# RACE 1 - ROCKJAW TOURS "IT'S WHY WE RACE" MAIDEN - 1120 M

5 D'AMBIDEX

Declared a late scratching at 6.02pm on veterinary advice after rearing and becoming cast in the barriers. The mare must trial before racing again.

**7 OXIDIZE** Commenced to over-race near the 700 metres and shifted out abruptly carrying

PARTY DAY wider. Stewards inquired into this incident and after questioning Rider C Jordan and viewing the official films found that OXIDIZE had commened

to over-race and shifted out despite the efforts of the rider.

8 PARTY DAY Checked and carried wider at the 600 metres when OXIDISE commenced to

over-race and shifted out despite the efforts of the rider. Rider D Pires stated that after receiving this interference his mount failed to respond to his riding.

9 SEDNA Slow to begin. 12 ARCADE BOY Slow to begin.

**13 ADDICTIVE GAS** Compounded over the concluding stages.

## RACE 2 - FLINDERS ISLAND CABIN PARK "HIDDEN ZEBRA" 3YO MAIDEN - 1220 M

1 SILVER GRANGE
2 TIMELY NEEDS
Bumped on jumping when TIMELY NEEDS shifted out.
Shifted out on jumping and bumped SILVER GRANGE.

4 CELESTIAL GLOW Raced three wide in the early stages. Momentarily steadied when SKY OF GOLD

shifted out near the 100 metres.

**6 SKY OF GOLD** Shifted out at 100 metres carrying CELESTIAL GLOW WIDER before being

corrected by its rider. Apprentice J Johnstone was advised he must correct his

mounts sooner than he had done on this occasion.

**7 THE PIRATE QUEEN**Over-raced at the 700 metres, shifted out and bumped with SKY OF GOLD.

# RACE 3 - NUTRIEN AG SOLUTIONS "STAR CHEERS" MAIDEN - 1420 M

**2 TIDEFORD (NZ)** Raced three wide in the middle stages.

4 BIG OLIVESlow to muster early speed.8 SEDITIOUS AWARDOver-raced in the early stages.9 WARRIORARaced wide in the early stages.

## RACE 4 - WHITEMARK POST OFFICE / CUTHILL FAMILY "DON'T SLIP THROUGH THE NET" CLASS 1 HANDICAP - 1220 M

**4 MAJESTIC MOLLY** Raced three wide in the early stages.

**5 PRINCE OF KHATUN** Blundered severely on jumping almost dislodging the rider. Then bumped by

MAJESTIC MOLLY which shifted out.

**6 ALISENT** Over-raced in the early and middle stages. Shifted out on two occasions under

pressure in the home straight.

## RACE 5 - INTERSTATE HOTEL FLINDERS ISLAND CUP CLASS 6 - 1420 M

2 SAILOR (NZ) Apprentice Radley reported that the gelding failed to respond to his riding in

the home straight after being placed in a forward position in the early and

middle stages.

**3 ADACHI** Laid in approaching the winning post.

5 MAKE A DECISION Caught three wide early and restrained to race at the back of the field. Placed

under pressure from the 600 metres and then held up momentarily near the 150 metres when CAPTAIN MORGAN (NZ) shifted out marginally under

pressure.

6 SH'BOURNE MIDNIGHT The tips were unable to be applied to the hind hooves and permission was

given for the gelding to race barefoot behind. Accidentally contacted by the

whip of ADACHI approaching the winning post.

**8 LOVIN' BEV** Shifted out under pressure from the 150 metres. Rider E Byrne Burke reported

that her mount felt flat in the run to the line.

### RACE 6 - KILLARA "ISLAND WARRIOR" VASE BM64 HCP - 1120 M

**4 WHEELING** Bumped on jumping.

6 POPILITA Scratched.

**7 CAPABELLE** Shifted in on jumping and bumped with WHEELING.

### RACE 7 - GLASS WARRIOR AMBASSADOR FOR NETS PLATE BM76 HCP - 1620 M

1 SHY GUY Laid in throughout.

**3 THE SPIRIT OF ZERO 6 ETHICAL DILEMMA**Steadied off heels near 1400 metres and commenced to over-race.
Tightened approaching the 800 metres when SHY GUY laid in.

**7 EXALTED CROWN** Raced three wide in the early and middle stages. Compounded from the 200

metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed.

# RACE 8 – 1808 A RUM BAR & COCKTAIL LOUNGE MAIDEN/CLASS 1 - 2150 M

1 OPENSEA (NZ)

Progressed three wide to take up a forward position due to the slow pace however this took longer than anticipated and he did not obtain a position until leaving the 700 metres. Rider A Darmanin was advised to ensure he rides his mounts out fully to the end of the race.
