on the date advertised for the Final.

If there are 8 or more eligible first preference nominations for the Heats those greyhounds shall be deemed nominated for the Final only and the Final shall be selected from those nominations with eligibility and field selection on the grade and order of choice at the time the fields for the final are drawn. If there are less than 8 eligible first preference nominations for the heats, then new nominations shall be called for the "Final Only" and connections must re-nominate for the "Final Only" and the field shall be selected from the nominations received with selection preference going to those arevhounds that had an eligible first preference nomination for the heats.

2.2.1.3. If Heats are not conducted for a Free-to-All Mid Distance or Free-to-All Distance series then, provided there are 6 or more eligible nominations, those greyhounds shall be deemed nominated for a Free-to-All race over the distance of the Heats. Provided there are at least 6 eligible first preference nominations for a Final, a Final only will be conducted on the date advertised for the Final. If there are 8 or more eligible first preference nominations for the Heats, those greyhounds shall be deemed nominated for the Final only and the Final shall be selected from those nominations with eligibility and field selection on the grade and order of choice at the time the fields for the final are drawn. If there are less than 8 eligible first preference nominations for the heats, new nominations shall be called for the "Final Only" and connections must re-nominate for the "Final Only" and the field shall be selected from the nominations received with selection preference going to those greyhounds that had an eligible first preference nomination for the heats.

- 2.2.1.4. The number of Heats scheduled for each series shall be the maximum number of Heats to be conducted. The number of Heats to be conducted shall be reduced in accordance with the number of eligible first preference nominations received as per the Heats/ Nominations table.
- 2.2.1.5. A greyhound must contest and finish in a heat or in the case of an abandoned or No Race have been entitled to contest the heat at the time the heat was abandoned or was declared a "No Race", before being eligible for and/or listed in the field to contest the Final.

#### 2.2.2 Special conditions for a series conducted in two sets of heats and final

2.2.2.1. Any series conducted in two sets of Heats and Final shall be conducted in accordance with the conditions defined in the Feature Race Conditions for the event, subject to the ruling that if there are insufficient first preference nominations to conduct at least 2 Heats with at least 8 eligible nominations in each heat then no Heats shall be conducted on the first day of the series.

- 2.2.2.2. If Heats are not conducted on the first day of the Series, then the Series shall be conducted as a Heats and Final Series only under the grades and distances laid down for the second series of Heats and the Final and connections must re-nominate for the new "Heats and Final" only series. The Special Conditions for a Series conducted in Heats and a Final as defined in Clause 2.2.1 then apply to the new series.
- 2.2.2.3.In the case of Mid Distance or Distance Heats (not being Free-to-All Heats) not being conducted on the first day of the Series then an event for the same grade as the heats will be programmed provided there are at least 6 eligible nominations that have stipulated a second choice for the grade of the heats over that distance.
- 2.2.2.4. In the case of Free-to-All Mid Distance or Free-to-All Distance heats not being conducted on the first day of the Series then, provided there are 6 or more eligible nominations, those greyhounds shall be deemed nominated for a Free-to-All race over the distance of the Heats at that meeting.

- 2.2.2.5. The number of Heats scheduled for each series shall be the maximum number of Heats to be conducted. The number of Heats to be conducted shall be reduced to provide at least 8 eligible first preference nominations for each Heat.
- 2.2.2.6. A greyhound must contest both sets of heats or in the case of an abandoned or No Race have been entitled to contest the heat at the time the heat was abandoned or was declared a "No Race", to be eligible for and/ or listed in the field to contest the Final.
- 2.2.3. Special conditions for a feature event conducted without heats
- 2.2.3.1. Any Feature Event scheduled to be conducted without Heats shall only be conducted provided there are at least 6 eligible nominations unless Tasracing, in exceptional circumstances, grants approval for the event to be conducted with fewer eligible nominations.

#### 2.4. Conflict of conditions

- 2.4.1 In the event of a conflict between any provisions of this policy and the specified conditions of a race or series, the provisions of the specified conditions of a race or series shall prevail.
- 2.4.2 Tasracing retains the right to amend any of the above conditions at their absolute discretion to maximise the number and/or quality of races being programmed.
