Comments / Explanations:

Late rider explanations were accepted for the runners listed above.

RACE 1 – LADBROKES ODDS SURGE MAIDEN– 1100 METRES**2 THE TRINE**

Shifted in and bumped with THE TRINE on jumping.

3 AFFIRMATIONS

Raced wide from the 600metres.

4 CLOVER HILL

Raced three wide from the 600 metres and then carried wider by AFFIRMATIONS shifting out.

8 GLADDING

Brushed the running rail on multiple occasions from the 200m. When passing the winning post, rider K Sanderson reported his foot struck the end of the rail at the gap in the rail. Subsequently the track staff re-positioned this rail to prevent a further occurrence.

RACE 2 – TTMI MACHINERY MAIDEN - 1400 METRES

3 LEO DAVINCI	Inconvenienced after the start, and as a result was slow to muster early speed.
4 REGAL HUNTER	Jumped inwards at the start, hampering the early speed of LEO DAVINCI. Laid in throughout the home straight, brushing with EAGLEFURTHER at around the 50 metres.
5 EAGLEFURTHER	Over raced in the early stages. Steadied near the 50 metres, when REGAL HUNTER laid in and brushed with the mare.
7 ROUSING LEVI	Slow to muster early speed. Raced four wide to the 600 metres.
9 TIMMIE LAD	Bounded on jumping.

RACE 3 – TAS BREEDERS LIFE MEMBER OWEN & SANDRA ATKINS C1 HCP- 1400 METRES

1 RESPITE	Jumped out at the start. Near the 1100 metres, crossed to the front of STREETFIGHTER VEGA causing that gelding to momentarily take hold. Stewards advised rider E Byrne-Burke to exercise more care when shifting ground.
2 THANKGODITSFRIDAY (NZ)	
3 STREETFIGHTER VEGA	Commenced to over-race in the middle stages when steadied off the heels of RESPITE.
5 SKY EAGLE	Checked off the heels of BUNKER BOB near the 1100 metres when racing keenly.
8 PAULARTES	Tightened after the start between BUNKER BOB and RESPITE, and as a result was slow to muster early speed.
9 BUNKER BOB	Momentarily shifted in, when RESPITE rolled forward crowding SKY EAGLE which had been carried out at that point.

RACE 4 – TAS BREEDERS LIFE MEMBER JENNY WATSON C1 HCP- 1200 METRES

2 MAZZINI	Jumped out at the start, bumping with SNOW MAIDEN. Laid in over the concluding stages, brushing with the rail.
3 SNOW MAIDEN	Raced three wide from the 600 metres. Laid in, over the concluding stages when under pressure.
4 TALK LIKE THAT	Inclined to lay out when under pressure over the concluding stages.
5 GEEGEES LEGACY	Fractious in the barriers prior to the start.

RACE 5 – TTC MEMBERS CLASS 4 - 1200 METRES

1 RUBBLE 'N' FUDD	Over-raced in the early and middle stages. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed the gelding to have thumps, and a minor laceration to the left hind heel bulb. Trainer J Blacker could not offer any explanation for the below-market expectations performance of the gelding, other than the stable would be following up with blood tests early in the week the results of which will be advised to the Stewards. Rider J Radley pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on 12 occasions prior to the 100 metres. Taking into account the high breach of the rule, his good record, and that Rider Radley did not further use the whip inside the 100 metres, Stewards fined Apprentice Radley \$400.
3 RICH GLOW	Tightened on jumping by RUBBLE 'N' FUDD, which jumped outwards.
5 GEMS EAGLE	Declared a late scratching at 7:58pm on veterinary advice, after harmlessly dislodging rider A Darmanin and then breaking free from the Clerk Of The Course enroute to the barriers, and galloping for 1600 metres

6 NGAPALI BEACH

Over raced in the early stages.

RACE 6 – FIELD FAMILY BM60 HCP– 1100 METRES**2 WARICA**

Cast a near-fore plate during the race.

3 RALPH THE ROCKET

Slow to muster early speed.

4 COOL HEART**5 OHSHE'STROUBLE**

Jumped awkwardly, contacting the inside barrier partition and was slow into stride.

6 STARS IN THE NIGHT**7 LORD WHITEGATE**

Over-raced during the early stages.

8 POWER MAGNUM

Laid out throughout the 800 meter turn.

9 NAZORIAN

Shifted outwards on jumping.

RACE 7 – TAS BREEDERS LIFE MEMBER GRAEME MCCULLOCH C4 HCP - 1600 METRES**2 ONLY OLD ONCE**

Slow to muster early speed. When questioned on the below -market expectations performance, Rider Codi Jordan reported she believed the mare had raced with her tongue over the bit and had choked down. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities.

8 RUBICK'S AFFAIR

Bounded after the start.

RACE 8 – TAS BREEDERS LIFE MEMBER ROBYN WINSHAW BM60 HCP– 1400 METRES**1 GEE GEES ME BOY**

Bumped with NO ACCESS shortly after the start.

3 WILLINGLY

Raced three wide in the early stages, before working forward to the lead.

6 LION'S TOOTH

Slow to muster early speed. Raced four wide from the 500 metres.

7 CRAZY ATOM

Tended to over race during the early and middle stages.
